# Madison

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - Cut (1) 72" x width of fabric strip.

Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage:

(2) 8-3/4" x 72" and (2) 8-3/4" x 64" multi-stripe borders.

Using templates, and referring to quilt image for direction and placement of stripe within each triangle, fussy cut (4) Template X for triangles framing basket, (1) Template Y for base of basket, (9) Template Z with motifs centered for piecing basket (3 with butterflies, 6 with flowers), and 2 upside down Template Z (with identical butterflies)

**Fabric B** - Cut (4) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (29) 4-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 58 triangles

Cut (4) 2-3/8" strips, subcut (2) 2-3/8" x 32-1/2" and (2) 2-3/8" x 28-3/4" borders

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 8-7/8" strip, subcut (1) 8-7/8" square [then cut in half diagonally *only as shown* for 2 triangles] and

(2) 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

Cut (5) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (35) 4-7/8" squares then cut 11 in half diagonally *only as shown* and 24 in the opposite direction for a total of 70 triangles

Cut (4) 4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4" x 65" borders, (1) 3" x 13" strip, and (1) 2" x 20" strip

Cut (3) 3" strips, sewn together end to end with the 3" x 13" strip and cut into (2) 3" x 68" borders

Cut (4) 2" strips, sewn together end to end with the 2" x 20" strip and cut into (2) 2" x 48-1/2" and (2) 2" x 43-1/2" borders

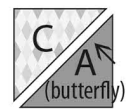
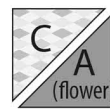
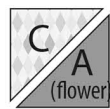
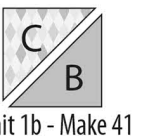
**Fabric D** - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

NOTE: Not all Fabrics B and C 4-7/8" and 8-7/8" triangles are used.

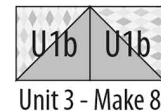
Diamonds and arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

## 2. Piecing Order:

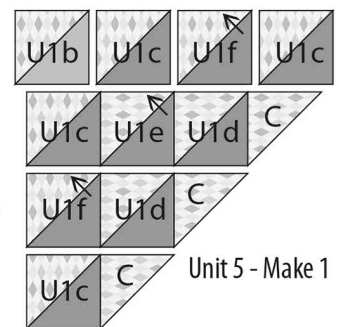
1. Sew 1 each **Fabrics B** and **C** 4-7/8" triangles (noting orientation of **C** diamonds) together along their long edges as shown. Make a total of 16 Unit 1a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 1b-1f indicated with fabrics shown.



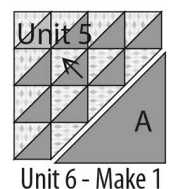
2. Sew 2 Unit 1b together noting orientation. Make a total of 12 Unit 2 (4-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 each Units 3 and 4 with units shown.



3. Arrange 3 **Fabric C** 4-7/8" triangles, 1 each Unit 1b and 1e, 2 each Units 1d and 1f, and 4 Unit 1c in 4 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together into Unit 5 (length of top and left edges are 16-1/2" unfinished).



4. Add a **Fabric A** (Template Y) triangle to bottom, right corner of Unit 5 as shown (16-1/2" square unfinished).

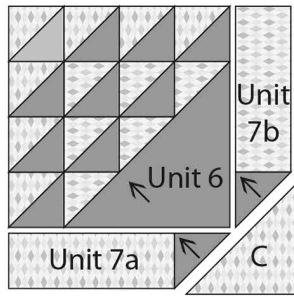


5. Sew **Fabric A** (upside down Z Template) triangle to end of each **Fabric C** 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip as shown to make 1 each Units 7a and 7b (4-1/2" left side x 16-7/8" long side unfinished).



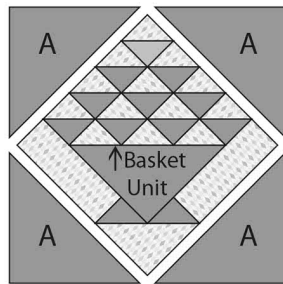

6. Sew Unit 7a to bottom and Unit 7b to right side of Unit 6. Add **Fabric C** 8-7/8" triangle to corner as shown to complete Basket Unit (20-1/2" square unfinished).



Basket Unit - Make 1

7. Sew **Fabric A** (Template X) triangles (refer to quilt image for orientation of stripe) to sides of Basket Unit to complete **Basket Block** (28-3/4" square unfinished).



Basket Block - Make 1

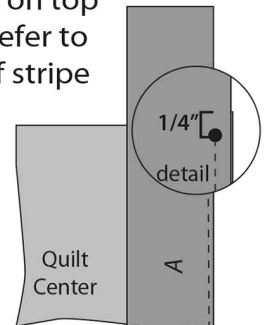
8. Stitch 2-3/8" x 28-3/4" **Fabric B** borders to right and left sides of **Basket Block**. Add 2-3/8" x 32-1/2" **Fabric B** borders to top and bottom.

