Cutting Notes: Mark and store your cutting pieces according to the block they have been assigned to, as this will make it much easier when you start piecing. Be sure to read the entire pattern before you begin. Appliqué techniques required.

A		50087-42 White on White BEDROCK COLLECTION	3½	QUILT CENTER PATCH BLOCKS: (2) 8½" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 8½" squares. QUILT CENTER PIECED BLOCKS: (1) 9¼" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 9¼" squares; cut squares twice diagonally to yield (8) QST. INNER BORDER #1: (5) 2½" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 2½" x 40½" strips from (2) strips. Piece the remaining (3) strips and subcut (2) 2½" x 44½" strips. INNER BORDER #2: (26) 2½" x WOF strips. Subcut (416) 2½" squares. INNER BORDER #3: (7) 2½" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2½" x 60½" strips, (2) 2½" x 64½" strips.
B		51613-1 White	1	OUTER BORDER: (7) 4" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 4" x 67½" strips, (2) 4" x 74½" strips.
C		51614-3 Lavender	¾	QUILT CENTER PIECED BLOCK (1), INNER BORDER #2 PIECED BLOCKS (6): (1) 9¼" x WOF strip. Subcut (1) 9¼" square. Subcut the 9¼" square diagonally twice to yield (4) QST (you will only use 2 in the center). (6) 4½" squares.
D		51615-3 Lavender	½	QUILT CENTER PIECED BLOCKS (2), INNER BORDER #2 PIECED BLOCKS (11): (1) 9¼" x WOF strip. Subcut (1) 9¼" square. Subcut 9¼" square diagonally twice to yield (4) QST. (11) 4½" squares. APPLIQUE PIECES: Pieces for (1) teacup using provided templates.

Subcut the 9 1/4" square diagonally twice to yield (4) QST (you will only use 2). (12) 4 1/2" squares.</p> <p>APPLIQUE PIECES: Pieces for (1) teacup and flower center using provided templates.</p>
F		51615-5 Blueberry	1/2	<p>QUILT CENTER PIECED BLOCKS (2), INNER BORDER #2 PIECED BLOCKS (10): (1) 9 1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut (1) 9 1/4" square. Subcut the 9 1/4" square diagonally twice to yield (4) QST. (10) 4 1/2" squares.</p> <p>APPLIQUE PIECES: Pieces for (1) flower using provided templates.</p>

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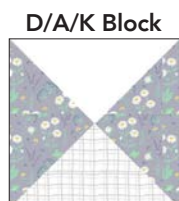

Subcut the 9¼" square diagonally twice to yield (4) QST (you will only use 2 in the center). (9) 4½" squares. APPLIQUE PIECES: Pieces for (1) teacup saucer using provided templates.
M		51618-10 Chamomile	¾	INNER BORDER #2 PIECED BLOCKS (5): (1) 4½" x WOF strip. Subcut (5) 4½" squares. APPLIQUE PIECES: Pieces for (1) teapot using provided templates.

BINDING: (7) 2¼" x WOF strips. Piece strips together to form a continuous binding strip.

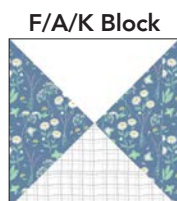
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Constructing Quilt Center Pieced Blocks

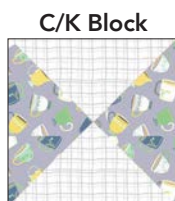
1. Arrange and sew together (4) QST to complete (1) pieced block. Make a total number of blocks for each fabric combination. Square to 8½".



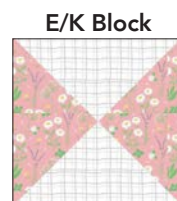

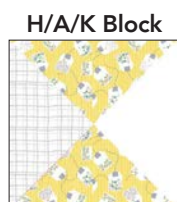

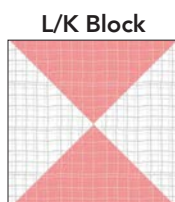
2. Arrange and sew together (4) QST to complete (1) pieced block. Make a total number of blocks for each fabric combination. Square to 8½".



