Wild Blush

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric (LOF) parallel to selvage then subcut as directed:

- (2) 5-1/2" x LOF floral stripe, subcut
- (4) 5-1/2" x 36-1/2" floral stripe borders
- (3) 5-1/2" x LOF butterfly stripe, subcut
- (8) 5-1/2" x 27" butterfly stripe borders
- (4) 3" x LOF paisley stripe, subcut (2) 3" x 52" and (2) 3" x 34" paisley stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 18-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 9-1/2" wide x 18-1/2" tall pieces
Cut (1) 9-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 9-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (3) 9-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 9-1/2" x 18-1/2" pieces and (8) 9-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (3) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 5-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders
Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" borders

Fabrics G and H - From each fabric:
Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" and (20) 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces

Fabric I - Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (56) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (2) 2" strips
Cut (8) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 75-1/2" and (2) 2" x 72-1/2" borders
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 27" strips


Fabric I - (continued)


Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips. Sew 2 strips together end to end and cut into (1) 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" and (1) 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" borders. Repeat with remaining 2 strips for a total of 2 each length borders

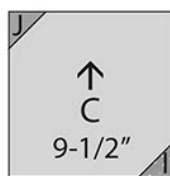
Fabric J - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (56) 2-1/2" squares

Fabrics K and L - From each fabric:
Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (20) 2-1/2" squares

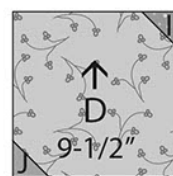
2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 56 each **Fabrics I** and **J** 2-1/2" squares. 

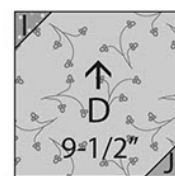
2. Arrange 1 each marked **Fabrics I** and **J** 2-1/2" square on a **Fabric C** 9-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along the marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 2 **Block 1a** (9-1/2" square  Block 1a - Make 2 unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of **Blocks 1b, 2a-b, 3a-b, and 4a-b** (below and on next page) shown with fabrics indicated.



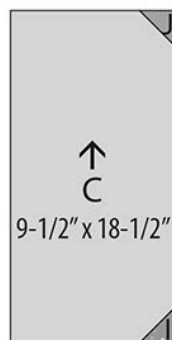
Block 1b - Make 2



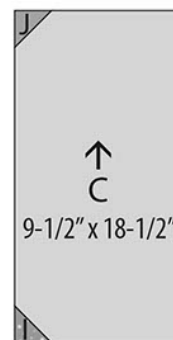
Block 2a - Make 4

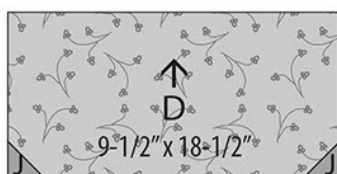


Block 3a - Make 1

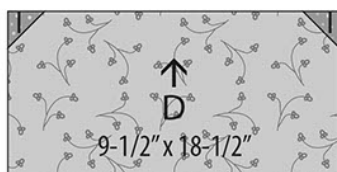

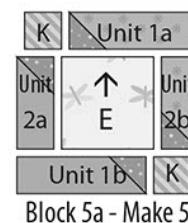
3. Using the same sew and flip technique in Step 2, add marked **Fabrics I** and **J** marked 2-1/2" squares to corners of **Fabrics G** and **H** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips as shown to make 5 each Units 1a-1h (2-1/2" x 7-1/2" unfinished).



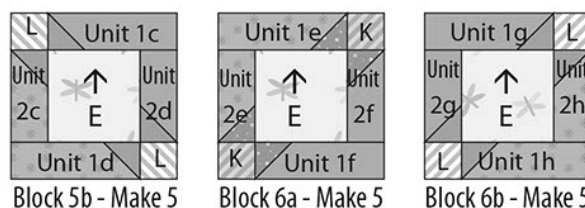
4. In the same manner, add marked **Fabrics I** and **J** 2-1/2" squares to corners of **Fabrics G** and **H** 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips as shown to make 5 each Units 2a-2h (2-1/2" x 5-1/2" unfinished).



