Finished Size: 57 ½" x 57 ½" (146.05cm x 146.05cm)

### Fabric Needed

3 Wishes Fabric® Wild & Whimsy Collection by Connie Haley

- 1 Panel (76.2cm) – Panel (14560-Multi)
- 1 ½ yds (137.16cm) – Forest (14561-Multi)
- 1 ⅞ yds (102.87cm) – 3W Basics Collection White (14544-White on White)
- ⅝ yd (57.15cm) – Rainbows (14563-Multi) for Piecing and Binding
- ⅝ yd (57.15cm) – Leaves (14565-Multi)
- ½ yd (45.72cm) – 3W Basics Collection Red (14546-Red)
- ⅓ yd (30.48cm) – Animals (14562-Multi)
- 3 ⅓ yds (304.8cm) – Leaves (14565-Multi) for Backing

### ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- 66" x 66" (167.64cm x 167.64cm) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)



# Before you begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼" (6.35mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric.

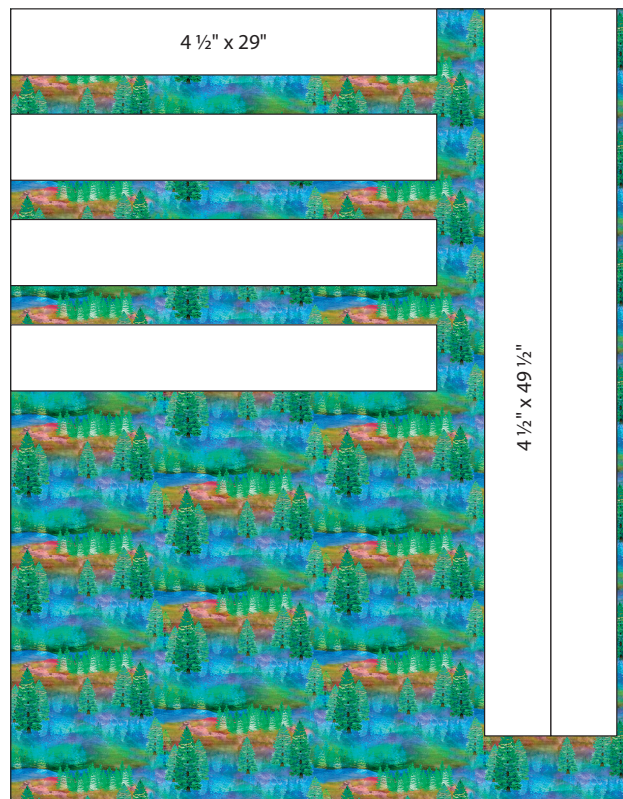
## Cutting

1. Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.



**Panel (14560-Multi) / ⅞ yd (76.2cm x 106.68cm)**

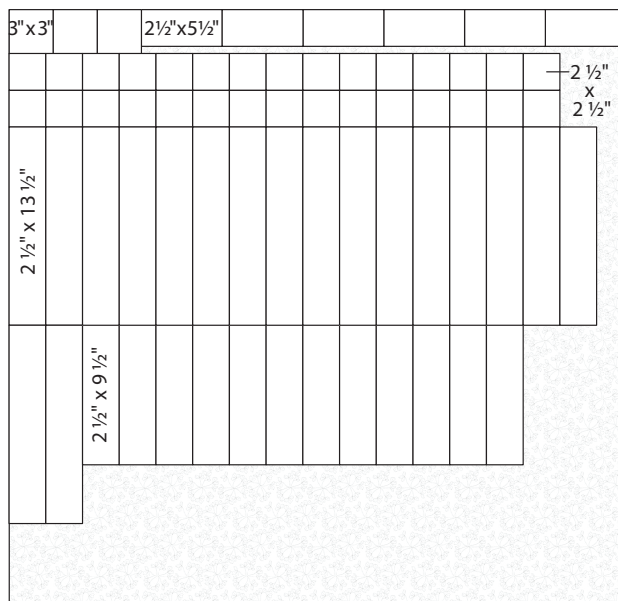
Fussy Cut 6 – 9 ½" x 9 ½" (24.13cm x 24.13cm) as pictured on Page 1



**Forest (14561-Multi) / 1 ½ yds (137.16cm x 106.68cm)**

Cut 2 – 4 ½" x 49 ½" (11.43cm x 125.73cm)

Fussy Cut 4 – 4 ½" x 29" (11.43cm x 73.66cm)

