Wall Quilt: 35 1/2" x 69"

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Happy Gatherings

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.


1. Cut the following:


If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut centers of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" tall x 12-1/2" wide

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 3" x 59" word stripe borders and (2) 5-3/4" x 36" pumpkin stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 4-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles

Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 4-1/2" squares then cut 4 squares in half diagonally  for a total of 8 triangles


Cut (4) 2-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 2-1/4" x 15" strips

Cut (3) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-3/4" x 12" strips

Fabrics D and E - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces and (2) 4-1/2" squares

Fabrics F and G - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 4-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles

Fabrics H and J - From each fabric:

Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips and (4) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

Fabric I - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (3) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 56-1/2" borders

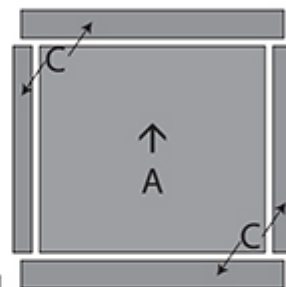
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 31" borders

Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 7" strips

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch Fabric C

1-3/4" x 12" strips to sides of a **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-1/4" x 15" **Fabric C** strips to top and bottom of panel.



Block 1 - Make 4

Trim bordered panel to 14-1/2" square (unfinished). Make a total of 4 **Block 1**.

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Sew a 4-1/2" **Fabric C** triangle centered on each side of a **Fabric I** 1-1/2" x 7" strip. Trim to 4-1/2" square (unfinished). In the same manner, make a total of 4 **Unit 1**.



Unit 1 - Make 4

3. Stitch **Fabrics C and F** 4-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 8 **Unit 2a** (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 **Unit 2b** with **Fabrics C and G** 4-7/8" triangles.

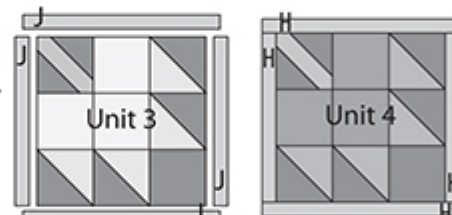
4. Arrange 1 **Unit 1**, 4 **Unit 2a**, 1 **Fabric C** 4-1/2" square, 1 **Fabric D** 4-1/2" square, and 1 **Fabric D**



Unit 3 - Make 2

Unit 4 - Make 2

4-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece in 3 vertical rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 **Unit 3** (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 **Unit 4** with fabrics and units shown.



Block 2 - Make 2

Block 3 - Make 2

5. Sew 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" **Fabric J** strips to opposite sides of a **Unit 3** as shown.

Add 1-1/2" x 14-1/2"

Fabric J strips to remaining sides. Make a total of 2 **Block 2** (14-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 **Block 3** by adding **Fabric H** strips to **Unit 4**.

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QUILT LAYOUT

Border measurements are the cut size.

Arrow indicates orientation of directional print.

6. Refer to Quilt Layout for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

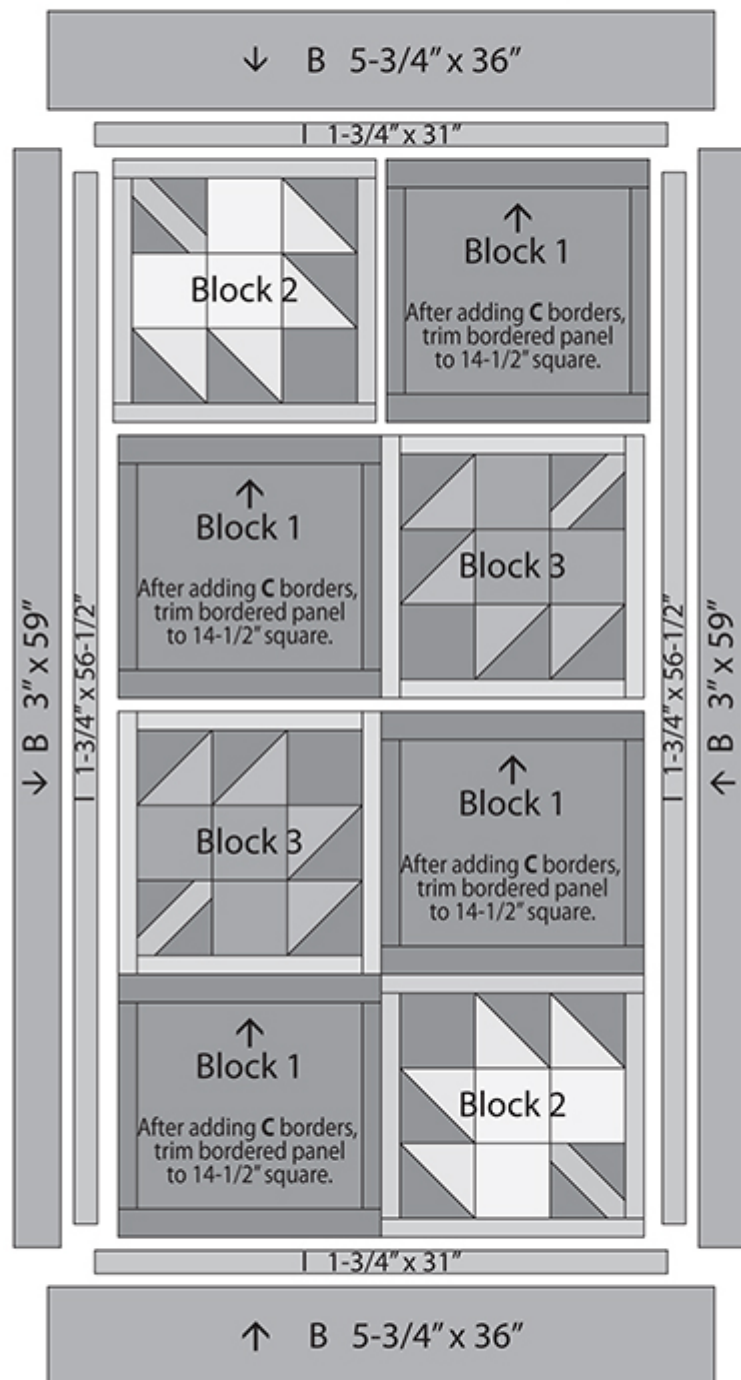
7. Arrange blocks in 4 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center ($28\frac{1}{2}'' \times 56\frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished).

8. Sew **Fabric I** $1\frac{3}{4}'' \times 56\frac{1}{2}''$ borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric I** $1\frac{3}{4}'' \times 31''$ borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

9. Sew **Fabric B** $3'' \times 59''$ borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric B** $5\frac{3}{4}'' \times 36''$ borders to top and bottom of quilt.

10. The quilt measures approximately $36'' \times 69\frac{1}{2}''$ (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

11. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric I**) and enjoy!!



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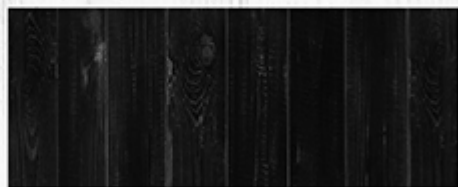