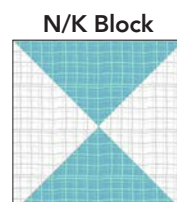

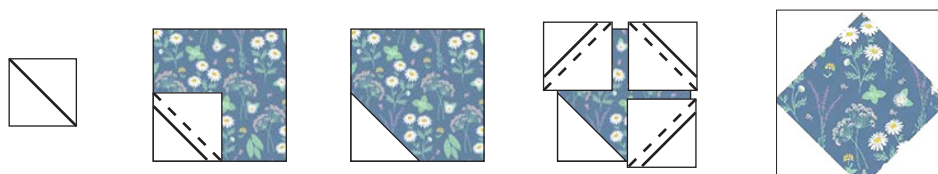

Constructing Inner Border #2 Pieced Blocks

3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2½" **A** square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) 4½" **F** square. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¼" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat with (3) additional 2½" **A** squares at the remaining (3) corners of the same **F** square.



4. Make a total number of blocks for the following <prints>:

(12) blocks: **E**

(11) blocks: **D, I, J**

(10) blocks: **F, H, O**

(9) blocks: **L, N**

(6) blocks: **C**

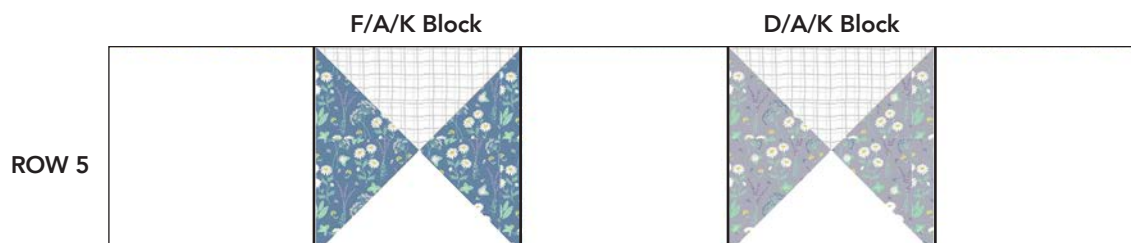
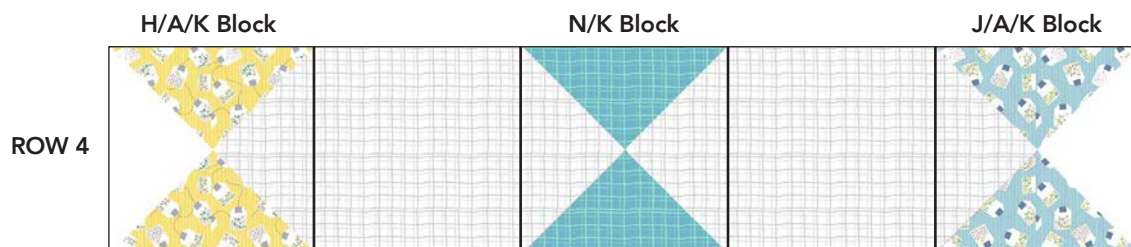
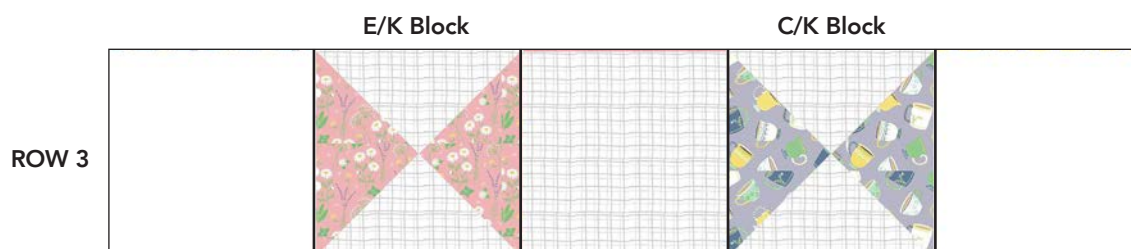
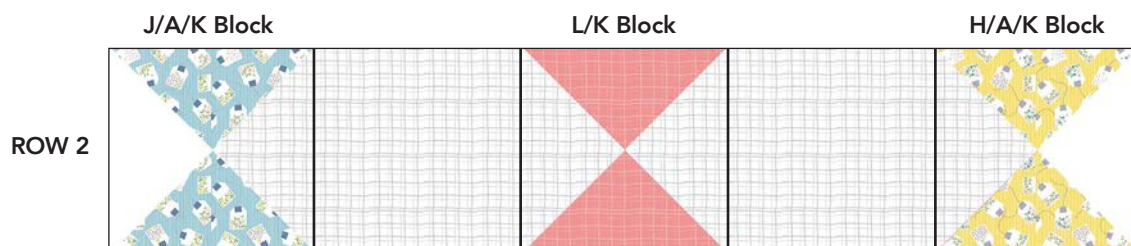
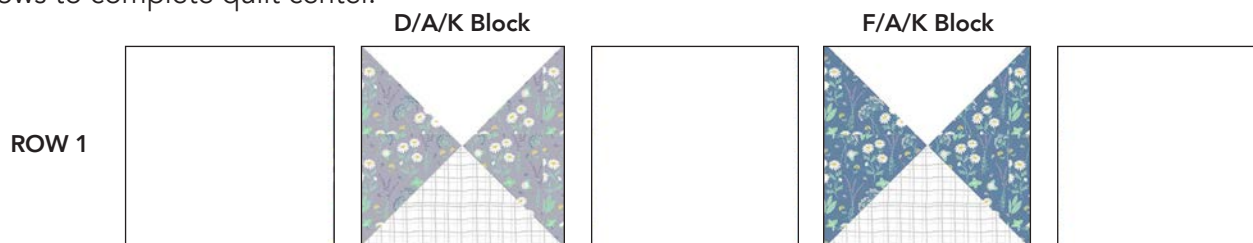