5. Arrange 1 **Fabric E** 5-1/2" square, 2 **Fabric K** 2-1/2" squares, and 1 each Units 1a, 1b, 2a, and 2b in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 **Block 5a** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



6. In the same manner, make 5 each **Blocks 5b**, **6a**, and **6b** with fabrics and units indicated.

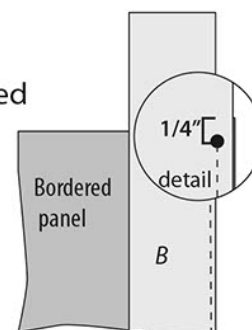


7. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.

8. Stitch **Fabric I** 2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-3/4" x 27" **Fabric I** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 25-1/2" x 43-1/2" (unfinished).**

9. Center **Fabric B** 3" x 52" paisley borders on right and left sides of bordered panel and **Fabric B** 3" x 34" paisley borders on top and bottom of bordered panel.

Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of bordered panel. Do not trim. Press borders out.

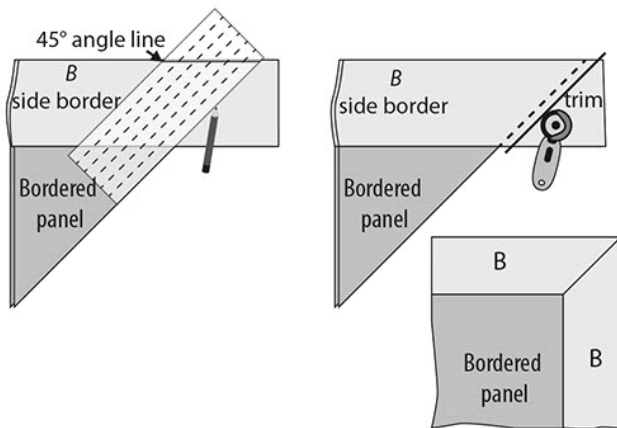


Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

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10. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



11. Sew **Fabric I** 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add **Fabric I** 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.

12. Sew **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add **Fabric F** 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.

13. Arrange 2 **Block 2a**, 2 **Block 2b**, 1 **Block 3a**, 1 **Block 5a**, 2 **Block 5b**, 2 **Block 6a**, and 1 **Block 6b** in 2 vertical rows on left side of bordered panel as shown. Stitch into vertical rows. Sew rows together (18-1/2" x 54-1/2" unfinished) and sew to left side of bordered panel.

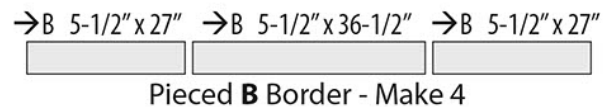
14. Arrange 2 **Block 2a**, 2 **Block 2b**, 1 **Block 3b**, 2 **Block 5a**, 1 **Block 5b**, 1 **Block 6a**, and 2 **Block 6b** in 2 vertical rows on right side of bordered panel as shown. Stitch into vertical rows. Sew rows together (18-1/2" x 54-1/2" unfinished) and sew to right side of bordered panel.

15. Arrange 1 each **Blocks 1a, 1b, 4a, 5a, 5b, 6a**, and **6b** in a horizontal row above bordered panel as shown. Stitch into row (9-1/2" x 72-1/2" unfinished) and sew to top of bordered panel.

16. Arrange 1 each **Blocks 1a, 1b, 4b, 5a, 5b, 6a**, and **6b** in a horizontal row below bordered panel as shown. Stitch into row (9-1/2" x 72-1/2" unfinished) and sew to bottom of bordered panel. Quilt center measures 72-1/2" square unfinished).

17. Sew **Fabric I** 2" x 72-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric I** 2" x 75-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

18. Sew a **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 36-1/2" floral border between 2 **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 27" butterfly borders (5-1/2" x 89-1/2" unfinished). Make a total of 4 pieced **Fabric B** borders.



18. Referring to Steps 9 and 10, add pieced **Fabric B** mitered borders.

19. The quilt measures approximately 85-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric M**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

