| $21 / 3$ yards | Border Stripe - Cream (C) | $2282-33$ |
| $3 / 8$ yard | Mini Buffalo Check - Red (D) | $2289-88$ |
| $1 / 8$ yard | Diamond Weave - Cream (E) | $2287-34$ |
| $1 / 8$ yard | Mini Buffalo Check - Cream (F) | $2289-33$ |
| $3 / 8$ yard | Diamond Weave - Gold (G) | $2287-44$ |
| $2 / 3$ yard | Mini Squiggle - Black (H) | $2284-99$ |
| $11 / 4$ yards | Floating Geo - Cream (I) | $2288-34$ |
| 1 yard | Basket Weave - Red (J) | $2286-88^{*}$ |
| $3 / 8$ yard | Mini Cross - Red (K) | $2285-88$ |
| $3 / 8$ yard | Mini Buffalo Check - Cream/Red (L) $2289-44$ |  |

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel - Cream (A), cut:

- (1) 36 " $\times 36$ " square.

From the Mini Cross - Black (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x 36" WOF strips.
-(2) $3 " x 41 "$ WOF strips.
From the Border Stripe - Cream (C), fussy cut:
-(4) $3 \frac{3}{4}$ " $\times 401 / 2 "$ length of fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on large snowflakes.


## From the Mini Buffalo Check - Red (D), cut:

-(3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (26) $21 / 2 " x 41 / 2 "$ strips.

## From the Diamond Weave - Cream (E), cut:

-(1) $21 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 8 " \times 33 / 4 "$ strips.
From the Mini Buffalo Check - Cream (F), cut:
-(1) $21 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 8 " \times 33 / 4 "$ strips.
From the Diamond Weave - Gold (G), cut:

- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 47$ " strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 49$ " strips.


## From the Mini Squiggle - Black (H), cut:

- (3) $31 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $31 / 4 " \times 541 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $31 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $31 / 4 " \times 49 "$ strips.

From the Floating Geo - Cream (I), cut:
-(15) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (232) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Basket Weave - Red (J), cut:

- (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
- (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $21 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Mini Cross - Red (K), cut:
-(4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Mini Buffalo Check - Cream/Red (L), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Novelty Toss - Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) 70 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 70 " $\times 70$ " back.


## Block Assembly

Center Block

1. Sew (1) 3 " $\times 36$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the $36^{\prime \prime} \times 36$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 3" x 41" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $401 / 2$ " square to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric I square on the left side of (1) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.

3. Place another $21 / 2 "$ Fabric I square on the right side of the $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip, right sides together (Fig. 4).
Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (30) Unit 1 strips total.

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5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 6-8 for fabric identification, location and seam direction to make (30) Unit 2 strips, (30) Unit 3 strips and (26) Unit 4 strips.

6. Repeat Steps 2-3, refer to Figures 9-10 and use (16) $21 / 8$ " Fabric J squares, (4)
$21 / 8 " \times 33 / 4 "$ Fabric F strips and (4) $21 / 8 " \times 33 / 4 "$ Fabric E strips to make (4) Unit 5 strips and (4) Unit 6 strips.

8. Sew (27) assorted strips together lengthwise to make the Top Border (Fig. 12 below).
9. Sew (27) assorted strips together lengthwise to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 13 below).
7. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to the top of (1) Unit 6 strip lengthwise as shown in Figure 11 to make (1) Unit 7 square. Repeat to make (4) Unit 7 squares total.
10. Sew (31) assorted strips together lengthwise to make the Left Border (Fig. 14 below).
11. Sew (31) assorted strips together lengthwise to make the Right Border (Fig. 15 below).

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
12. Sew (1) $33 / 4 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to each end of (1) $33 / 4 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 47 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 49 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) $31 / 4 " \times 49 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $31 / 4 " \times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew the Left, Right, Top and Bottom Borders to the Center Block to make the quilt top.
16. Layer and quilt as desired.
17. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
18. Bind as desired.