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Quilt Center Assembly

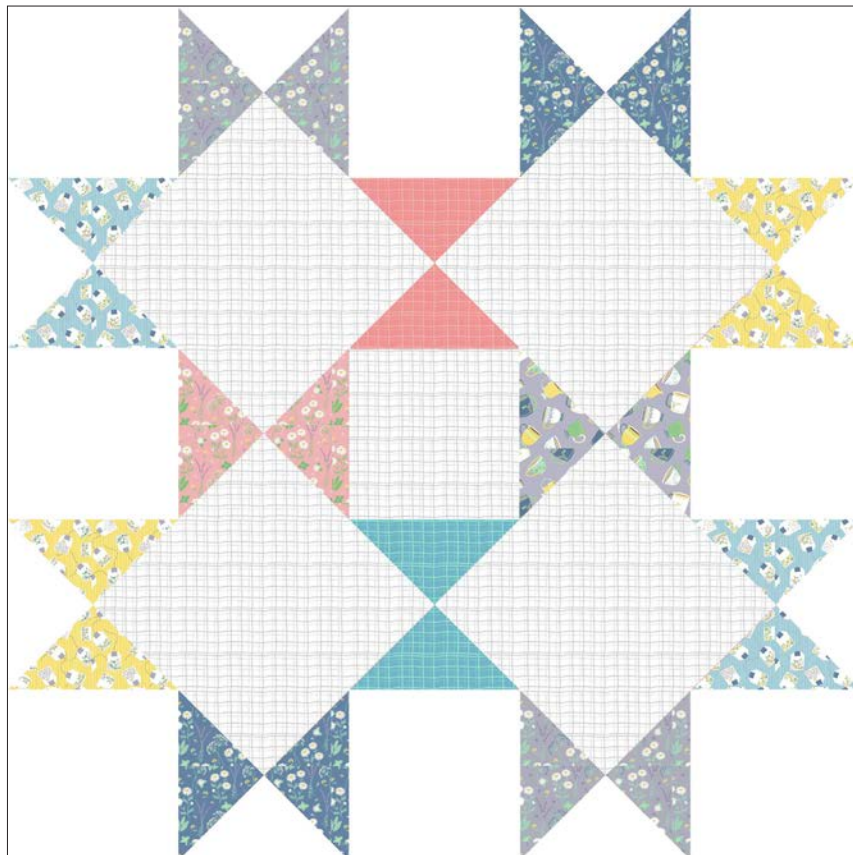
5. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together a total of (5) blocks to make a pieced row (pieced and patch blocks, when appropriate). Make a total of (5) pieced rows. Rows are shown below. Sew together pieced rows to complete quilt center.





