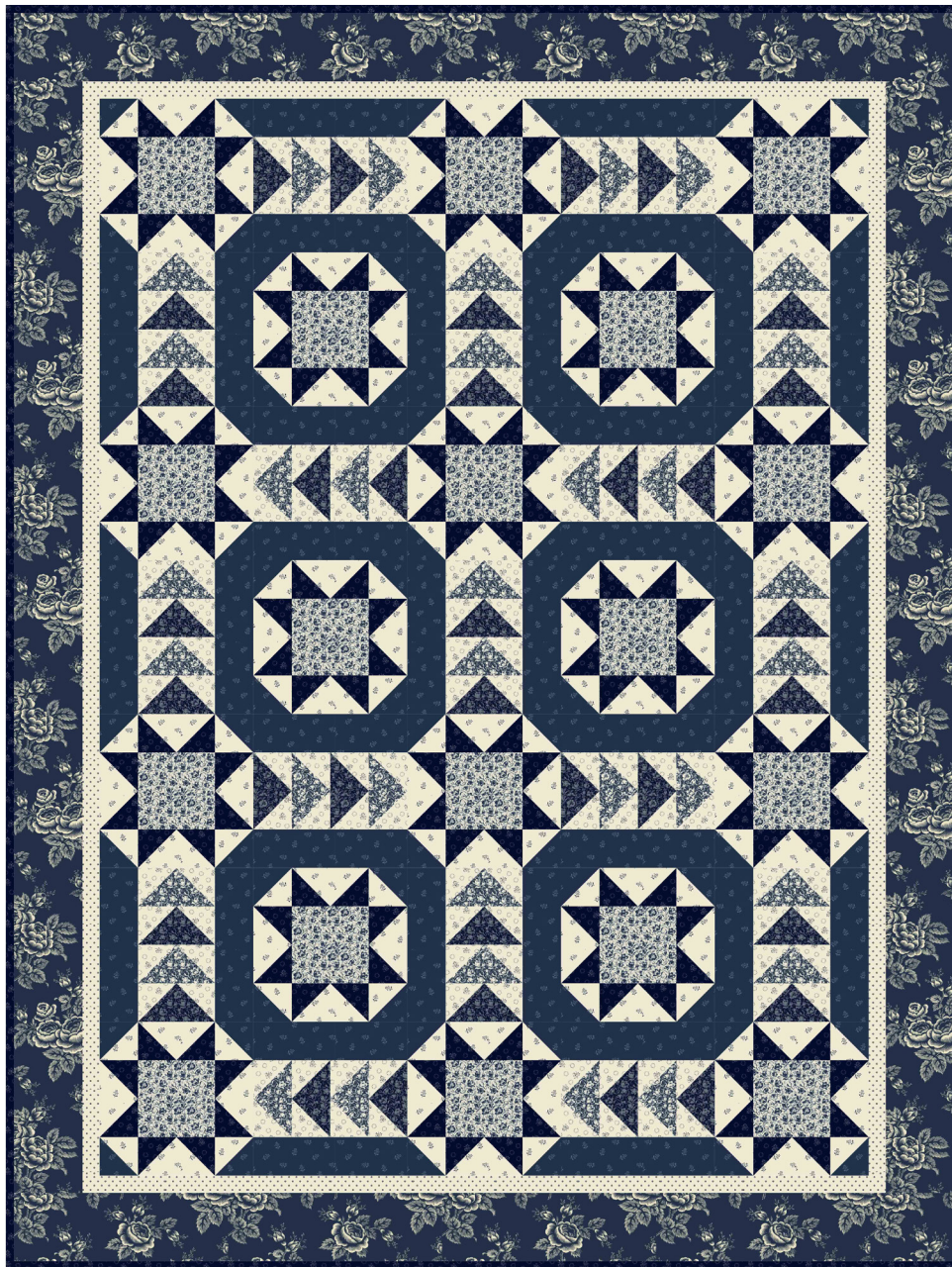

KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A		50880-3 Navy-Blue	1-1/8	(3) 3-1/8" x WOF" strips; subcut (36) 3-1/8" squares, cut once diagonally. (3) 9-1/2" x WOF" strips; subcut (34) 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" rectangles.
B		50880-2 Cream	7/8	(3) 3-1/8" x WOF" strips; subcut (36) 3-1/8" squares, cut once diagonally. (3) 5-3/4" x WOF" strips; subcut (18) 5-3/4" squares, cut twice diagonally.
C		50879-3 Navy-Blue	1-1/8	(6) 3-1/8" x WOF" strips; subcut (72) 3-1/8" squares, cut once diagonally. (7) 2-1/4" x WOF" strips for binding. Sew strips via short edge.
D		50876-2 Cream	5/8	(3) 5" x WOF strips; subcut (18) 5" squares.
E		50879-2 Cream	2/3	(6) 3-1/8" x WOF" strips; subcut (68) 3-1/8" squares, cut once diagonally.
F		50876-3 Navy-Blue	1/2	(2) 5-3/4" x WOF strips; subcut (9) 5-3/4" squares, cut twice diagonally.
G		50876-1 Navy	1/2	(2) 5-3/4" x WOF strips; subcut (9) 5-3/4" squares, cut twice diagonally.
H		50878-2 Cream	3/8	(6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew strips via short ends. Subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 65-1/2" strips and (2) 1-1/2" x 47 1/2" strips.
I		50874-1 Navy	7/8	(6) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew strips via short ends. Subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 63-1/2" strips and (2) 4-1/2" x 55-1/2" strips.
