Constructing Pieced Blocks

1. Star blocks. Finished Block Size: 8" x 8"

1a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **G** square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) 21/2" x 41/2" M rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Repeat with another 21/2" **G** square at the opposite corner of the same **M** rectangle to make a flying geese unit. Make a total of (4) flying geese units.



1b. Sew (2) flying geese units to the opposite sides of (1) 4¹/₂" **G** square to make a row unit.





1c. Sew (2) 2¹/₂" M squares to the opposite short sides of (1) flying geese unit to make a row unit. Make (2) row units. Sew together row units to make (1) M Star Block. Make an additional (4) N Star Blocks.

2. Appliqué blocks. Finished size: 8" x 8"

2a. Prepare tulip appliqué pieces using method of choice. Use appliqué block diagram for placement guide, arrange pieces on (1) 8¹/₂" K square. Once satisfied with placement, sew appliqué pieces in place using method of choice. Make a total of (4) blocks.



3. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (3) blocks to make a pieced row. Sew together pieced rows to complete quilt center, measuring 241/2" x 241/2" raw edge to raw edge.

Row 1 and 3: (2) tulip blocks and (1) star block.

Row 2: (3) star blocks.





Quilt Top Assembly

4. Inner border #1. Sew (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $24\frac{1}{2}$ " **M** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $26\frac{1}{2}$ " **M** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.






5. Inner border #2. Finished Block Size: 2" x 2"

5a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" **G** square. Place square, RST, on (1) 3" **K** square. Sew ¼" away from, on left and right sdies of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Align diagonal seam of HST units against 45 degree of quilting ruler, trim HST units to meausre 2½" x 2½" raw edge to raw edge. Make a total of (36) HST units.



5b. Arrange and sew together (8) HST units and (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " K squares to make a column. Make (2) columns and sew to opposite sides of quilt center.



5c. Arrange and sew together (10) HST units and (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " K squares to make a row. Make (2) rows and sew to remaining opposite sides of quilt center.









6. Inner border #3.

6a. Sew (2) $3'' \times 30\%''$ **O** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $3'' \times 35\%''$ **O** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.






7. Inner border #4. Finished block size: 5" x 5"

7a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{34}{}$ " **N** square. Place square, RST at a corner of (1) $1\frac{34}{}$ " x 3" **K** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{14}{}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **Fabric** corner triangle. Repeat with another $1\frac{34}{}$ " **N** square at the opposite corner of the same **K** rectangle to make (1) flying geese unit. Make a total of (4) flying geese units.



7b. Sew (2) flying geese units to the opposite sides of (1) 3" N square to make a row unit.





7c. Sew (2) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " **K** squares to the opposite short sides of (1) flying geese unit to make a row unit. Make (2) row units. Sew together row units to make (1) star blocks. Make a total of (4) blocks each for **N** and **P**. [Note: (1) block **N** made in previous step].







7d. Sew (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " K rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) P star block to make a column. Make (2) columns and sew to the opposite sides of quilt center.



7e. Sew (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " K rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) P star block to make a row. Add (2) N stars to the opposite short ends of the row. Make a total of (2) pieced rows, and sew to the top and bottom of quilt center.





8. Inner border #5. Finished Block Size: 2½" x 5" and 5" x 5".

8a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **H** square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) 3" x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " **M** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **H** corner triangle. Repeat with (3) additional $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **H** squares at the remaining corners of the same **M** rectangle to complete (1) block.





8b. Make a total of (24) blocks each for fabrics: H, I, N

[Note: (1) block **H** was already created in the previous step].

8c. Arrange and sew (18) blocks to make a column. Make a total of (2) columns, and sew to left and right sides of quilt center.



8d. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **H** square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " **M** square. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Repeat with additional (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **H** squares at the remaining corners of the same **M** square. Make a total of (4) square sewn units.













8e. Arrange and sew together (18) blocks made in Step 8a to make a top and bottom pieced row unit. Sew (2) square sewn units to the opposite short sides of row unit. Make a total of (2) row units and sew to the top and bottom of quilt center.



9. Inner border #6.

9a. Sew (2) $3'' \times 55\frac{1}{2}''$ **K** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $3'' \times 60\frac{1}{2}''$ **K** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.



10. Inner border #7. Finished Block Size: 3" x 3"

10a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 4" **A** square. Place square, RST, on (1) 4" **B** square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from, on right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) HST units. Align diagonal seam of HST units against 45 degree line on quilting ruler, trim HST units to measure $\frac{3}{2}$ " x $\frac{3}{2}$ " raw edge to raw edge.






10b. Make a total number of HST each for the following fabrics:



10c. [Designer's Note: Quilters are free to arrange HST block placement as they wish to mimic an antique scrappy look. Or, refer to the graphics below to match the layout of the quilt image on the cover]. Arrange and sew (20) HST units to make a pieced column. Make a total of (4) columns. Sew together (2) columns into (1) combined column. Make a total of (2) combined columns. Sew columns to left and right sides of quilt center.



10d. Arrange and sew together (24) HST units to make a pieced row. Make a total of (4) rows. Sew together (2) rows into (1) row. Make a total of (2) rows. Sew rows to the top and bottom of quilt center.





11. Inner border #8. Finished Block Size: 4" x 4".

11a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " J square. Place square, RST at a corner of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " K rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **fabric** corner triangle. Repeat with another (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " J square at the opposite corner of the same J rectangle to make (1) flying geese unit. Make a total of (4) flying geese units.




11b. Sew (2) flying geese to the opposite sides of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " J square to make a row unit.



11c. Sew (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **K** squares to the opposite short sides of (1) flying geese unit to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.



11d. Sew rows together to make (1) star block. Blocks should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " raw edge to raw edge. Make a total of (4) star blocks.




11e. Sew (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **O** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center.







11f. Sew (2) star blocks to the left and right sides of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $72\frac{1}{2}$ " **O** strip. Make (2) pieced strip sets, and add to the top and bottom of quilt center.



12. Inner border #9. Finished Block Size: 4" x 4".

12a. Sew together $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF **G** strip and $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF **K** strip. Make (6) strip sets. Cut pieced strip set at $4\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals. Each strip set should yield (9) blocks. Make a total of (52) blocks.

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
12b. Arrange and sew (13) blocks to make a column. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **G** rectangle to one end. Make (2) columns, and sew to the left and right sides of quilt center.







12c. Arrange and sew together (14) blocks to make a row. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **G** rectangle to one end. Sew (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **O** squares to the opposite short sides of pieced row. Make a total of (2) rows and sew to the top and bottom of quilt center.



13. Outer border. Finished Block Size: 4" x 4".

13a. Sew together $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF **J** strip and $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF **K** strip. Make (7) strip sets. Cut pieced strip set at $4\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals. Each strip set should yield (9) blocks. Make a total of (56) blocks.

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
13b. Arrange and sew (14) blocks to make a column. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " J rectangle and $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " K rectangle to one end. Make (2) columns, and sew to the left and right sides of quilt center.







13c. Arrange and sew together (14) blocks to make a row. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " J rectangle and $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " K rectangle to one end. Sew (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " O squares to the opposite short sides of pieced row. Make a total of (2) rows and sew to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Finishing

- **14.** With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich.
- **15.** Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired.
- **16.** Bind with **Fabric P** to finish quilt.
