7/8 yard	Apples Outlined - Red (H)	1526-88*
7/8 yard	Tossed Apples - Cream (I)	1520-48
1/4 yard	Folio - Early Green (J)	7755-62
1/4 yard	Blooming Vine - Cream (K)	1523-48

Table Topper Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Packed Apples - Red (A), cut:

- (1) 10 1/2" square.

From the Blooming Vine - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 5 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Baskets - Cream (C), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" squares.

From the Apples Outlined - Cream (D), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.

From the Stripe - Cream/Red (E):

- Fussy cut (4) 9 1/4" x 20 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Blocks - Red (F):

- Fussy cut (4) 8 1/2" squares each centered on a block.

From the Folio - Brown Bag (G), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 11 1/2" strips.

From the Apples Outlined - Red (H), cut:

- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 1/2" squares.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Apples - Cream (I), cut:

- (4) 4 1/2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Folio - Early Green (J), cut:

- (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 3/4" x 20 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Blooming Vine - Cream (K), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" squares.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 1/2" squares.

From the Bloom and Birds - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 58" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58" x 58" back.

Table Topper Sewing

Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of (1) 8 1/2" Fabric F square. Sew (1) 2" x 11 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim unit to measure 10 1/2" square. Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.

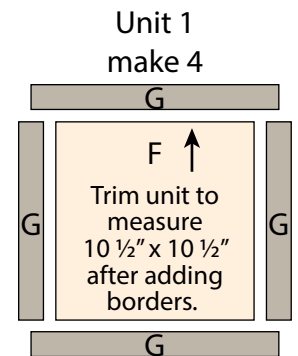

2. Place (1) 1 3/4" Fabric J square on the lower right corner of (1) Unit 1 square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 3).

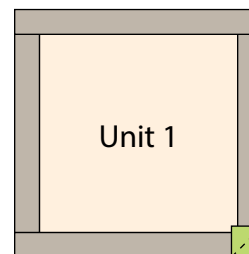

Block One make 1

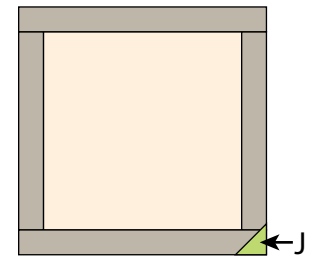

3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 4-6 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block Four square. Note: The arrow in the figures represents the direction of the fabric print.

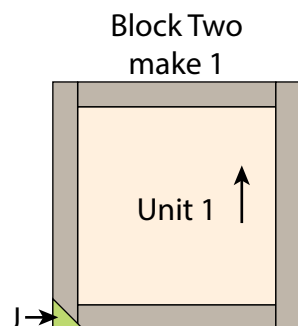

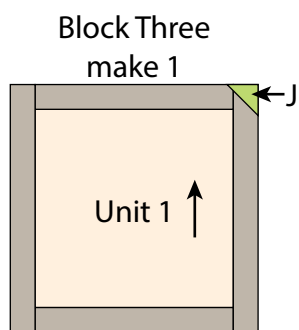

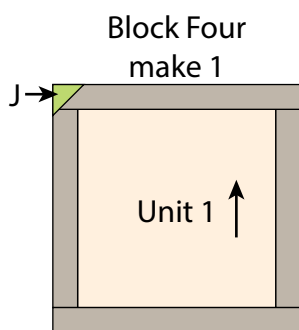

4. Place (1) 1 1/2" Fabric K square on the left side of (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 8).

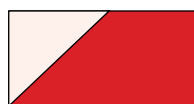

5. Place another 1 1/2" Fabric K square on the right side of the 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (16) Unit 2 strips total.

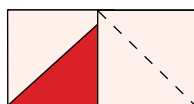

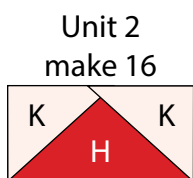

6. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric K square. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew (1) 1 1/2" Fabric H square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip to make (1) Top Block Strip. Repeat to make (1) Bottom Block Strip. Sew the Top Block Strip and the Bottom Block Strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric K square to make (1) Block Five square (Fig. 11). Pay attention to the strip orientations. Repeat to make (4) Block Five squares total.