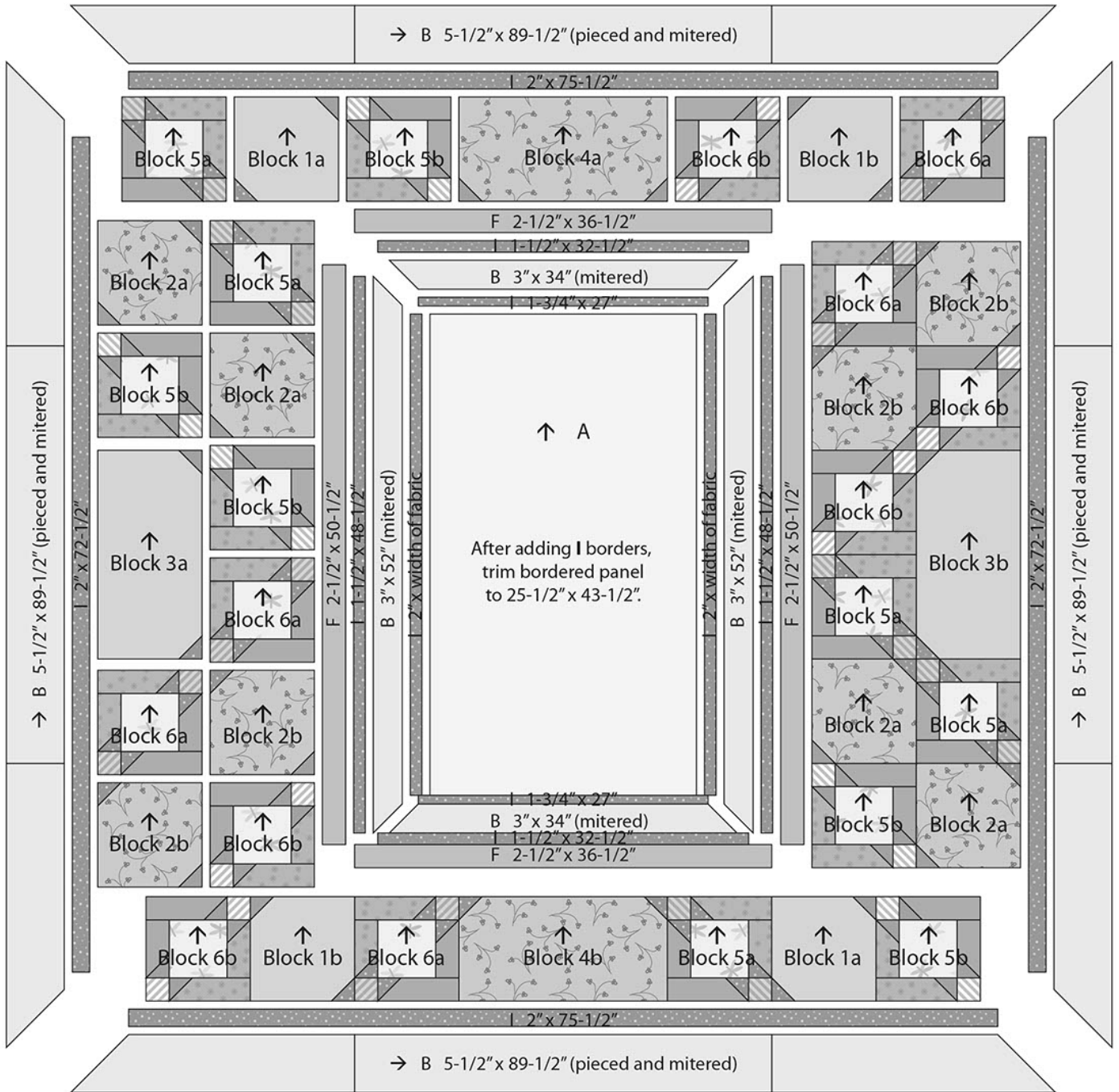
20. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric I**) and enjoy!!

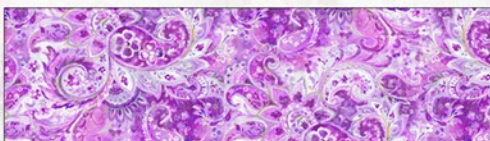

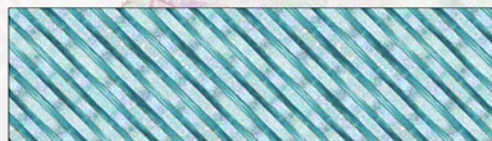

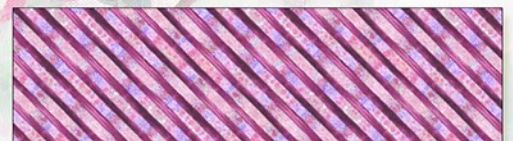