		Backing	3-1/2	Batting 63" x 81"

FLYING GEESE BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Flying Geese Units: Using **E** and **C** 3-1/8" triangles and **B**, **F** and **G** 5-3/4" triangles, make flying geese units as shown in diagrams below. Trim units to 2-3/4" x 5".



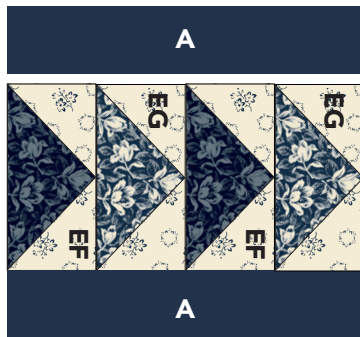
MAKE 34 **EF**



MAKE 34 **EG**



MAKE 72 **BC**



2. Flying Geese Blocks: Sew together (2) **EF** and (2) **EG** units alternatively, as shown in diagram. Add (1) **A** 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" strip to top and to bottom of flying geese unit. Square block to 9-1/2".
Note proper rotation of EF and EG units.

Make 17 Flying Geese Blocks. Set aside.

STAR BLOCK ASSEMBLY

3. Half-Square Triangle Units: Sew (1) **A** and (1) **B** 3-1/8" triangles together via long sides. Square to 2-3/4". Make 72 **AB** HSTs.

4. Unit One: Sew (1) **AB** unit to each end of (1) **BC** flying geese unit. *Note proper rotation of AB units.* Make 36 Unit Ones. Set aside.

5. Center Unit: Sew (1) **BC** flying geese unit to opposite sides of (1) **D** 5" square. Make 18 Center Units.

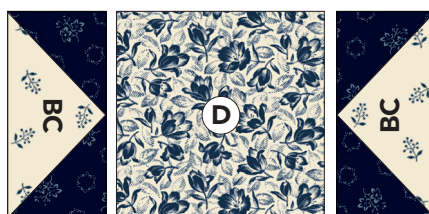
6. Star Block: Sew (1) Unit One to top and to bottom of (1) Center Unit. Square to 9-1/2". Make 18 Star Blocks. *Note proper rotation of Unit Ones.*