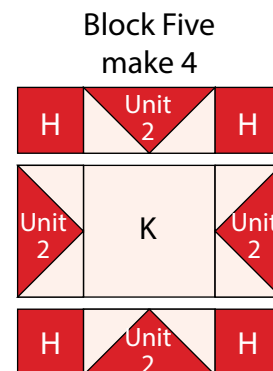

7. Repeat Steps 4-5 and refer to Figure 12 while using (8) 5 1/2" square and (4) 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric D strips to make (4) Unit 3 strips.

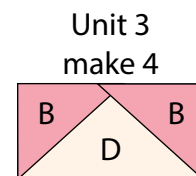

8. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of (1) 10 1/2" Fabric A square. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew (1) 5 1/2" Fabric C square to each end of (1)

Unit 3 strip to make (1) Top Block Strip. Repeat to make (1) Bottom Block Strip. Sew the Top Block Strip and the Bottom Block Strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make the Center Block (Fig. 13). Pay attention to the strip orientations.

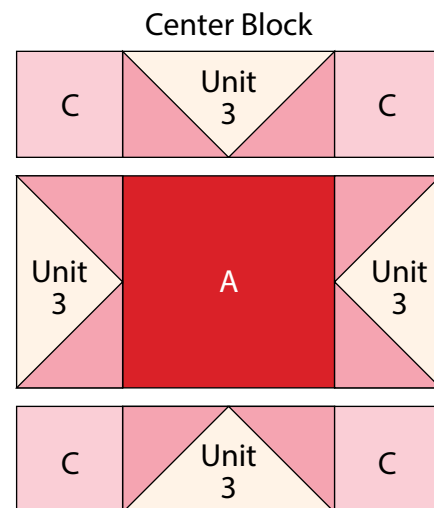

9. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 20 1/2" Fabric J strip to the bottom of (1) 9 1/4" x 20 1/2" Fabric E strip to make (1) Block Six strip (Fig. 14). Pay attention to the orientation of the Fabric E strip. Repeat to (4) Block Six strips total.

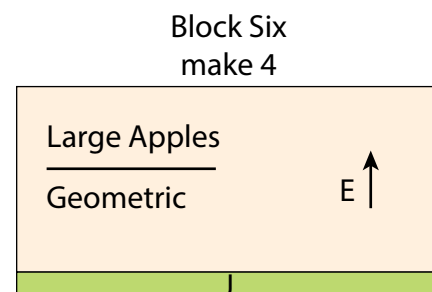

Table Topper Top Assembly

(Refer to Figure 15 while assembling.)

10. Sew (1) Block Six strip to each side of the Center Block. Pay attention to the strip orientations. Sew (1) Block One square to the left side of (1) Block Six strip. Pay attention to the strip orientation. Sew (1) Block Two square to the right end of the Block Six strip to make (1) Top Inner Border Strip. Sew (1) Block Three square to the left side of (1) Block Six strip. Pay attention to the strip orientation. Sew (1) Block Four square to the right side of the Block Six strip to make (1) Bottom Inner Border Strip. Sew the Top Inner Border Strip and the Bottom Inner Border strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Pay attention to the strip orientations.

11. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Block Five square to each end of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to make (1) Top Outer Border Strip. Repeat to make (1) Bottom Outer Border Strip. Sew the Top Outer Border Strip and the Bottom Outer Border Strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

