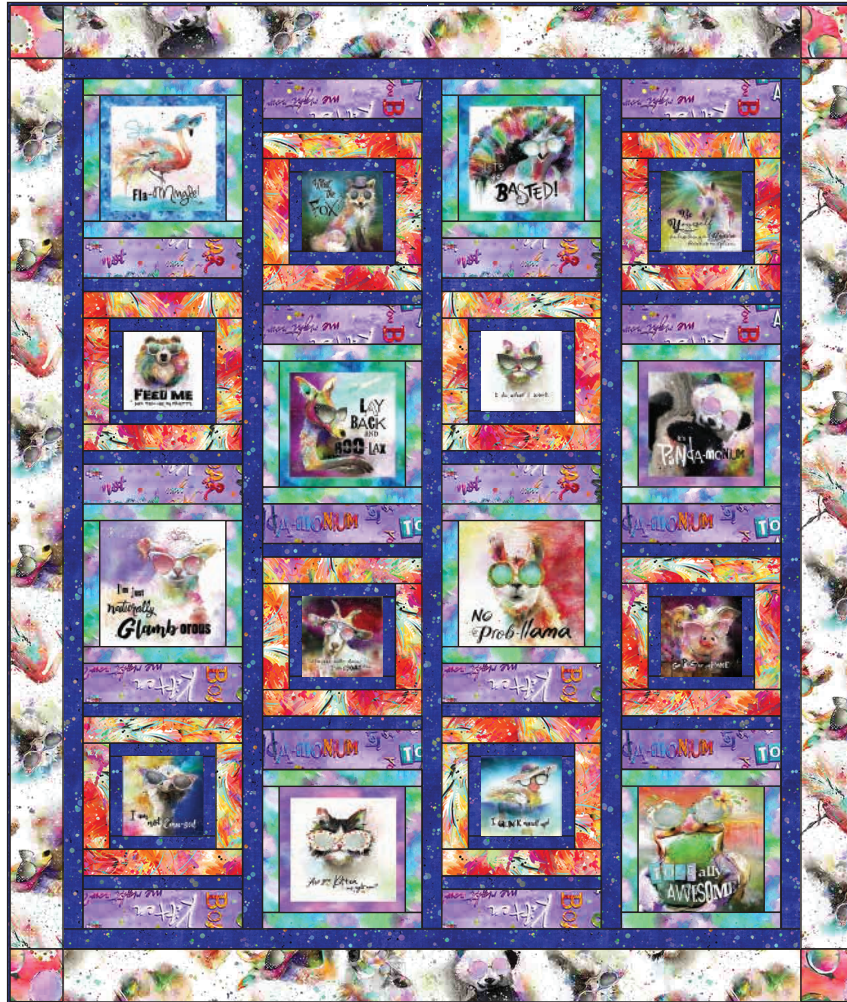




## Sassier ANIMALS Quilt



Finished Size: 63 ½" x 75" (161.29cm x 190.50cm)

## Fabric Needed

3 Wishes Fabric® Sassier Animals Collection by Connie Haley

- 2 yds (182.88cm) – Splatter (15994-BLU-CTN-D) for Piecing and Binding
- 1 ½ yds (102.87cm) – Tossed Animals (15995-WHT-CTN-D)
- 1 Panel (91.44cm) – Large Panel (15992-MUL-CTN-D)
- 1 Panel (91.44cm) – Small Panel (15990-BLU-CTN-D)
- ⅞ yd (80.01cm) – Texture (15997-MUL-CTN-D)
- ⅞ yd (80.01cm) – Flamingo Feathers (15993-MUL-CTN-D)
- ¾ yd (68.58cm) – Words (15991-PUR-CTN-D)
- ¼ yd (22.86cm) – Sunglasses (15996-COR-CTN-D)
- 4 yds (365.76cm) – Sunglasses (15996-COR-CTN-D) for Backing

### ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- 70" x 82" (177.8cm x 208.28cm) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

## Before you begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼" (6.35mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. Label blocks as they are made. wof = width of fabric

## Cutting

1. Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.