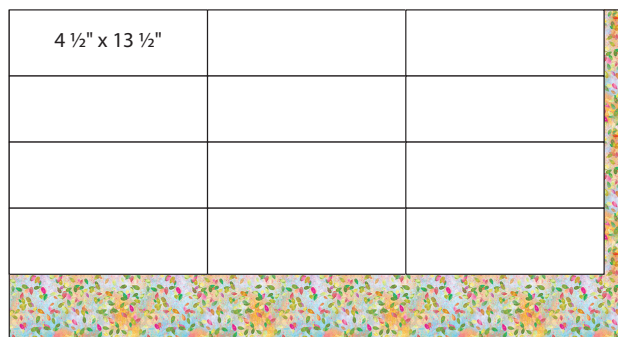

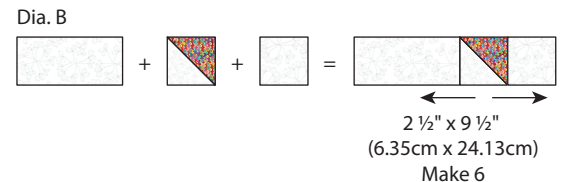
**Animals (14562-Multi) / 1/3 yd (30.48cm x 106.68cm)**

## Sewing

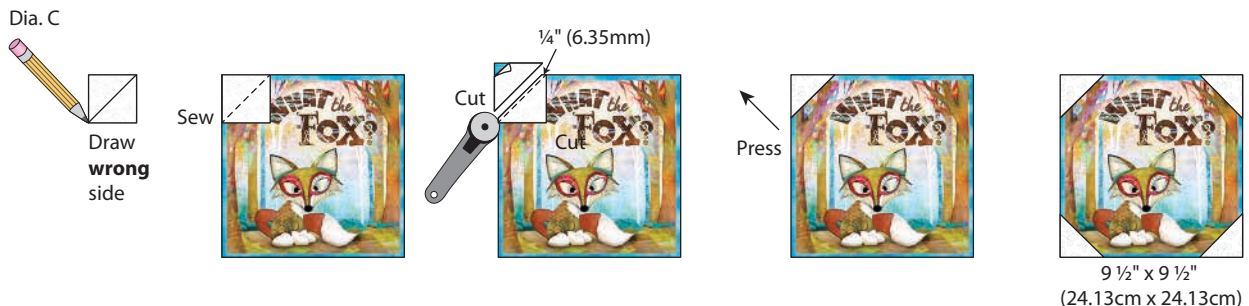
- Refer to Diagram A to make the Half Square Triangle Units. **Note:** Two squares make two HST Units. Draw a diagonal line on the **wrong** side of one 3W Basics White square (3" x 3" / 7.62cm x 7.62cm). Place on top of a Rainbows square (3" x 3" / 7.62cm x 7.62cm). Sew 1/4" (6.35mm) away from the line on both sides. Cut on the drawn line; press. Trim to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (6.35cm x 6.35cm). Repeat to make a total of six HST units



- Place one 3W Basics White rectangle (2 1/2" x 5 1/2" / 6.35cm x 13.97cm), one HST Unit (2 1/2" x 2 1/2" / 6.35cm x 6.35cm) and one 3W Basics White square (2 1/2" x 2 1/2" / 6.35cm x 6.35cm) as shown in Diagram B. Pin RST and sew; press. Repeat to make six Border Units (2 1/2" x 9 1/2" / 6.35cm x 24.13cm).



- Draw a diagonal line on the **wrong** side of one 3W Basics White square (2 1/2" x 2 1/2" / 6.35cm x 6.35cm). Place on the corner of the Fussy Cut Panel "What the Fox" square (9 1/2" x 9 1/2" / 24.13cm x 24.13cm) as shown in Diagram C. Sew on the drawn line, trim the corner 1/4" (6.35mm) away from the seam and press open. Repeat for the other three corners to make one Panel Snow Ball Unit (9 1/2" x 9 1/2" / 24.13cm x 24.13cm).





5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Diagram D using the five remaining Fussy Cut Panel squares (9 1/2" x 9 1/2" / 24.13cm x 24.13cm) and 20 3W Basics White squares (2 1/2" x 2 1/2" / 6.35cm x 6.35cm) to make a total of six Panel Snow Ball Units.

