Fabric Requirements

1 panel ($\frac{2}{3}$ yard) Panel-CM6958 Sage

$\frac{5}{8}$ yard Holiday-CM5168 Green
(includes $\frac{3}{8}$ yard for binding)

$\frac{1}{8}$ yard each:

Dot-CM9528 White

Holiday-CM6964 Snow

Holiday-CM6961 Holly

Hatch-CM2959 White

Holiday-CM5166 Natural

Holiday-CM6960 White

Holiday-CM6103 Cream

Holiday-CM6102 Cream

Holiday-CM6962 Pine

$1\frac{1}{8}$ yards Holiday-CM6963 Cream

$2\frac{1}{2}$ yards Holiday-CM6959 Cream (backing)

44" x 53" batting

This special panel offers two quilts for the price of one—this one uses the tree portion and the Seasonal Squares quilt uses the squares.

Cutting

From Panel-CM6958 Sage:

- Trim the panel to $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x $31\frac{1}{2}$ " with Christmas tree in the center.

From Holiday-CM5168 Green:

- Cut four 1" x width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut two 1" x $22\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and two 1" x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Sub-cut four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Cut five $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for binding.

From Dot-CM9528 White:

- Cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From both Holiday-CM6964 Snow and Holiday-CM6961 Holly:

- Cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut eight $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From each of Hatch-CM2959 White, Holiday-CM5166 Natural, Holiday-CM6960 White, Holiday-CM6103 Cream, Holiday-CM6102 Cream and Holiday-CM6962 Pine:

- Cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut twelve $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From Holiday-CM6963 Cream:

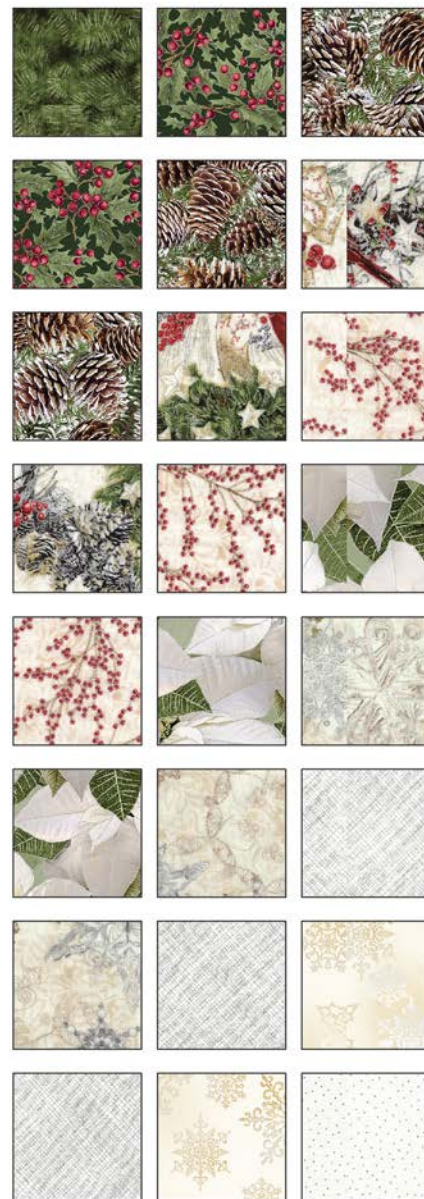
- Cut two $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x length-of-fabric (LOF) strips, centering the border repeat.

Quilt Top Assembly

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " and pieces are sewn right sides together.

1. Sew one 1" x $22\frac{1}{2}$ " CM5168 Green strip to the top and another to the bottom of the CM6958 Sage panel. Sew one 1" x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " CM5168 Green strip to each side of the panel.
2. Make four strip sets [SS] of each $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square fabric grouping in the order shown (figure 1). Sew the squares together in each row, pressing the seams of adjacent strip sets in alternate directions. Sew the rows together in order, matching adjacent seams.



Imagination... Passion... Creativity

- Invert a second pieced strip set and sew SS8 below the previous SS8 row so that the bottom half goes from SS8 to SS1 at the lower edge (figure 2). Make two 16-row columns.

Quilt Top Assembly

- Refer to the quilt photo for orientation and sew one strip set column to each side of the panel. Note that the light fabrics should face the center tree panel.
- Measure the quilt width and trim the two 6½" x LOF CM6963 Cream strips to that measurement. Sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt top center.

Finishing

- Layer the quilt top, batting and backing, and quilt as desired.
- Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