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6. Appliqué. Prepare appliqué pieces using method of choice. Refer to quilt image for placement guide, arrange teapot, teacup and flower appliqué pieces on quilt center. Once happy with placement, sew pieces in place using appliqué method of choice.



Quilt Top Assembly

7. Inner border #1. Sew (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.

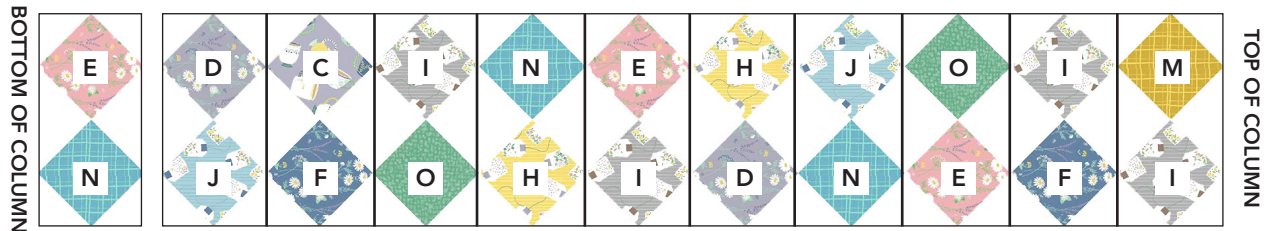




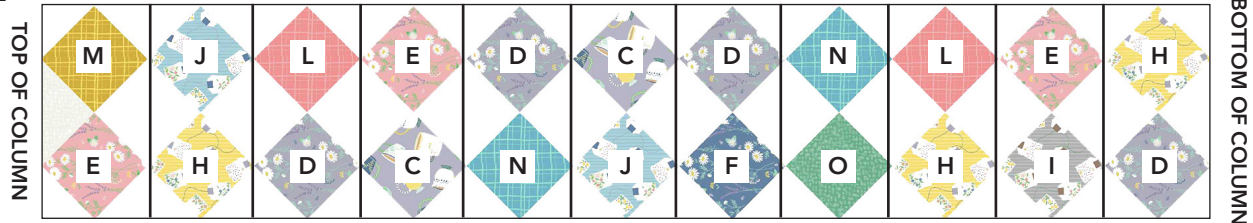
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8. Inner border #2. Arrange and sew together (22) pieced blocks to make a pieced 2x11 column unit. Make (2) column units and sew to the left and right sides of quilt center. Refer to the diagrams below for reference. Then, arrange and sew together (30) pieced blocks to make a pieced 2x15 row unit. Make (2) row units and sew to top and bottom of quilt center. Refer to diagrams on Page 8 for reference.

