



#### **Piecing Instructions**

- 1. Blocks 1 and 2 are constructed using units from strip sets. Follow the fabric combinations listed below to sew together strip sets by WOF using a 1/4" seam. Repeat to make (2) of each strip set combination.
- 1-1/4" x WOF  $\bf F$  strip + 7" x WOF  $\bf K$  strip + 6-1/4" x WOF  $\bf F$  strip
- $\bullet$  2" x WOF **C** strip + 7" x WOF **M** strip + 5-1/2" x WOF **C** strip
- ullet 2-5/8" x WOF  $oldsymbol{J}$  strip + 7" x WOF  $oldsymbol{Q}$  strip + 4-7/8" x WOF  $oldsymbol{J}$  strip
- 3-3/8" x WOF **E** strip + 7" x WOF **L** strip + 4-1/8" x WOF **E** strip
- 4-1/8" x WOF  $\bf D$  strip + 7" x WOF  $\bf N$  strip + 3-3/8" x WOF  $\bf D$  strip
- 4-7/8" x WOF I strip + 7" x WOF R strip + 2-5/8" x WOF I strip
- 5-1/2" x WOF **H** strip + 7" x WOF **O** strip + 2" x WOF **H** strip
- 6-1/4" x WOF **B** strip + 7" x WOF **P** strip + 1-1/4" x WOF **B** strip
- 7" x WOF **G** strip + 7" x WOF **A** strip




**2.** Cut (36) 2" units from each strip set combination for Blocks 1 and 2 as shown below in the diagram.



#### Block 1

- 1. Using (18) units from each strip set use Block 1 diagram, the fabric combinations listed in the strip set instructions as well as the fabric guide shown to complete (18) blocks.
- 2. Press seams toward the strip set unit using Fabrics G and A.



- 1. Using (18) units from each strip set use Block 2 diagram, the fabric combinations listed in the strip set instructions as well as the fabric guide shown to complete (18) blocks.
- 2. Press seams toward the strip set unit using Fabrics G and A.





#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

- **1.** Lay out the quilt top using the diagrams below to ensure accurate block placement. The quilt should create a wave effect.
- **2.** Sew together horizontal rows first, alternating the direction that the seams are pressed on each row.
- 3. Sew together the quilt top nestling seams as you go to reduce bulk.





### Finishing

- 1. Layer quilt top, batting and backing together.
- 2. Baste and quilt as desired.
- 3. Attach  ${\bf G}$  binding to complete quilt.