**Splatter (15997-BLU-CTN-D) / 2 yds (182.88cm x 106.68cm)**  
 Cut 13 – 2" x 42" (5.08cm x 106.68cm)  
 Cut 7 – 2 ½" x 42" (6.35cm x 106.68cm) for Binding  
 Cut 16 – 1 ½" x 12 ½" (3.81cm x 31.75cm)  
 Cut 16 – 2" x 9 ½" (5.08cm x 24.13cm)  
 Cut 16 – 2" x 6 ½" (5.08cm x 16.51cm)

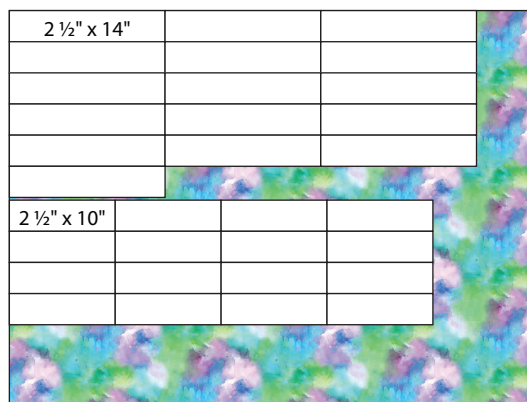

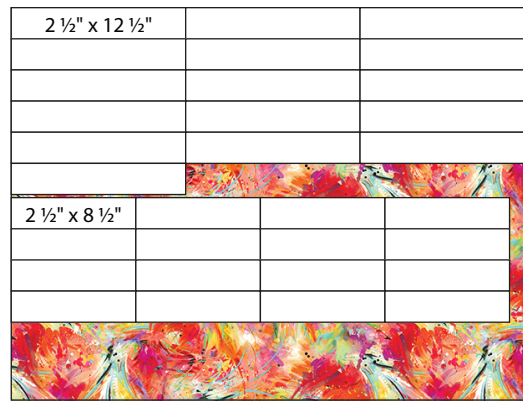
**Large Panel (15992-MUL-CTN-D) / 36" (91.44cm x 106.68cm)**  
**Fussy Cut 8 – 10" x 10" (25.4cm x 25.4cm)**



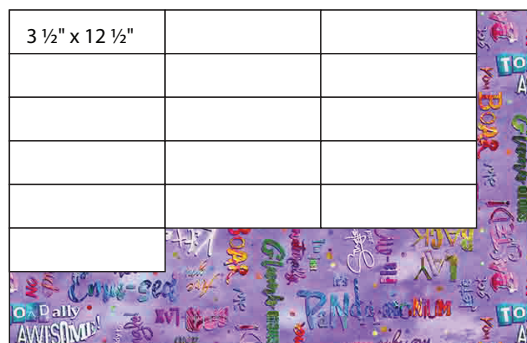
**Small Panel (15990-BLU-CTN-D) / 36" (91.44cm x 106.68cm)**

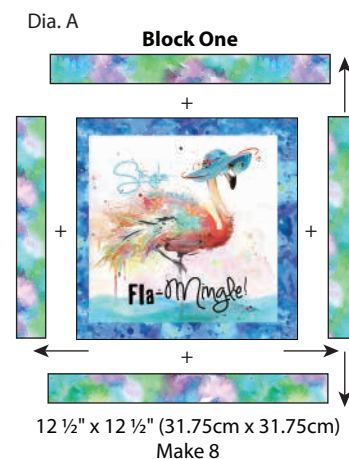
**Words (15991-PUR-CTN-D) /  $\frac{3}{4}$  yd (68.58cm x 106.68cm)**  
 Cut 16 – 3 ½" x 12 ½" (8.89cm x 13.75cm)



**Sunglasses (15996-COR-CTN-D) /  $\frac{1}{4}$  yd (22.86cm x 106.68cm)**  
 Cut 4 – 4 ½" x 4 ½" (11.43cm x 11.43cm)

## Sewing

- Refer to Diagram A to sew one Texture strip (2 ½" x 10" / 6.35cm x 25.4cm) RST to each side of one Large Panel square (10" x 10" / 25.4cm x 25.4cm). Sew one Texture strip (2 ½" x 14" / 6.35cm x 35.56cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Large Panel square (10" x 10" / 25.4cm x 25.4cm) to make one Block One square. Trim the block to measure 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75cm). Repeat to make a total of eight Block One squares that each measure 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75cm).