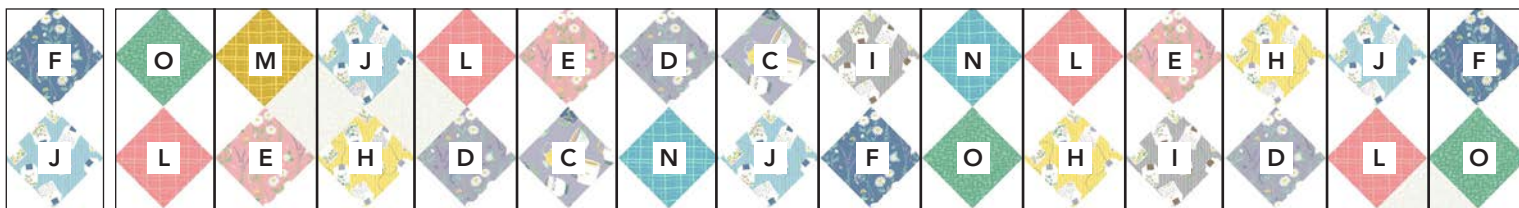

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9. Inner border #3. Sew (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

10. Inner border #4. Sew (2) 2" x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " **G** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2" x $67\frac{1}{2}$ " **G** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

11. Outer border. Sew (2) 4" x $67\frac{1}{2}$ " **B** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 4" x $74\frac{1}{2}$ " **B** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Finishing

12. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich.

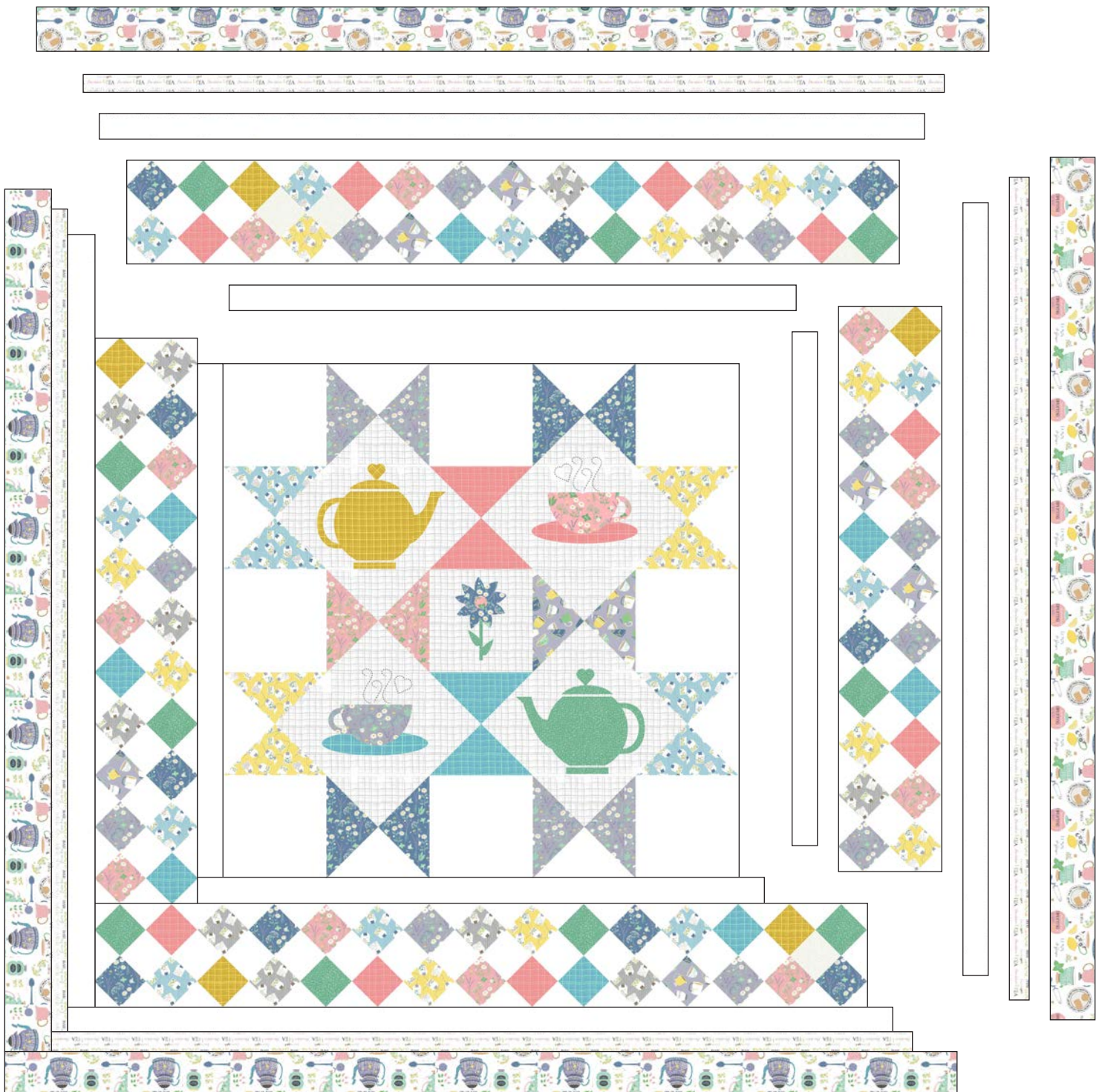
13. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired.

