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Floral Serenade

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvege to selvege, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut (4) 5-1/2" x 89" lengthwise border strips

Fabric B - Cut (6) 6-1/8" strips, subcut (18) 6-1/8" x 11-7/8" pieces

Cut (5) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (9) 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces and (18) 4-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (2) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (9) 4-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally for 18 triangles] and (5) 4-1/2" squares
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips

Fabric D - Cut (3) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (18) 4-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 36 triangles

Fabric E - Cut (2) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (9) 4-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally for 18 triangles] and (4) 4-1/2" squares
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips

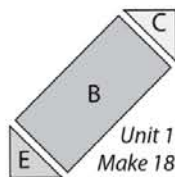
Fabric F - Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (9) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice for 36 triangles
Cut (4) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (36) 4-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (9) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice for 36 triangles
Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

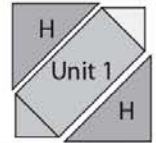
Fabric H - Cut (5) 8-7/8" strips, subcut (18) 8-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 36 triangles
Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips
Cut (8) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 72-1/2" and (2) 2" x 75-1/2" borders

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew a **Fabric E** 4-7/8" triangle to one short end of a **Fabric B** 6-1/8" x 11-7/8" piece, and a **Fabric C** 4-7/8" triangle to the other short end to make Unit 1. Make 18 Unit 1.



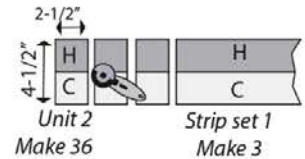
2. Stitch 2 **Fabric H** 8-7/8" triangles to long sides of Unit 1 to complete **Block A**. Make 18 **Block A** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block A - Make 18

3. Stitch a **Fabric C** 2-1/2" x WOF strip to a **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x WOF strip to make Strip set 1. Repeat to make 3 Strip set 1 (4-1/2" x WOF unfinished).

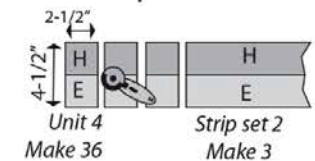
4. Cut a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece from Strip set 1 to make Unit 2. Repeat to make 36 Unit 2.



5. Arrange 2 Unit 2 as shown and stitch together to make Unit 3. Make 18 Unit 3 (4-1/2" square unfinished).



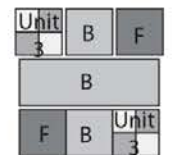
6. Repeat Step 3 using **Fabric E** in place of **Fabric C** to make 3 Strip set 2. Then in the same manner as Step 4, cut a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece from Strip set 2 to make Unit 4. Make 36 Unit 4.



7. In the same manner as Step 5, use 2 Unit 4 to make Unit 5. Make 18 Unit 5.

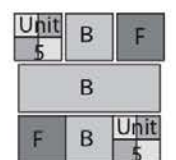


8. Arrange 1 **Fabric B** 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" piece, 2 **Fabric B** 4-1/2" squares, 2 **Fabric F** 4-1/2" squares, and 2 Unit 3 into 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows then sew rows together to make **Block B**. Make 4 **Block B** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block B - Make 4

9. In the same manner as Step 8, use 1 **Fabric B** 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" piece, 2 **Fabric B** 4-1/2" squares, 2 **Fabric F** 4-1/2" squares, and 2 Unit 5 to make **Block C**. Make 5 **Block C**.



Block C - Make 5

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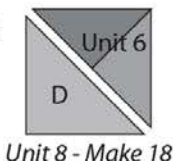
10. Stitch the right short edge of a **Fabric F** 5-1/4" triangle to the left short edge of a **Fabric G** 5-1/4" triangle to make Unit 6. Make 18 Unit 6.



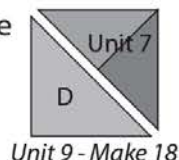
11. Stitch the right short edge of a **Fabric G** 5-1/4" triangle to the left short edge of a **Fabric F** 5-1/4" triangle to make Unit 7. Make 18 Unit 7.



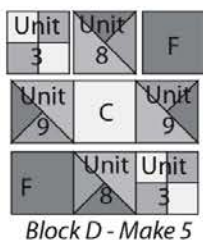
12. Stitch a **Fabric D** 4-7/8" triangle to the long edge of Unit 6 to make Unit 8. Make 18 Unit 8 (4-1/2" square unfinished).



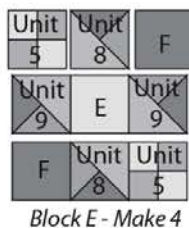
13. Stitch a **Fabric D** 4-7/8" triangle to the long edge of Unit 7 to make Unit 9. Make 18 Unit 9 (4-1/2" square unfinished).



14. Arrange 1 **Fabric C** 4-1/2" square, 2 **Fabric F** 4-1/2" squares, 2 Unit 3, 2 Unit 8, and 2 Unit 9 into 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows, then sew rows together to make **Block D**. Make 5 **Block D** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



15. In the same manner as Step 14, use 1 **Fabric E** 4-1/2" square, 2 **Fabric F** 4-1/2" squares, 2 Unit 5, 2 Unit 8 and 2 Unit 9 to make **Block E**. Make 4 **Block E** (12-1/2" square unfinished).