13. Layer and quilt as desired.

14. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

15. Bind as desired.

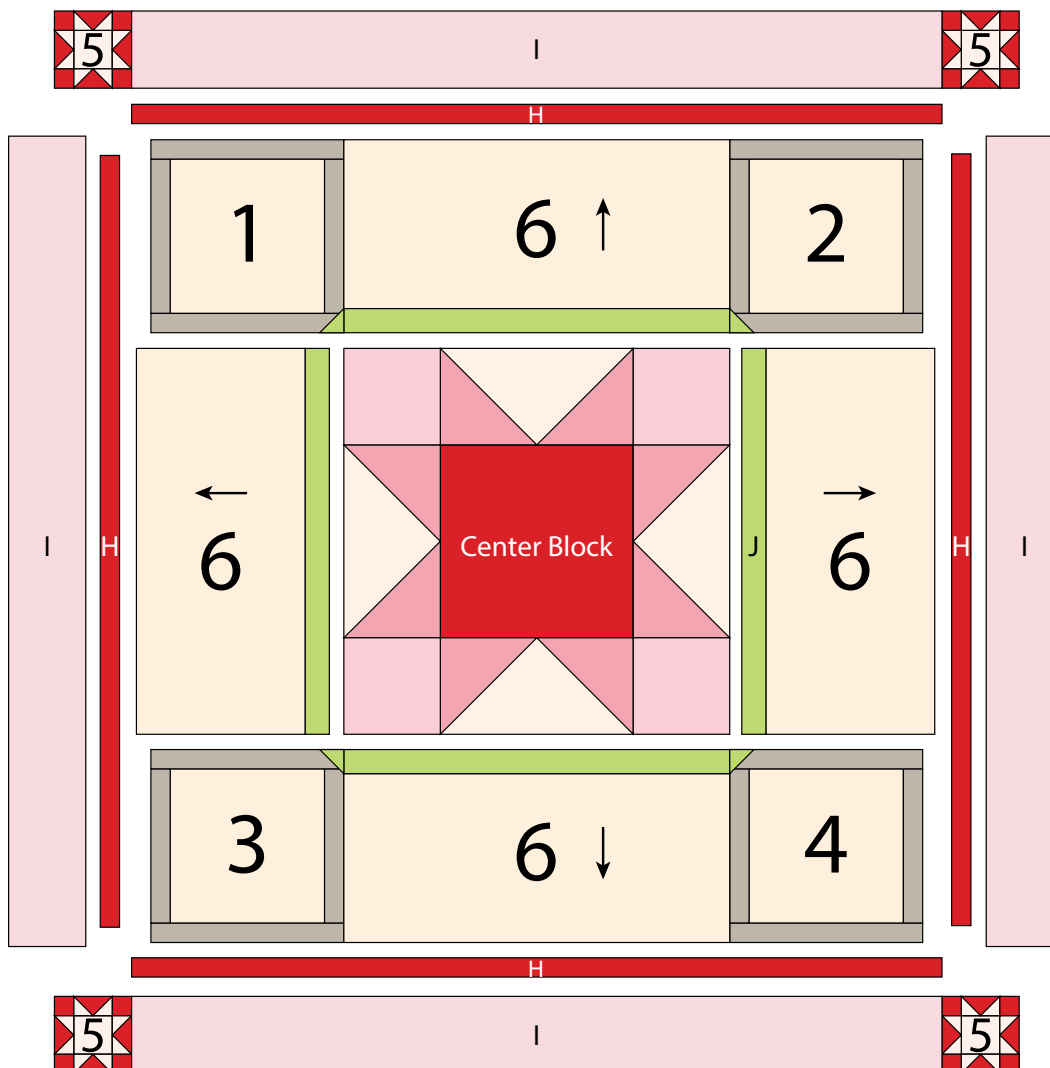

3/8 yard	Small Set Apples - Taupe (D)	1525-48
1/4 yard	Packed Apples - Red (E)	1522-88
1/4 yard	Apples Outlined - Cream (F)	1526-44
1 1/8 yards	Tossed Baskets - Cream (Backing)	1524-48

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Blocks - Red (A):

- Fussy cut (4) 8 1/2" squares each centered on a block.

From the Apples Outlined - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 1/2" squares.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Blooming Vine - Cream (C), cut:

- (3) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 3/4" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 3/4" x 10" strips.

From the Small Set Apples - Taupe (D), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/2" squares.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 1 1/2" squares.

From the Packed Apples - Red (E), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" squares.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 1/2" squares.

From the Apples Outlined - Cream (F), cut:

- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Baskets - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (4) 20" x 16" strips for the backs.

Place Mat Sewing

Instructions

1. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 16). Trim unit to measure 10" square. Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 squares total.