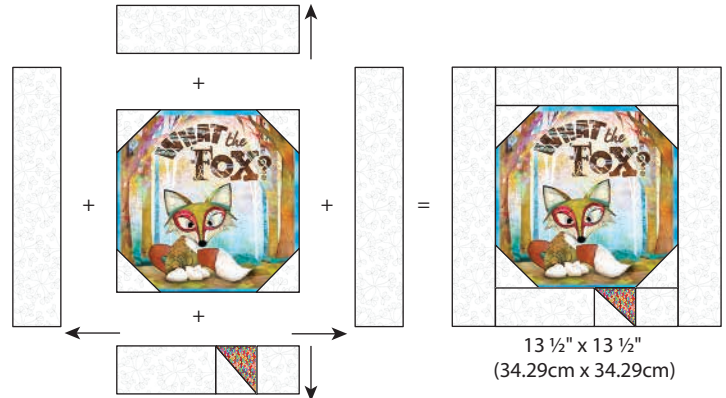

6. Refer to Diagram E to add borders to the "What the Fox" Snow Ball Unit (9 1/2" x 9 1/2" / 24.13cm x 24.13cm). Place the Border Unit made in Step 3 on the bottom of the Snow Ball Unit as shown. Pin RST and sew; press. Place a 3W Basics White rectangle (2 1/2" x 9 1/2" / 6.35cm x 24.13cm) on the top as shown. Pin RST and sew; press. Place a 3W Basics White rectangle (2 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 6.35cm x 34.29cm) on each side as shown. Pin RST and sew; press to make one Panel Block (13 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 34.29cm x 34.29cm).

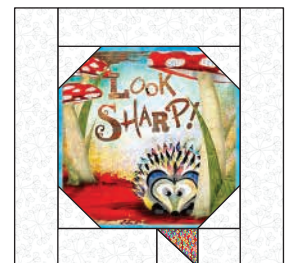


7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Diagram F to add the borders to the "I've Got Your Pack" and "Look Sharp" Snow Ball Units to make Panel Blocks (13 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 34.29cm x 34.29cm) for Row 1.

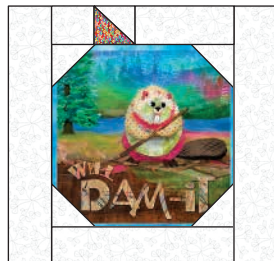

8. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Diagram G, adding the Border Unit on the top and the 3W Basics White rectangle (2 1/2" x 9 1/2" / 6.35cm x 24.13cm) on the bottom of the Snowball Units to make the three Panel Blocks (13 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 34.29cm x 34.29cm) for Row 5.

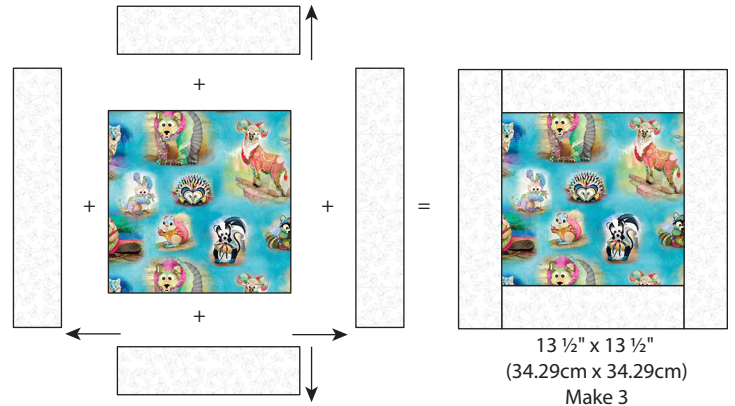

9. Refer to Diagram H to add the borders to one Animals square (9 1/2" x 9 1/2" / 24.13cm x 24.13cm). Place one 3W Basics White rectangle (2 1/2" x 9 1/2" / 6.35cm x 24.13cm) on the top and bottom as shown. Pin RST and sew; press. Place a 3W Basics White rectangle (2 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 6.35cm x 34.29cm) on each side as shown. Pin RST and sew; press to make three Animals Blocks (13 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 34.29cm x 34.29cm).