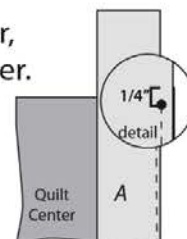


16. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and rows.

17. Arrange blocks in 6 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (72-1/2" square unfinished).

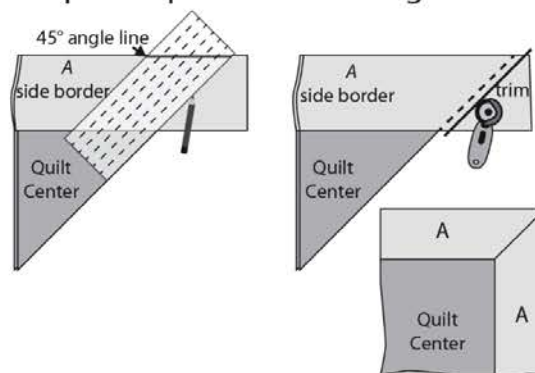
18. Sew **Fabric H** 2" x 72-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 2" x 75-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

19. Center **Fabric A** 5-1/2" x 89" borders on all sides of quilt center, with navy edge next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in Italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

20. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



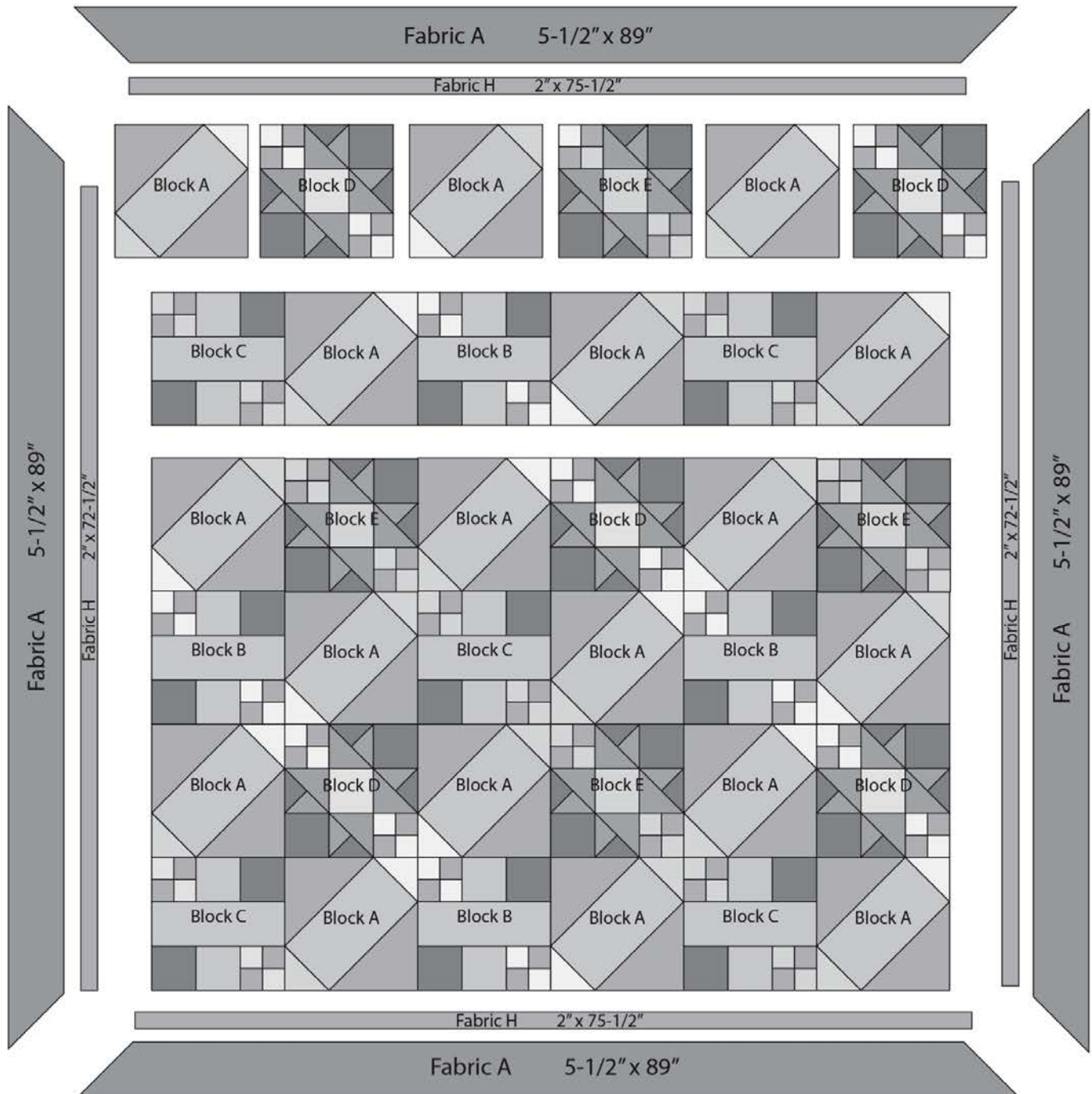
21. The quilt measures approximately 85-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

22. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

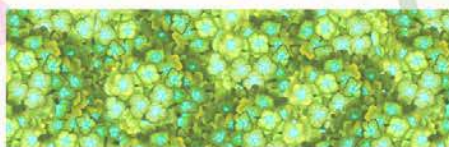