9. Arrange 4 each Units 3 and 4 in 2 rows above bordered **Basket Block**. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together (8-1/2" x 32-1/2" unfinished). Add to top of **Basket Block**. In the same manner, make and add bottom border.

10. Arrange 6 Unit 2 in 2 vertical rows on right and left sides of bordered **Basket Block**. Stitch into side borders (4-1/2" x 48-1/2" unfinished). Add to right and left sides of bordered **Basket Block**.

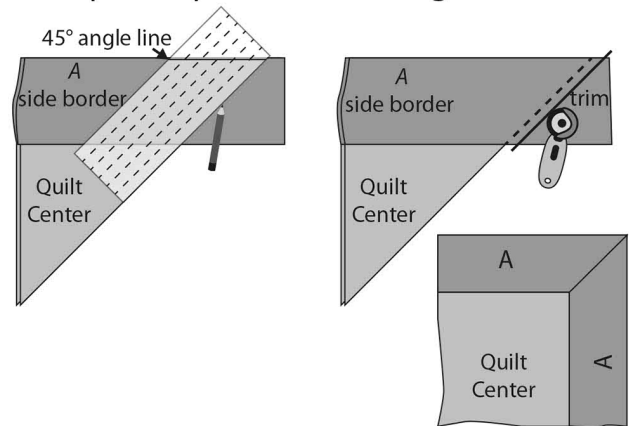
11. Stitch 2" x 48-1/2" **Fabric C** borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add 2" x 43-1/2" **Fabric C** borders to top and bottom to complete quilt center (43-1/2" x 51-1/2" unfinished).

12. Center **Fabric A** 8-3/4" x 72" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric A** 8-3/4" x 64" borders on top and bottom of quilt center (refer to quilt image for orientation of stripe next to quilt center). Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.  
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

13. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



14. Sew **Fabric C** 3" x 68" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric C** 4" x 65" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

15. The quilt measures approximately 65" x 75" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric E**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

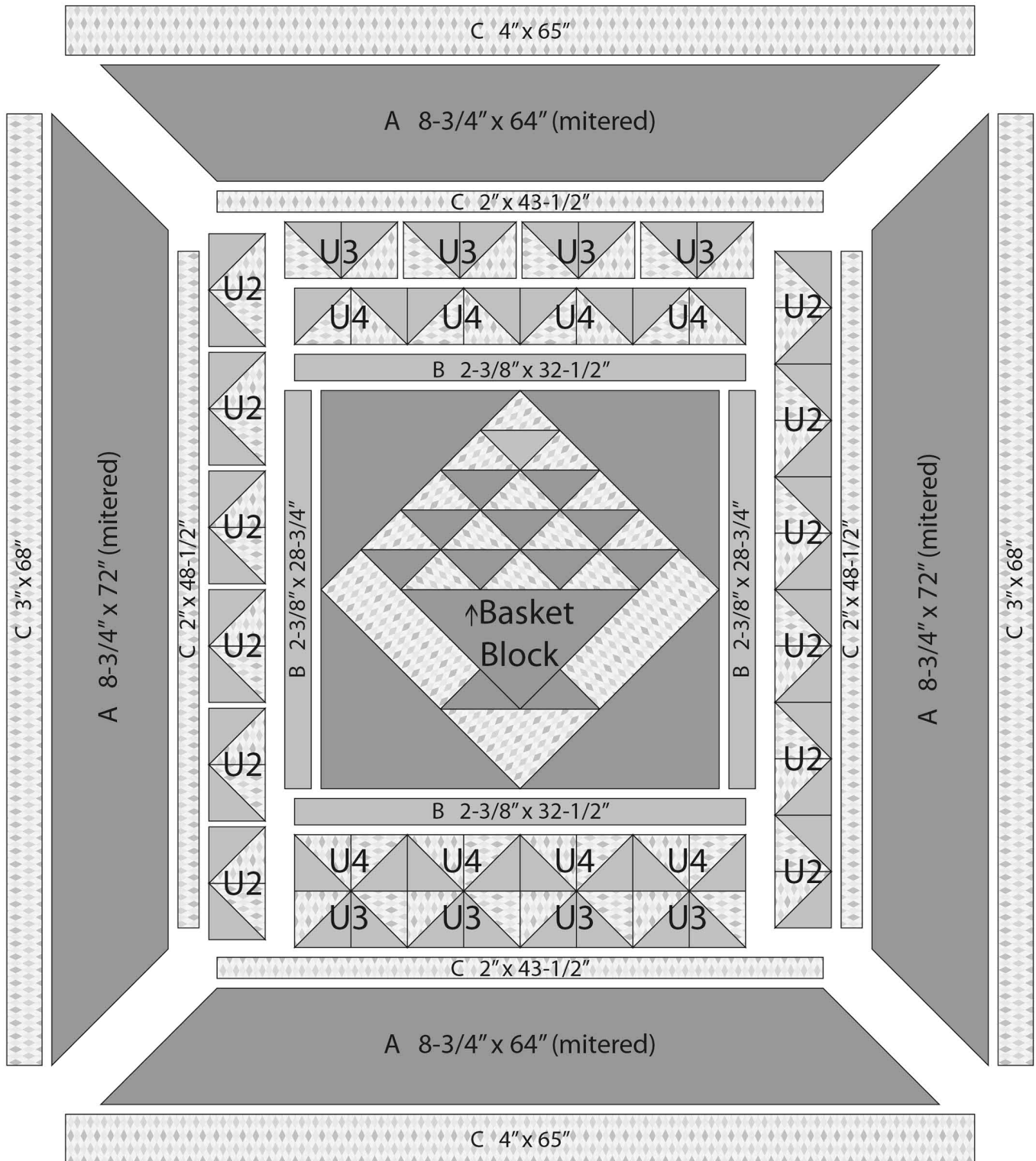
16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!

