Table Topper: 59" square

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all of fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 9" x 63" multi-stripe borders

Fabrics C and D - From each fabric: Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces


Fabrics E and H - From each fabric: Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (10) 4-1/2" squares. Cut remaining strip into (1) 2-1/2" and (1) 2" strips, subcut those into (10) 2-1/2" squares and (8) 2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (8) 2" strip, subcut (24) 2" x 12-1/2" strips

Fabric G - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (6) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 12" and (8) 1-1/4" x 13" strips

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch Fabric G 1-1/4" x 12" strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 13" Fabric G strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished). Make a total of 4 Block 1.

2. Arrange 2 Fabric D Н D C E 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces, 1 **Fabric H** 4-1/2" square, Е D Н and 1 Fabric H 2-1/2" square Unit 1 Unit 2 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch Make 10 Make 10 into rows. Sew rows together.

Make a total of 10 Unit 1 (6-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 10 Unit 2 with fabrics indicated.

- 3. Arrange 2 each Units 1 and 2 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 Block 2 (12-1/2" square unfinished).


- 4. Refer to Table Topper Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of blocks, strips, squares, and borders.
- 5. Arrange blocks, Fabric F 2" x 12-1/2" strips and 2" Fabrics E and H squares in 7 rows. Sew into rows. Join rows to complete the 42-1/2" x 42-1/2" topper center.
- 6. Center Fabric B 9" x 63" borders on all sides of topper center with gray stripe next to topper 1/4" center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping detail 1/4" from corners of topper center. Do not trim. Press 8 Quilt borders out. $^{\downarrow}$ Center

- 7. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the topper right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.
- 8. The table topper measures approximately 59-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric G) and enjoy!!