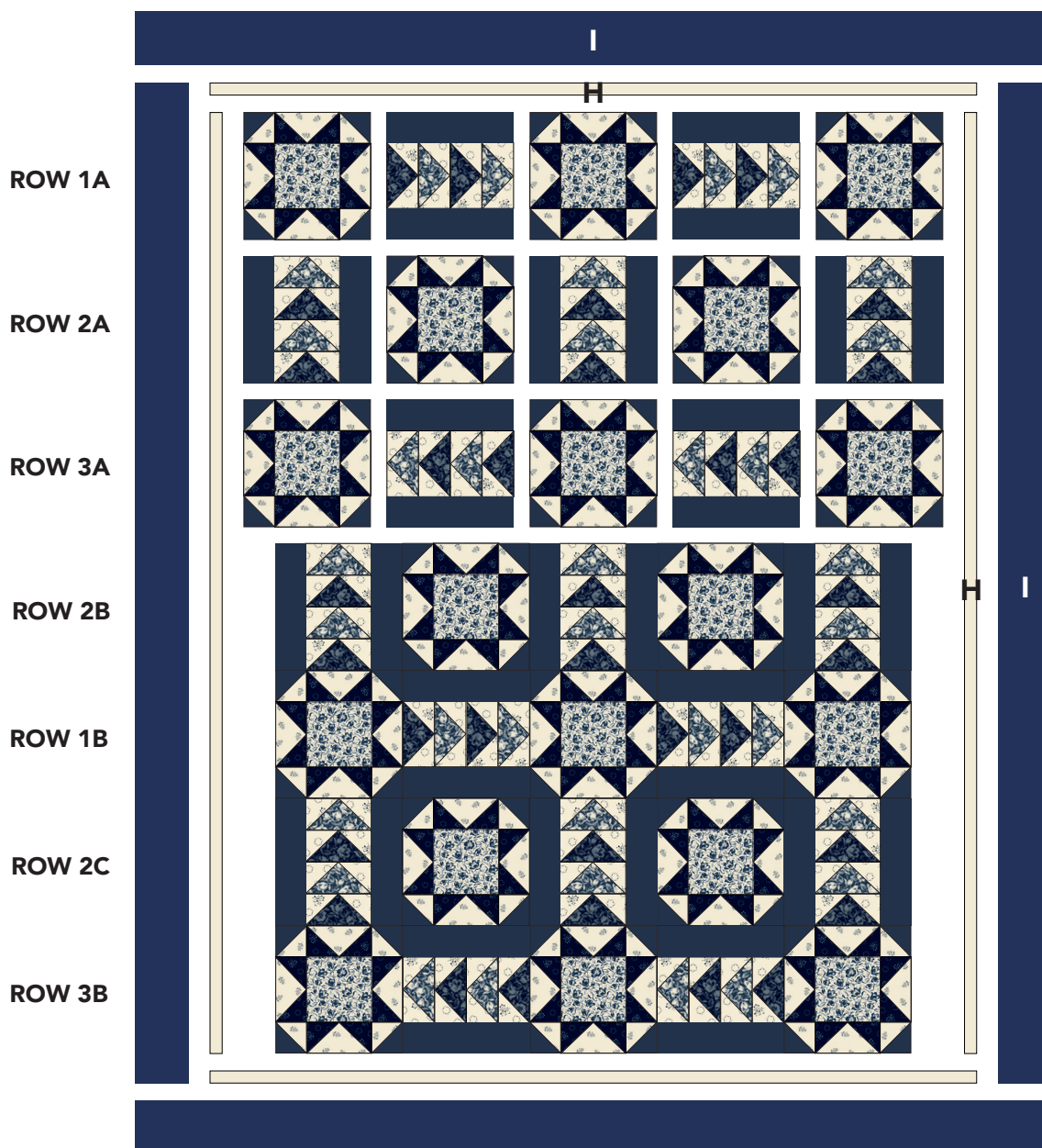
QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

7. Row Assembly: Sew Star Blocks and Flying Geese Blocks into (7) rows as shown in Quilt Diagram. *Note proper direction of Flying Geese Blocks.* Sew rows together to form quilt center.

8. H Inner Border: Sew (1) **H** 1-1/2" x 63-1/2" strip to opposite sides of quilt top. Sew (1) **H** 1-1/2" x 47-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt top.

9. I Outer Border: Sew (1) **I** 4-1/2" x 65-1/2" strip to opposite sides of quilt top. Sew (1) **I** 4-1/2" x 55-1/2" strip to top and bottom of quilt top.

QUILT DIAGRAM



FINISHING:

Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **C** 2-1/4" strips.
