Throw Quilt: 48" x 69"

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Hidden Valley

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.



1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 6" x 45-1/2" scenic stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (2) 12-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 12-1/2" squares and (2) 9-1/2" wide x 11" tall pieces

Cut (1) 7-1/4" strips, subcut (2) 7-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 8 triangles] and (4) 6-7/8" squares [then cut 2 in half diagonally in 1 direction and 2 in the opposite direction for 8 triangles] 

Fabric D - Cut (1) 6-3/4" strip, subcut (4) 6-3/4" squares


Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 2-3/4" x 24" strips and (1) 2" x 16" strip

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (2) 2" strips, sewn together end to end with the 2" x 16" strip and cut into (2) 2" x 47" strips

Fabric E - Cut (10) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 66-1/2", (2) 2" x 48-1/2", and (4) 2" x 45-1/2" borders

Fabric F - Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 6-1/2" squares and (4) 5" squares

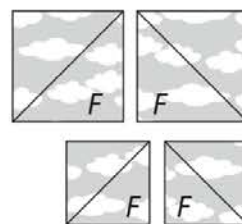
Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 3-7/8" squares [cut 2 in half diagonally in 1 direction and 2 in the opposite direction for 8 triangles]  and (4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips
Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (2) 2" x 9-1/2" strips

NOTE: Fabric F is directional with clouds running horizontally.

NOTE: Not all Fabric C 7-1/4" x 6-7/8" triangles are used.

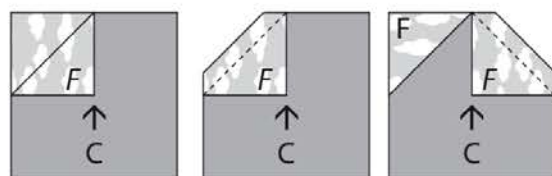
2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of (4) 6-1/2" and (2) 5" **Fabric F** squares in 1 direction and a diagonal line in the opposite direction on (4) 6-1/2" and (2) 5" **Fabric F** squares.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Print indicates orientation of directional print.

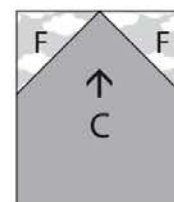
2. Arrange a marked **Fabric F** 6-1/2" square right sides together on a **Fabric C** 12-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on adjoining corner as shown. Make a total of 4 **Block 1** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 4

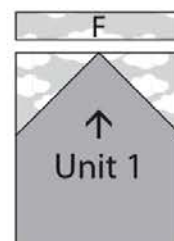
Arrows indicate orientation of directional print.

3. Referring to Step 2, make 4 Unit 1 (9-1/2" x 11" unfinished) by adding **Fabric F** 5" squares to adjoining corners of **Fabric C** 9-1/2" x 11" pieces to create triangles.



Unit 1 - Make 2

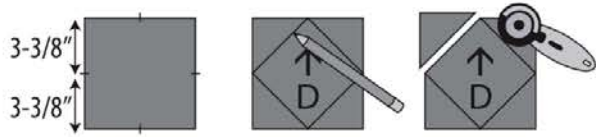
4. Sew a **Fabric F** 2" x 9-1/2" strip to top of a Unit 1. Make a total of 2 **Block 2** (9-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).



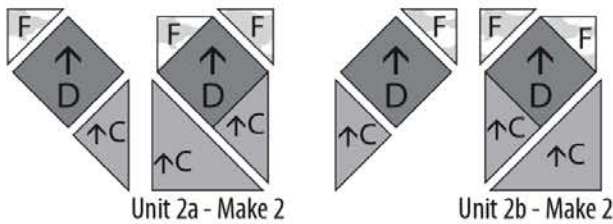
Block 2 - Make 2

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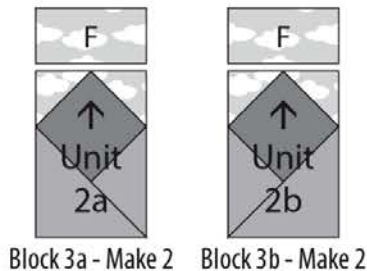
5. Mark the center point on all sides of a 6-3/4" **Fabric D** square as shown. Draw diagonal lines from mark to mark. Trim corners from square. Repeat for a total of 4 trimmed **D** squares (4-3/4" square unfinished).



6. Sew 1 each **Fabric F** 3-7/8" triangle and **Fabric C** 7-1/4" triangle to opposite sides of a trimmed **Fabric D** square as shown. Add 1 each **Fabric F** 3-7/8" triangle and **Fabric C** 6-7/8" triangle to opposite sides as shown. Make a total of 2 each Units 2a and 2b (6-1/2" x 9-1/2" unfinished).



