## Country Road Market

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.


#### 1. Cut the following:

- Fabric A Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 6-1/2" x 48-1/2" bicycle stripe borders
- Fabric B Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (1) 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" strip
- Fabric C Cut (1) 8" strip, subcut (4) 8" squares Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
- **Fabric D** Cut (2) 21"x length of fabric strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (1) 21"x 54" backing
- 2. Piecing Order:
- 1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the **Fabric C** 8" squares.

- 2. Stitch the **Fabric B** 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" strip lengthwise between the **Fabric A** 6-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips to complete the runner base (15-1/2" x 48-1/2" unfinished). **Diagram 1**
- 3. Working on 1 corner at a time, arrange a marked **Fabric C** 8" square on a corner of the runner base. Sew along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on remaining corners. **Diagram 2**
- 4. The runner measures approximately 15-1/2" x 48-1/2" (unfinished).
- 5. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric C**) and enjoy!!


