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h a 5" charm square?





Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side.



Sew ¼" on each side of the line.



Cut apart on the diagonal line.



Press open to make 2 half square triangles. 41/2"x 41/2" with seams






Place 2-5"x 5" right side together



Stitch a scant 1/4' seam on outside edges Cut in half



Press open to make 2 "pieced" charms 4½"x5" with seams



 $\frac{1}{4}$ yard = 8 squares

1 fat quarter = 12 squares

 $\frac{1}{2}$ yard = 24 squares

 $\frac{3}{4}$ yard = 40 squares

1 yard = 56 squares






Place 2 "pieced" charms right side together (nest seams)



Stitch a scant 1/4" seam on outside edges Cut in half



Press open to make 2–4 patch blocks 41/2"x 41/2" with seams


