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## **FABRICS: *Secret Escape* by Archive, licensed by MGL, for Elizabeth's Studio LLC**

**18002 Black (block panel):** 2/3 yard

**18000 Cream (large scale floral)—**1/3 yard

**18000 Blue (large scale floral)—**5/8 yard

**18000 Black (large scale floral)—**1-7/8 yards

**18001 Black (butterflies)—**1/3 yard

**588 Cream (tone-on-tone)—**3/4 yard

**588 Blue (tone-on-tone)—**1 yard

**559 Black (tone-on-tone)—**1 yard

**588 Blue (tone-on-tone)—**1/2 yard for binding

Backing fabric—for 70" x 70" quilt top (4-1/2 yards)

### **CUTTING DIRECTIONS:**

**18002 Black (block panel):** Fussy cut (4) 10-1/2" squares, centering motifs.

**18000 Cream (large scale floral):** Cut (1) 10-1/2" X WOF (Width of Fabric) strip, cross cut into (2) 10-1/2" x 20-1/2" sections.

**18000 Blue (large scale floral):** Cut (1) 20-1/2" x WOF strip, cross cut into (2) 20-1/2" x 10-1/2" sections.

**18000 Black (large scale floral):** Cut (1) 20-1/2" x WOF strip, cross cut into (1) 20-1/2" square. Cut (8) 4-1/2" x WOF strips.

**18001 Black (butterflies):** Cut (2) 5-1/2" x WOF strip, cross cut into (8) 5-1/2" squares.

**588 Cream (tone-on-tone):** Cut (4) 5-1/2" x WOF strip, cross cut into (8) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" sections AND (4) 5-1/2" squares.

**588 Blue (tone-on-tone):** Cut (3) 5-1/2" x WOF strips, cross cut into (8) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" sections AND (4) 5-1/2" squares. Cut (7) 1" x WOF strips.

**559 Black (tone-on-tone):** Cut (4) 5-1/2" x WOF, cross cut into (16) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" sections.

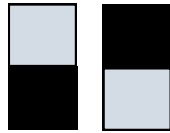
**588 Blue (tone-on-tone):** Cut (8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

## CONSTRUCTING THE QUILT TOP:

### Four Patch Units:



Sew together (2) 5-1/2" squares **588 Blue (tone-on-tone)** and (2) 5-1/2" squares **18001 Black (butterflies)**



squares to form four-patch. Be sure to maintain proper orientation of the fabrics with blue square on the top left. Repeat to create a second block with same orientation.



Repeat above steps using 5-1/2" squares **588 Cream (tone-on-tone)** and **18001 Black (overall)**, noting that the cream squares are on the bottom left in this block. Repeat to make a second block with same orientation.

### Rail Fence Units:



Sew together (1) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" section **588 Cream (tone-on-tone)** and (1) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" section **559 Black (tone-on-tone)** along long edges. Repeat to create a total of (8) blocks).



Repeat above steps using 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" sections **588 Blue (tone-on-tone)** and **559 Black (tone-on-tone)**. Create a total of (8) blocks in this colorway.

## ASSEMBLING THE ROWS:

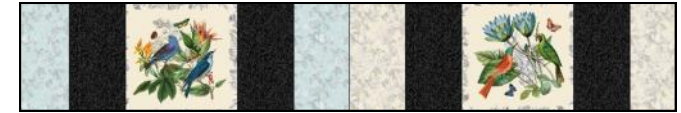
*When assembling the rows, refer to diagrams as needed. Be sure to maintain proper orientation of fabrics and blocks.*

### Row 1:



Sew together (1) blue/black four-patch unit, (1) blue/black rail fence unit, (1) 10-1/2" x 20-1/2" **18000 Cream (large scale floral)**, (1) cream/black rail fence unit, (1) cream/black four-patch unit. Be sure to orient units properly.

### Row 2:



Sew together (1) blue/black rail fence unit, (1) fussy-cut 10-1/2" square **18002 Black (block panel)**, (1) blue/black rail fence unit, (1) cream/black rail fence unit, (1) fussy-cut 10-1/2" square **18002 Black (block panel)**, and (1) black/cream rail fence unit.

### Row 3:

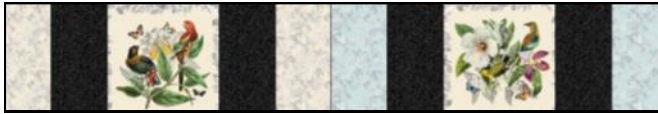


First, sew together (1) blue/black rail fence unit and (1) cream/black rail fence unit. Repeat to make a second unit.

Then, sew together: (1) 20-1/2" x 10-1/2" **18000 Blue (large scale floral)**, black/blue/cream/black rail fence unit, (1) 20-1/2" square **18000 Black (large scale floral)**, (1) black/cream/blue/black rail fence unit, and (1) 20-1/2" x 10-1/2" **18000 Blue (large scale floral)**. Note that the second rail fence unit is oriented opposite (with black/cream rail fence on top).



#### Row 4:



Sew together (1) cream/black rail fence unit, (1) fussy-cut 10-1/2" square **18002 Black (block panel)**, (1) black/cream rail fence unit, (1) blue/black rail fence unit, (1) fussy-cut 10-1/2" square **18002 Black (block panel)**, and (1) black/blue rail fence unit.

#### Row 5:



Sew together (1) cream/black four-patch unit, (1) cream/black rail fence unit, (1) 10-1/2" x 20-1/2" **18000 Cream (large scale floral)**, (1) blue/black rail fence unit, (1) blue/black four-patch unit. Be sure to orient units properly.

### ASSEMBLING THE QUILT TOP:

Sew rows together to create center section of quilt top.



### BORDERS:

#### Inner Blue Border:

Sew together (7) 1" x WOF **588 Blue (tone-on-tone)** strips along short edges. From long strip, cut (2) 1" x 60-1/2" side borders. Add to sides of quilt top. From remainder of strip, cut (2) 1" x 61-1/2" top and bottom borders. Add to top and bottom of quilt top.

#### Outer Border:

Sew together (8) 4-1/2" x WOF **18000 Black (large scale floral)** strips along short edges. From this strip, cut (2) 4-1/2" x 61-1/2" side borders. Add to sides of quilt top. From remainder of strip, cut (2) 4-1/2" x 69-1/2" top and bottom borders. Sew in place.

### FINISHING THE QUILT:

Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Use 2-1/2" **588 Blue (tone-on-tone)** strips to bind quilt.
