### **Fabric Requirements**

- **F1**  $\frac{1}{4}$  yd. for flying geese and half square triangles
- $F2 \frac{1}{3}$  yd. for flying geese, half square triangles and corner triangles
- **F3** F8 for flying geese and corner blocks
- **F4** F6 for flying geese
- **F5** F6 for flying geese and corner blocks
- **F6** F6 for flying geese and center square

### Cutting

- **F1** Cut 8 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares and 6 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 3<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares
- **F2** Cut 6  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, 4  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles  $2 - 67_{\text{s}}$ " x  $67_{\text{s}}$ " squares, cut once diagonally
- **F3** Cut 4  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and 4  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- **F4** Cut 8  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- **F5** Cut 4  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and 4  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- **F6** Cut 1  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " center square, 8  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares





wrong sid

Using a mechancial pencil draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of assorted F3 squares.

Stitch on marked line.
F2
Trim top layer leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Do not trim away background fabric.
F2
Press toward corner.
Repeat steps with a second square charm.





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Using a mechanical pencil draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light squares.



Stitch a scant 1/4" on opposite sides of marked line. Cut on marked line. Trim units to measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " with seams. Press seams open.



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Yields 2 HSTs.