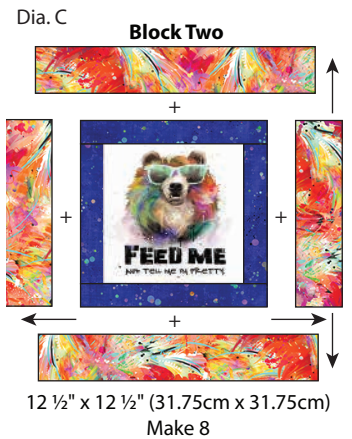


- Refer to Diagram B to sew one Splatter strip (2" x 6 ½" / 5.08cm x 16.51cm) RST to each side of one Small Panel square (6 ½" x 6 ½" / 16.51cm x 16.51cm). Sew one Splatter strip (2" x 9 ½" / 5.08cm x 24.13cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Small Panel square (6 ½" x 6 ½" / 16.51cm x 16.51cm) to make one Unit 1 square. Trim the unit to measure 8 ½" x 8 ½" (21.59cm x 21.59cm). Repeat to make a total of eight Unit 1 squares that each measure 8 ½" x 8 ½" (21.59cm x 21.59cm).

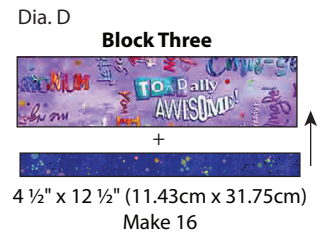




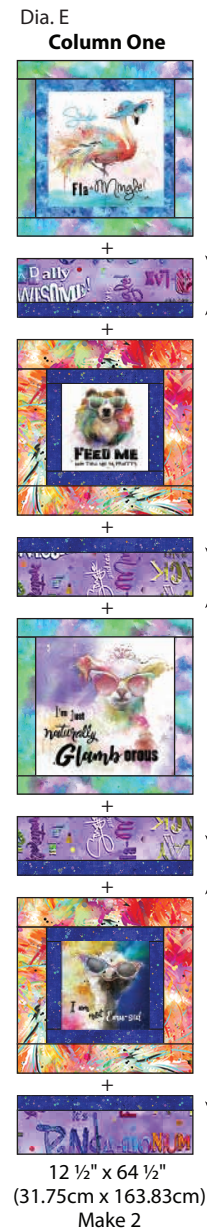
4. Refer to Diagram C to sew one Flamingo Feathers strip (2 ½" x 8 ½" / 6.35cm x 21.59cm) RST to each side of one Unit 1 square. Sew one Flamingo Feathers strip (2 ½" x 12 ½" / 6.35cm x 31.75cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make one Block Two square that measures 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75cm x 31.75cm). Repeat to make a total of eight Block Two squares.



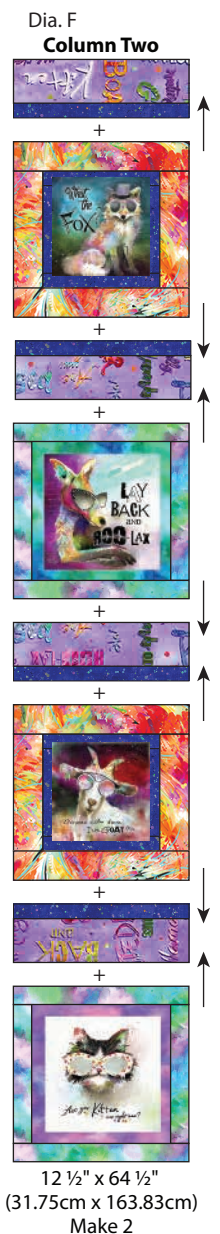
5. Refer to Diagram D to sew one Words strip (3 ½" x 12 ½" / 8.89cm x 31.75cm) RST to the top of one Splatter strip (1 ½" x 12 ½" / 3.81cm x 31.75cm) to make one Block Three strip that measures 4 ½" x 12 ½" (11.43cm x 31.75cm). Repeat to make a total of sixteen Block Three strips.