7. Add a **Fabric F** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" to top of Units 2a and 2b to complete 2 each **Blocks 3a** and **3b** (9-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).



8. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.

9. Stitch **Fabric D** 2-3/4" x 24" strips to short sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2" x 47" **Fabric D** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 25-1/2" x 45-1/2" (unfinished).*

10. Arrange bordered panel, blocks, **Fabric E** 2" x 45-1/2" borders, and **Fabric B** 6" x 45-1/2" borders in 9 rows. Stitch blocks into rows (12-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished). Sew rows together to complete quilt center (45-1/2" x 66-1/2" unfinished).

11. Sew **Fabric E** 2" x 66-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric E** 2" x 48-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

12. The quilt measures approximately 48-1/2" x 69-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric G**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

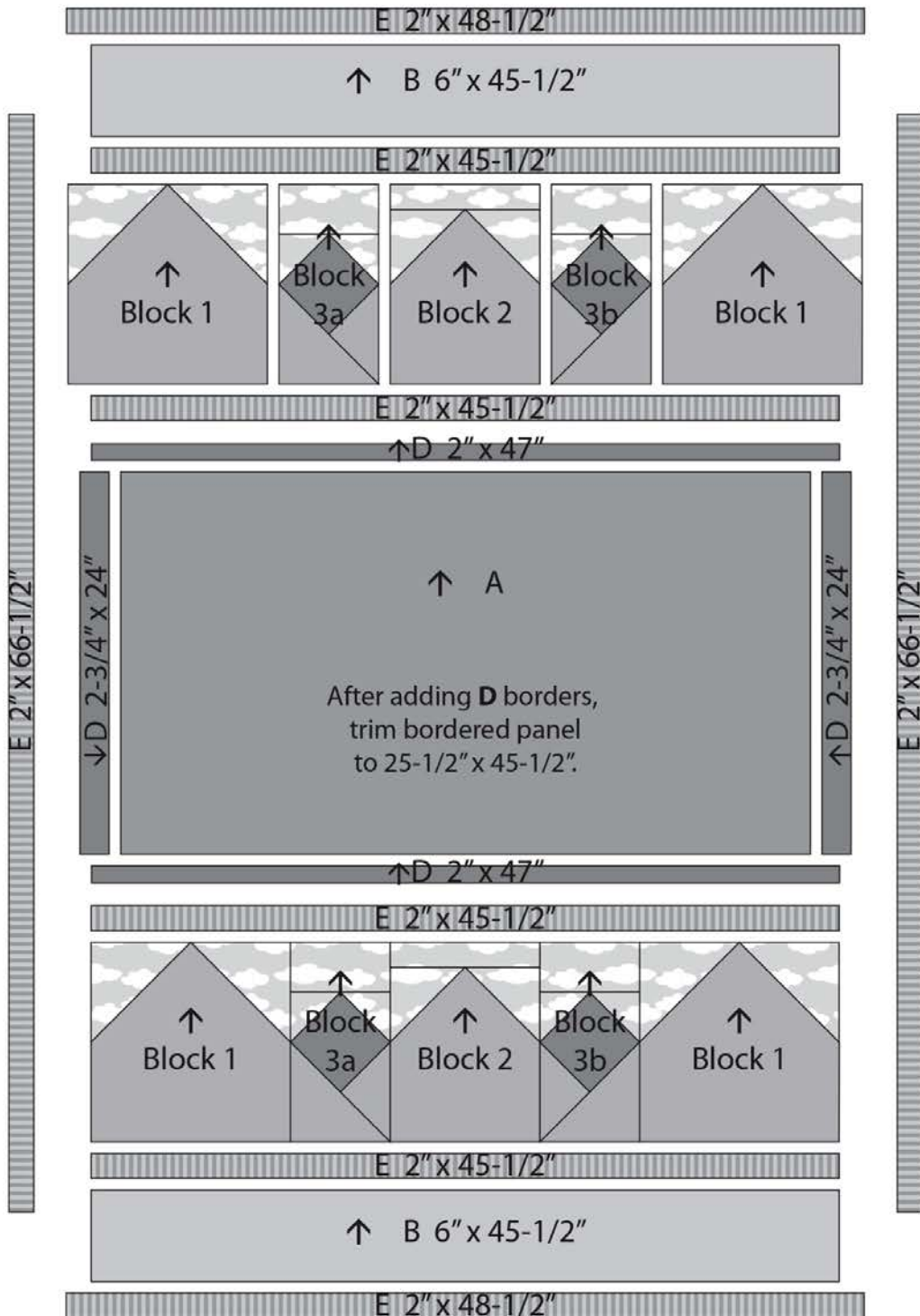
13. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!

Arrows, print, and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.
