с	TON THE LONG	51503-6 Yellow	1	(2) 3-3/8" x WOF strips; subcut (20) 3-3/8" x 14-5/8" rectangles.
D		51503-8 Coral	5/8	Binding: (8) 2-1/4" x WOF strips.
E		51504-1 Charcoal		(1) 9-1/4" x WOF strips; subcut (3) 9-1/4" squares. Cut each square twice diagonally to yield (12) QST. Discard (2).
			1-1/4	(3) 8-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (10) 8-7/8" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to yield (20) 8-7/8" HST. From remaining fabric strip, cut (2) 4-7/8" square.
F		51504-2 White		 (1) 4-7/8" x WOF strip; subcut (8) 4-7/8" squares. Along with the (2) previously cut 4-7/8" squares, cut each square once diagonally to yield (20) HST.
G		51504-3 Magenta	1	(2) 14-5/8" x WOF strips; subcut (20) 3-3/8" x 14-5/8" rectangles.
		Backing	5	Batting: 74" x 90"

HEART BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Press seams open unless otherwise stated. All seams are 1/4".

- 1. Units C/B: Sew (1) C 3-3/8" x 14-5/8" rectangle on both sides of (1) B 3-3/8" x 14-5/8" rectangle, as shown. Make (10).
- 2. Units G/A: Repeat Step 1 using G and A. Make (10).



- **3.** Units E/B: Sew (1) E 9-1/4" QST to (1) B 6-1/4" x 9" rectangle, as shown. Make (10).
- 4. Units F/A: Repeat Step 3 using F and A. Make (10).

- 5. Heart Block 1: Sew units C/B and E/B together, as shown.
- 6. Sew (2) E 4-7/8" HTS to the top edge and right side edge.
- 7. Sew (2) E 8-7/8" HST to the bottom edge and left side edge, as shown. Square block to 16-1/2". Make (10).
- 8. Heart Block 2: Repeat Steps 5-7 using units G/A and F/A, (2) F 4-7/8" QST and (2) F 8-7/8" HST.



9. Referring to Quilt Diagram, sew (2) Heart Block 1 and (2) Heart Block 2 together, alternately, into rows of (4). Make (5) rows.



Quilt Assembly



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **D** 2-1/4" strips pieced together using diagonal seams.
