- % yd (57.15cm) Floral (16041-WHT-CTN-D)
- 1/3 yd (30.48cm) Diamond Texture (16040-TRQ-CTN-D)
- 1/4 yd (22.86cm) Swirl Texture (16039-MUL-CTN-D)
- 3 ½ yds (304.80cm) Words (16043-TRQ-CTN-D) for Backing

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED:


- 70" x 82" (177.8cm x 208.28cm) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

Before you begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼" (6.35mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. Label blocks as they are made. wof = width of fabric

Cutting

1. Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.







Sewing


2. Refer to Diagram A to sew one White strip (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " / 3.81cm x 36.83 cm) RST to the top and to the bottom of one Diamond Texture strip (3 ½" x 14 ½" / 8.89cm x 36.83cm) to make one Unit 1 strip that measures 5 ½" x 14 ½" (13.97cm x 36.83 cm). Repeat to make four Unit 1 strips total.




3. Refer to Diagram B to sew one Panel square (14 ½" x 14 ½" / 36.83cm x 36.83cm) RST to each side of one Unit 1 strip lengthwise to make Row 1. Repeat to make Row 3. Sew one Unit 1 strip to each side of one Floral square (5 ½" x 5 ½" / 13.97cm x 13.97cm) to make Row 2. Sew the three rows together to make one Unit 2 square that measures 33 ½" x 33 ½" (85.09cm x 85.09cm).




4. Refer to Diagram C to sew one White strip (1 ½" x 33 ½" / 3.81cm x 85.09cm) RST to each side of the Unit 2 square. Sew one White strip (1 ½" x 35 ½" / 3.81cm x 90.17cm) RST to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make the Quilt Center that measures 35 ½" x 35 ½" (90.17cm x 90.17cm).



5. Refer to Diagram D to sew one White strip (3" x 5 ½" / 7.62cm x 13.97cm) RST to the left side of one Swirl Texture strip (3" x 30 ½" / 7.62cm x 77.47cm) to make one Unit 3 strip that measures 3" x 35 ½" (7.62cm x 90.17cm).




6. Refer to Diagram E to sew one White strip (3" x 5 ½" / 7.62cm x 13.97cm) RST to the right side of one Diamond Texture strip (3" x 30 ½" / 7.62cm x 77.47cm) to make one Unit 4 strip that measures 3" x 35 ½" (7.62cm x 90.17cm).



7. Refer to Diagram F to sew one White strip (3" x 8" / 7.62cm x 20.32cm) RST to the right side of one Swirl Texture strip (3" x 33" / 7.62cm x 83.82cm) to make one Unit 5 strip that measures 3" x 40 ½" (7.62cm x 102.87cm).



8. Refer to Diagram G to sew one White strip (3" x 8" / 7.62cm x 20.32cm) RST to the left side of one Diamond Texture strip (3" x 33" / 7.62cm x 83.82cm) to make one Unit 6 strip that measures 3" x 40 ½" (7.62cm x 102.87cm).



9. Refer to Diagram H to sew the Unit 3 strip to the left side and the Unit 4 strip to the right side of the Quilt Center. Sew the Unit 5 strip to the bottom and the Unit 6 strip to the top of the Quilt Center.



10. Refer to Diagram I to sew one White strip (1 ½" x 40 ½" / 3.81cm x 102.87cm) RST to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew together three White strips (1 ½" x 42" / 3.81cm x 106.68cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowances to ¼" (6.35mm). From the sewn strip cut two 1 ½"x 42 ½" (3.81cm x 107.95cm) strips. Sew one White strip (1 ½"x 42 ½" / 3.81cm x 107.95cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 42 ½" x 42 ½" (107.95cm x 107.95cm).



11. Refer to Diagram J to sew one White strip (3" x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " / 7.62cm x 13.97cm) RST to the left side of one Floral strip (3" x 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ " / 7.62cm x 95.25cm) to make one Unit 7 strip that measures 3" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (7.62cm x 107.95cm). Repeat to make a second Unit 7 strip.



12 Refer to Diagram K to sew one White strip (3" x 8" / 7.62cm x 20.32cm) RST to the left side of one Floral strip (3" x 40" / 7.62cm x 101.60cm) to make one Unit 8 strip that measures 3" x 47 ½" (7.62cm x 120.65cm). Repeat to make a second Unit 8 strip. Dia. K



13. Refer to Diagram L to sew the Unit 7 strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew the Unit 8 strip RST to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center. The Quilt Center should measure 47 ½" x 47 ½" (120.65cm x 120.65cm).



14. Sew together six White strips (2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" / 6.35cm x 106.68cm) end to end with diagonal seams; trim seam allowances to $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6.35mm). From the sewn strip cut two 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.35cm x 120.65cm) strips and two 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.35cm x 130.81cm) strips . Refer to Diagram M to sew one White strip (2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " / 6.35cm x 120.65cm) to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one White strip (2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " / 6.35cm x 130.81cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center to make the quilt top that measures 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (130.81cm x 130.81cm).




15. To make the Words backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 42" x 59" (106.68cm x 149.86cm). *Note:* Check the direction of fabric. Pin and sew the strips RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram N. Trim the back to measure 59" x 59" (149.86cm x 149.86cm).



- 16. Press finished quilt top and backing. Tape the backing **wrong** side up on a firm surface. Layer batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
- 17. Once the quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess backing and batting even with the quilt top.
- 18. To make the Ray Texture binding, remove the selvages and sew the short ends of the 2 ½" x 42" (6.35cm x 106.68cm) strips RST end to end at a 45-degree angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼" (6.35mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2" (5.08cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded binding even with the edge of the quilt and sew, mitering the corners (Dia. O). Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the binding. Fold the binding over to the back and hand stitch.

Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. *Tip:* Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