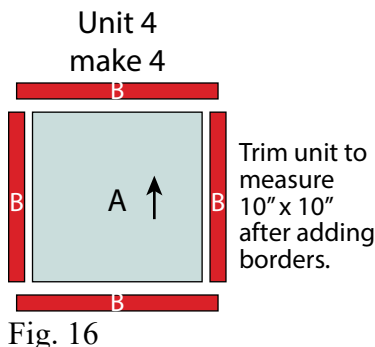

2. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 10" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 4 square to make (1) Block Seven square (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (4) Block Seven squares total.

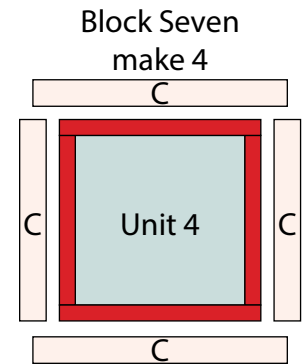

3. Place (1) 1 1/2" Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 18). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 18). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 19).

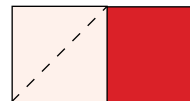

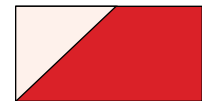

4. Place another 1 1/2" Fabric D square on the right side of the 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 20). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 20). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 21). Repeat to make (32) Unit 5 strips total.

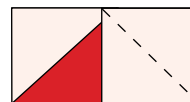

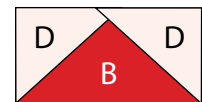

5. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Figure 22 for fabric identification and placement to make (16) Unit 6 strips.

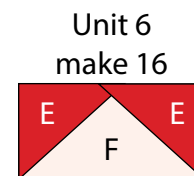

6. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to each side of (1) 2 ½” Fabric D square. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew (1) 1 ½” Fabric B square to each end of (1) Unit 5 strip to make (1) Top Block Strip. Repeat to make (1) Bottom Block Strip. Sew the Top Block Strip and the Bottom Block Strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) Block Eight square (Fig. 23). Pay attention to the strip orientations. Repeat to make (8) Block Eight squares total.

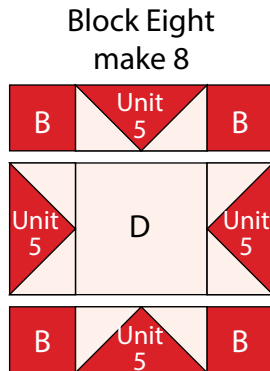

7. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to each side of (1) 2 ½” Fabric E square. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Sew (1) 1 ½” Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 6 strip to make (1) Top Block Strip. Repeat to make (1) Bottom Block Strip. Sew the Top Block Strip and the Bottom Block Strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) Block Nine square (Fig. 24). Pay attention to the strip orientations. Repeat to make (4) Block Nine squares total.

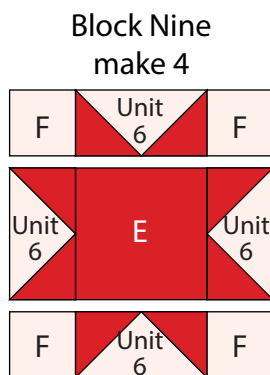

Place Mat Top Assembly

(Refer to Figure 25 while assembling.)

8. Sew (1) Block Eight square to the top and to the bottom of (1) Block Nine square to make (1) Side Border Strip. Sew the Side Border Strip to the left side of (1) Block Seven square to make (1) Place Mat top. Repeat to make (4) Place Mat tops total.

9. Layer and quilt as desired.

10. Sew the (7) 2 ½” x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Divide the long strip into (4) equal lengths.

11. Bind as desired.

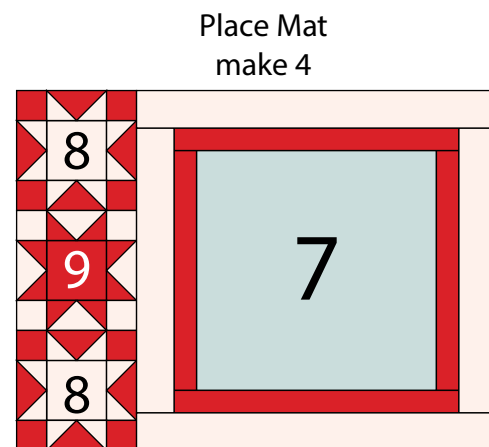
