ALL OUR STARS

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 12 panels to approximately 7-1/4" x 9-1/2" (note page number of each panel)

Fabric C - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 27-1/2" cloud/word stripe borders, 1 with stars on top, 1 on bottom.

Fabric D - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (14) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

Fabric E - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 26" strips

Cut (8) 1-3/8" strips, subcut (24) 1-3/8" x 11" strips

Cut (5) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (24) 1-1/4" x 7-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 55-1/2" borders

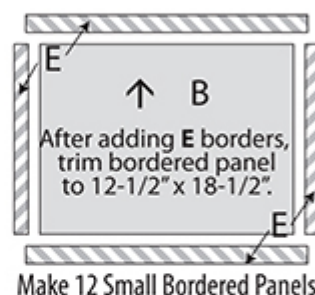
Cut (4) 2" strips, sew 2 strips together end to end and cut into (1) 2" x 43" and (1) 2" x 27-1/2" borders. Repeat with remaining 2 strips for a total of 2 each border length.

Fabric G - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips

2. Piecing Order:

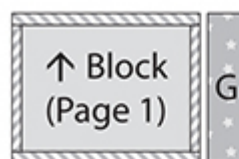
1. Stitch **Fabric E** 1-1/4" x 7-1/2" strips to sides of a 7-1/4" x 9-1/2"

Fabric B panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-3/8" x 11" **Fabric E** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim small bordered panel to 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" (unfinished).** Make a total of 12 small bordered panels.

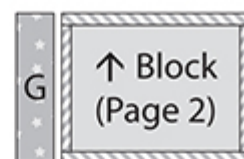


Arrows and stripes indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Sew a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" **Fabric G** strip to right side of small bordered panels with Pages 1, 3, 4, 7, 9, and 12. Sew a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" **Fabric G** strip to left side of small bordered panels with Pages 2, 5, 6, 8, 10, and 11. Blocks measure 8-1/2" x 12-1/2" (unfinished).

3. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of blocks, strips, panel, and borders.

4. Stitch **Fabric E** 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the 23-1/2" x 42" **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 26" **Fabric E** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim large bordered panel to 24-1/2" x 43" (unfinished).**

5. Sew **Fabric F** 2" x 43" borders to right and left sides of large bordered panel. Add **Fabric F** 2" x 27-1/2" borders to top and bottom of large bordered panel.

6. Sew **Fabric C** 8-3/4" x 27-1/2" borders to top and bottom to complete quilt center (27-1/2" x 62-1/2" unfinished).

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7. Arrange blocks with **Fabric B** small panels pages 1, 3, 6, 7, 8, and 10 and 7 **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips in a vertical row on left side of quilt center. Sew into vertical border (12-1/2" x 62-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to left side of quilt center.

8. Arrange blocks with **Fabric B** small panels pages 2, 4, 5, 9, 11, and 12 and 7 **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips in a vertical row on right side of quilt center. Sew into vertical border (12-1/2" x 62-1/2" unfinished) and sew to right side of quilt center.