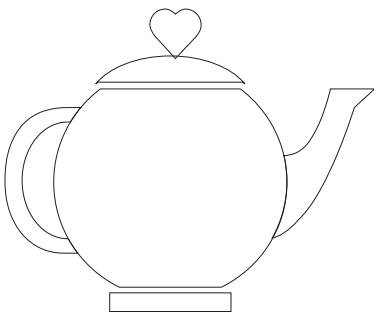
14. Bind with **Fabric N** to finish quilt.

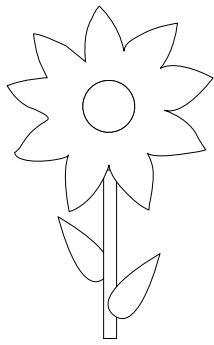

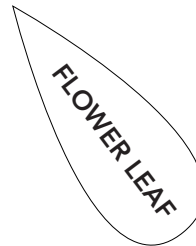

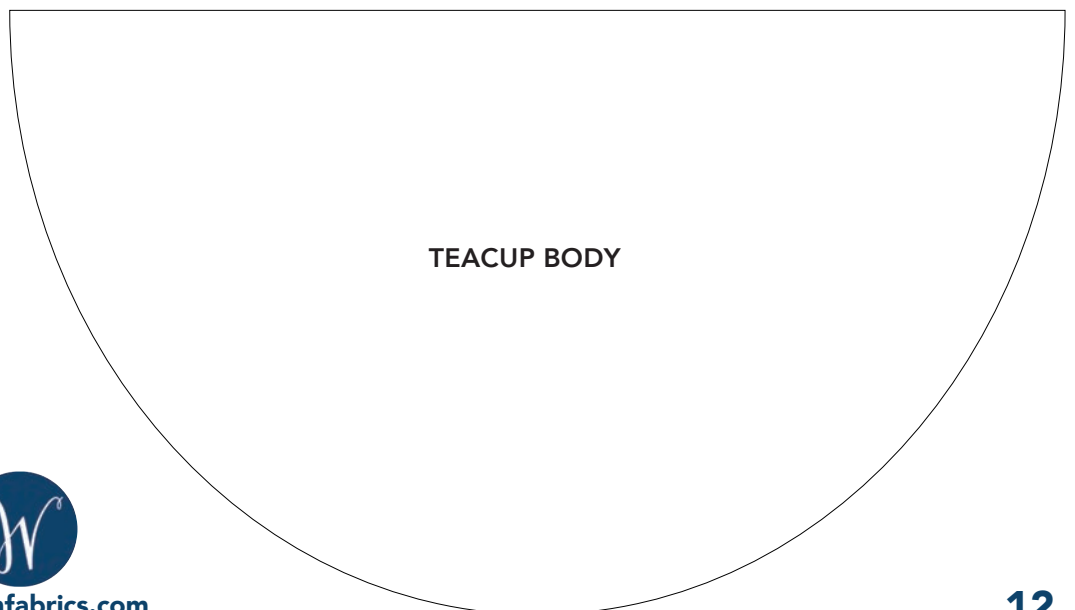