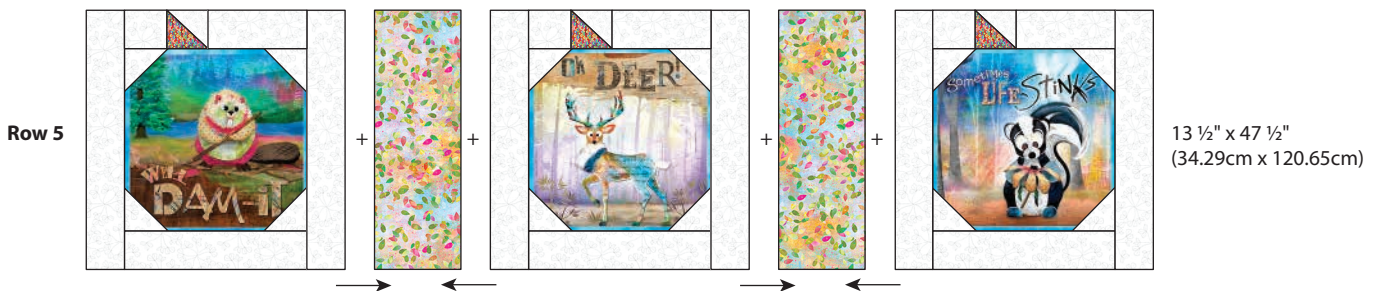
10. Alternate the "What the Fox", "I've Got Your Pack", and "Look Sharp" Panel Blocks (13 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 34.29cm x 34.29cm) with two Leaves rectangles (4 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 11.43cm x 34.29cm) as shown in Diagram I. Pin RST and sew; press to make Row 1 (13 1/2" x 47 1/2" / 34.29cm x 120.65cm).

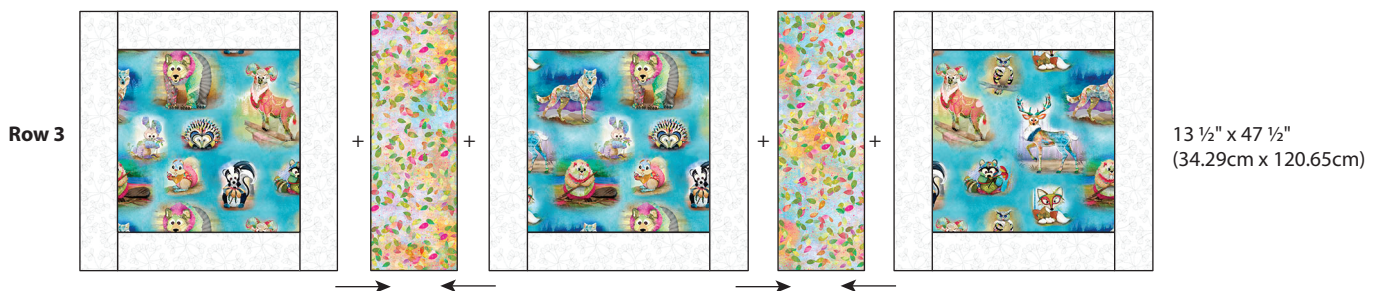
11. Alternate the "Well Dam-It", "Oh Deer!", and "Sometimes Life Stinks" Panel Blocks (13 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 34.29cm x 34.29cm) with two Leaves rectangles (4 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 11.43cm x 34.29cm) as shown in Diagram J. Pin RST and sew; press to make Row 5 (13 1/2" x 47 1/2" / 34.29cm x 120.65cm).

12. Alternate the three Animal Blocks (13 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 34.29cm x 34.29cm) with two Leaves rectangles (4 1/2" x 13 1/2" / 11.43cm x 34.29cm) as shown in Diagram K. Pin RST and sew; press to make Row 3 (13 1/2" x 47 1/2" / 34.29cm x 120.65cm).

13. Alternate three Leaves rectangles (4 ½" x 13 ½" / 11.43cm x 34.29cm) with two 3W Basics Red squares (4 ½" x 4 ½" / 11.43cm x 11.43cm) as shown in Diagram L. Pin RST and sew; press to make Row 2 (4 ½" x 47 ½" / 11.43cm x 120.65cm). Repeat to make Row 4.

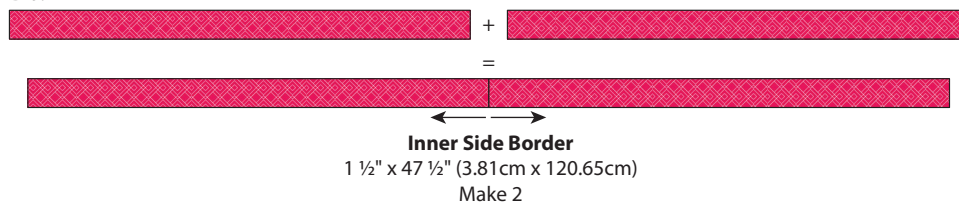
14. Refer to Diagram M and place the rows made in Steps 10-13 as shown. Pin RST, matching the seams, sew, and press. The Quilt Center should measure 47 ½" x 47 ½" (120.65cm x 120.65cm).