9. Sew **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 55-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

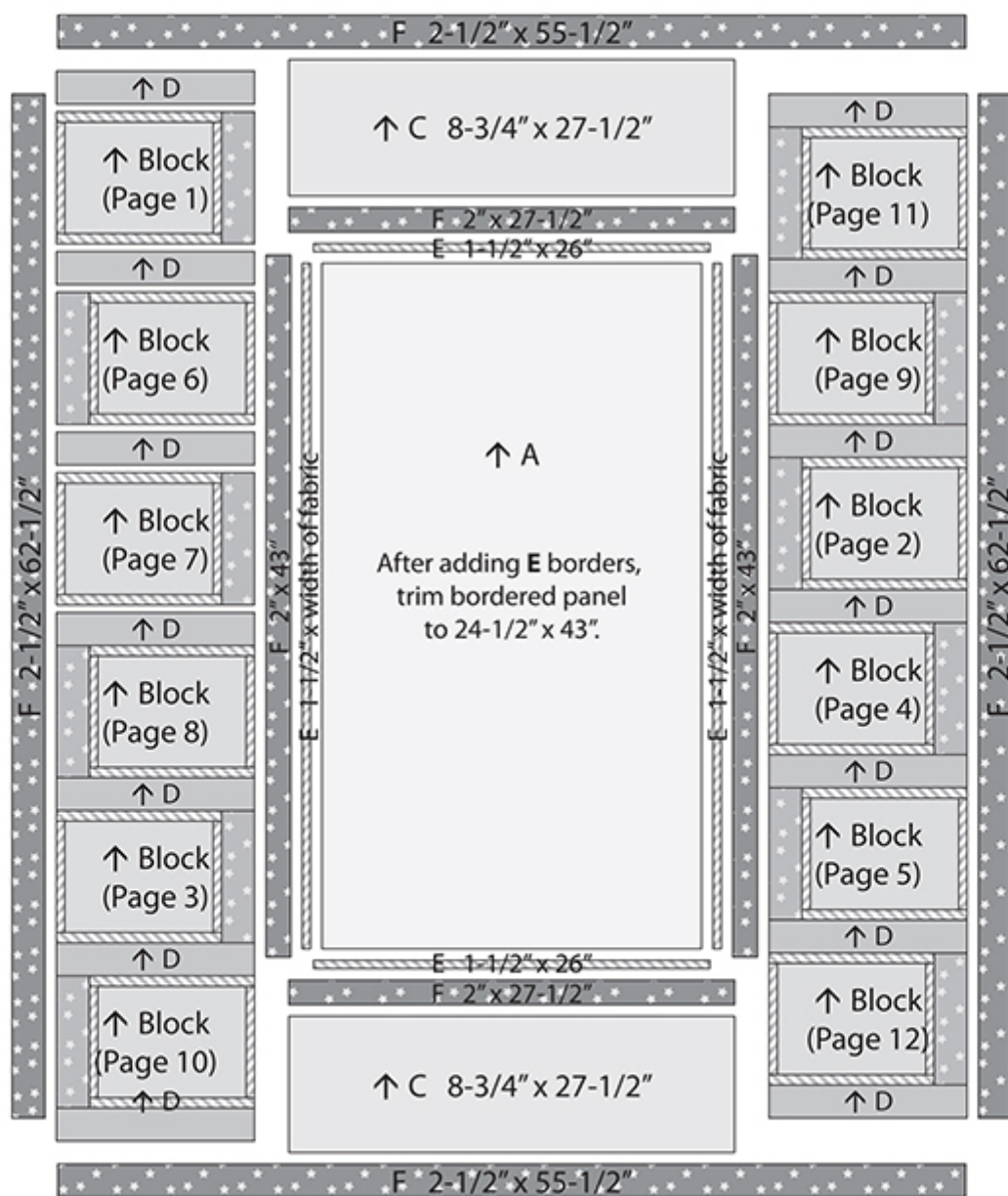
10. The quilt measures approximately 55-1/2" x 66-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric H**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

11. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric E**) and enjoy!!

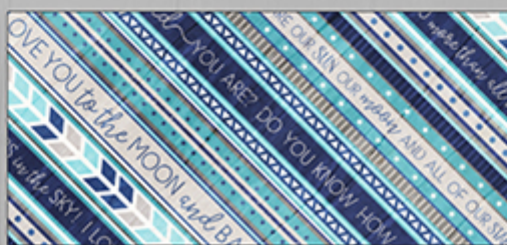

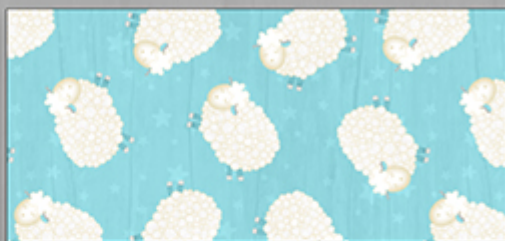
