Wilmington Prints: A World of Possibilities



Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 6" x 53" gnome stripe borders

Fabric B - Cut (1) 13" strip, subcut (4) 8" x 13" pieces

Fabric C - Cut (1) 8" strip, subcut (5) 8" squares

Fabric D - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (20) 3" squares

Fabric E - Cut (7) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 5-1/2" x 8" pieces and (16) 5-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (20) 3" squares

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric G - Cut (7) 3" strips, subcut (16) 3" x 8" strips and (40) 3" squares

Fabric H - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (8) 3" x 8" strips

Cut (6) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 66-1/2" and (2) 3" x 58" borders


Cut (3) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 53" borders

2. Piecing Order:

1. Arrange 2 **Fabric G** and 1 each **Fabrics D** and **F** 3" squares in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 20 Unit 1 (5-1/2" square unfinished).




2. Arrange 4 Unit 1, 4 Fabric E 5-1/2" x 8" pieces, and 1 Fabric C 8" square in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 Block 1 (18" square unfinished).



3. Sew **Fabrics G** and **H** 3" x 8" strips together lengthwise as shown. Make a total of 8 Unit 2 (5-1/2" x 8" unfinished).



4. Arrange 4 Fabric E 5-1/2" squares, 2 Unit 2, 2 Fabric G 3" x 8" strips, and 1 Fabric B 8" x 13 piece in 3 vertical rows. Stitch into vertical rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 2 (18" square unfinished).



Stripes and arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

5. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

6. Arrange blocks in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (53" square unfinished).

7. Sew **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 53" borders to top and bottom of quilt center. Add **Fabric A** 6" x 53" borders to top and bottom of **Fabric H** borders.

8. Sew **Fabric H** 3" x 66-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric H** 3" x 58" borders to top and bottom of quilt.


The quilt measures approximately
 71-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing
 (Fabric I) approximately 8" larger than the top.

10. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric F**) and enjoy!!