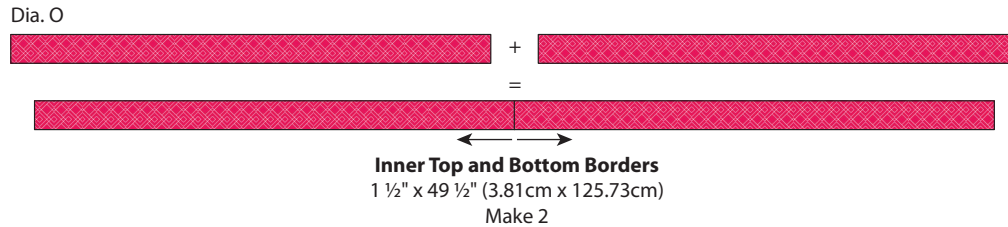


15. Place two 3W Basics Red rectangles (1 ½" x 24" / 3.81cm x 60.96cm) as shown in Diagram N. Pin short ends RST and sew. Press seam open to make one Inner Side Border (1 ½" x 47 ½" / 3.81cm x 120.65cm). Repeat to make two.

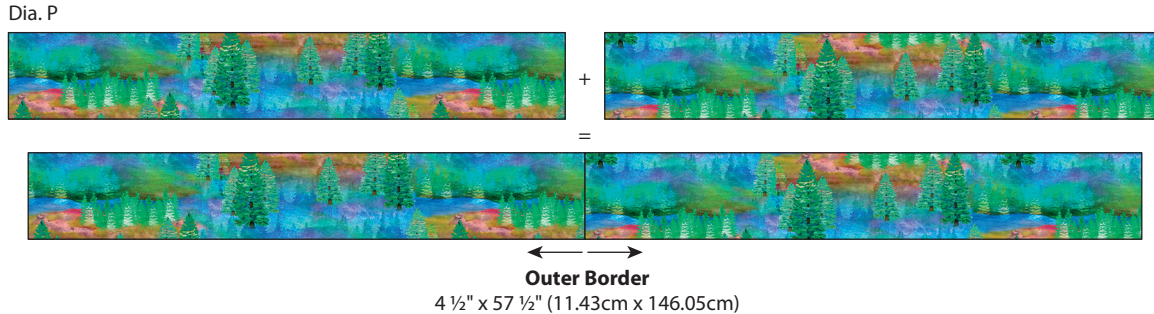

16. Place two 3W Basics Red rectangles (1 ½" x 25" / 3.81cm x 63.5cm) as shown in Diagram O. Pin short ends RST and sew. Press seam open to make the Inner Top Border (1 ½" x 49 ½" / 3.81cm x 125.73cm). Repeat to make the Inner Bottom Border.



17. Place two Forest rectangles (4 ½" x 29" / 11.43cm x 73.66cm) as shown in Diagram P. Pin short ends RST and sew; press seam open to make the Outer Top Border (1 ½" x 57 ½" / 3.81cm x 146.05cm). Repeat to make the Outer Bottom Border. **Note:** Place so fabric print runs in the same direction.



18. To complete the Quilt Top, refer to Diagram Q on Page 8 and the steps below to add the borders to the Quilt Center (47 ½" x 47 ½" / 20.65cm x 120.65cm).

#### Inner Border

Sides - Use the two 3W Basics Red rectangles (1 ½" x 47 ½" / 3.81cm x 120.65cm) made in Step 15.

Top & Bottom - Use the two 3W Basics Red rectangles (1 ½" x 49 ½" / 3.81cm x 125.73cm) made in Step 16.

#### Outer Border

Sides - Use the two Forest rectangles (4 ½" x 49 ½" / 11.43cm x 125.73cm).

Top & Bottom - Use the two Forest rectangles (4 ½" x 57 ½" / 11.43cm x 165.04cm) made in Step 17.

*Note fabric direction.*

Pin and sew the side borders first, then the top and bottom borders. Match ends and middles. Press to the outside. The finished Quilt Top should measure 57 ½" x 57 ½" (146.05cm x 146.05cm).