## QUILT LAYOUT

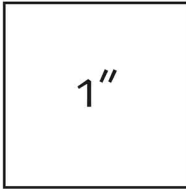
Border measurements are the cut size.

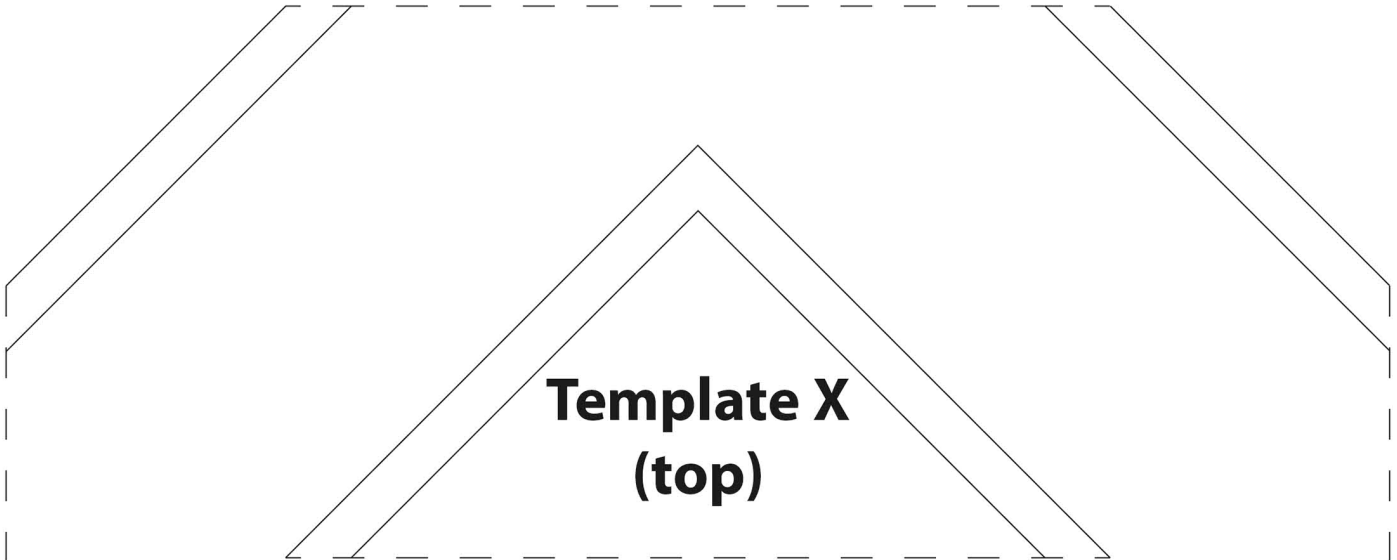

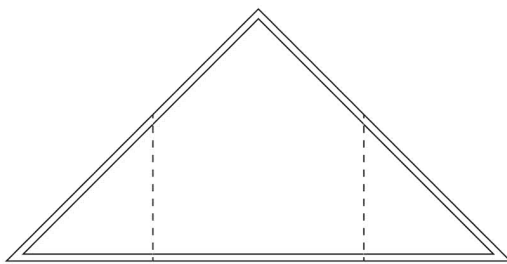

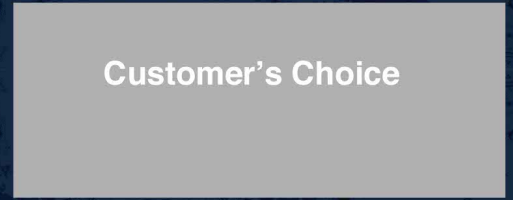