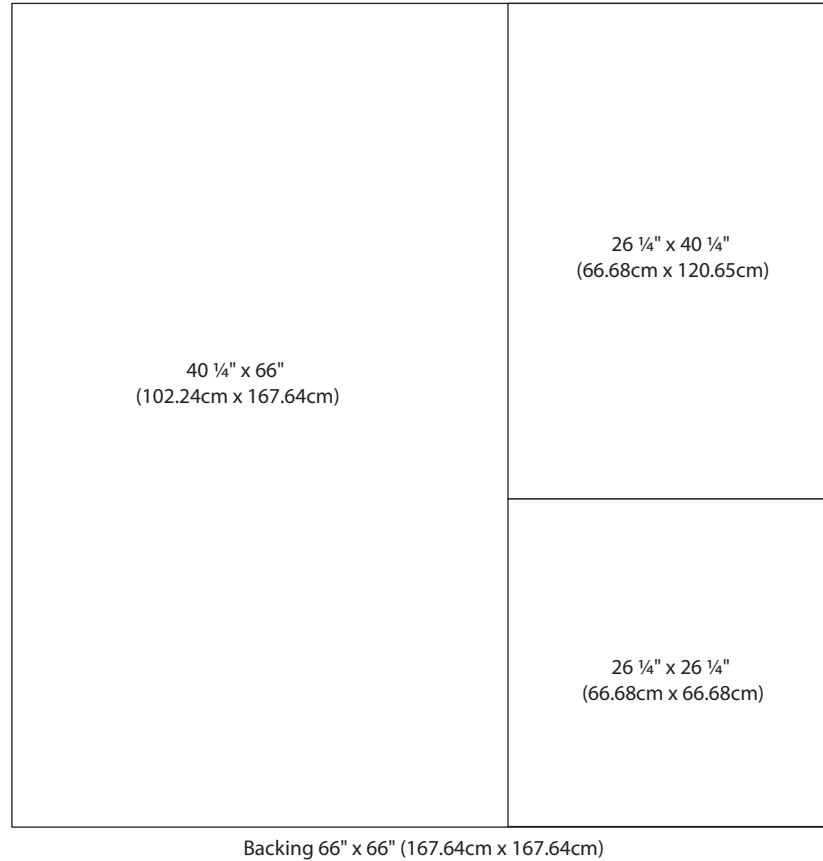

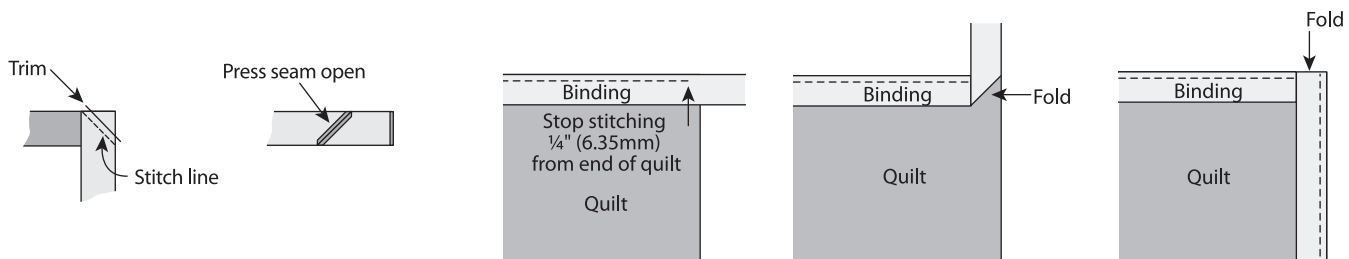


19. To make the Leaves backing, remove the selvages and cut one piece 40 ¼" x 66" (102.87cm x 164.64cm), one piece 26 ¼" x 40 ¼" (66.68cm x 102.24cm), and one piece 26 ¼" x 26 ¼" (66.68cm x 66.68cm). Pin RST and sew the two smaller pieces on the short sides; press, then pin RST and sew along the long edges as shown in Diagram R. Press seams open or to one side. The Backing should measure 66" x 66" (102.87cm x 102.87cm).

20. Press finished quilt top and backing. Tape the backing **wrong** side up to a firm surface. Layer batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
21. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess backing and batting even with the quilt top.
22. To make the Rainbows binding, remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six 2 ½" x wof (6.35cm x 106.68cm) strips RST end to end at a 45° angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼" (6.35mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2" (5.08cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded binding even with the edge of the quilt top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the binding. Fold binding over to back and hand stitch.



## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. **Tip:** Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