6. Refer to Diagram E to sew in the following order one Block One square, one Block Three strip, one Block Two square, one Block Three strip, one Block One square, one Block Three strip, one Block Two square and one Block Three strip to make one Column One strip that measures 12 ½" x 64 ½" (31.75cm x 163.83cm). Repeat to make a second Column One strip.



7. Refer to Diagram F to sew in the following order one Block Three strip, one Block Two square, one Block Three strip, one Block One square, one Block Three strip, one Block Two square, one Block Three strip and one Block One square to make one Column Two strip that measures 12 ½" x 64 ½" (31.75cm x 163.83cm). Repeat to make a second Column Two strip.







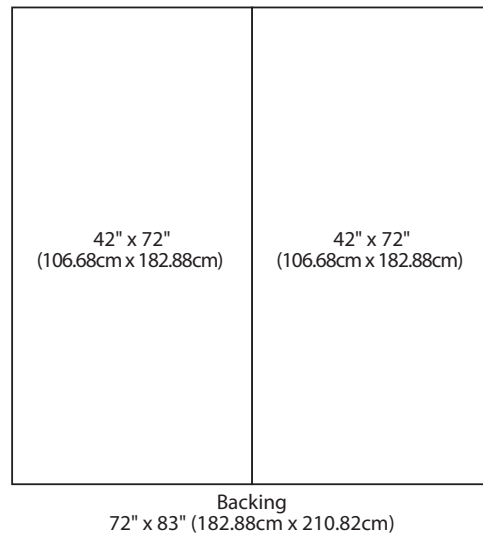
10. Refer to Diagram I to sew one Splatter strip 2" x 56" (5.08cm x 142.24cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center. Sew together four Tossed Animals strips (4 ½" x 42" / 11.43cm x 106.68cm) end to end with diagonal seams; trim seam allowances to ¼" (6.35mm). From the sewn strip cut two 4 ½" x 67 ½" (11.43cm x 142.24cm) strips. Refer to Diagram I to sew one Tossed Animals strip (4 ½" x 67 ½" / 11.43cm x 142.24cm) to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the Quilt Center to make the quilt top. Completed Quilt Top should measure 64" x 75 ½" (162.56cm x 191.77cm).

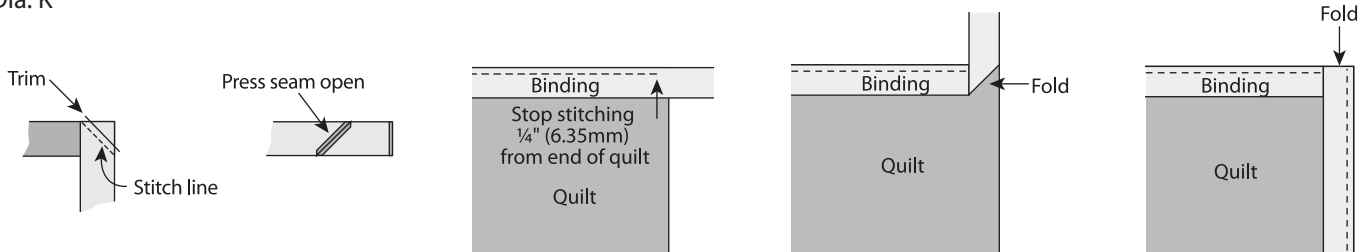
11. To make the Texture backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 42" x 72" (106.68cm x 182.88cm). **Note:** Check the direction of fabric. Pin and sew the strips RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram J. Trim the back to measure 72" x 83" (182.88cm x 210.82cm).

12. Press finished quilt top and backing. Tape the backing **wrong** side up on a firm surface. Layer batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
13. Once the quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess backing and batting even with the quilt top.
14. To make the Splatter binding, remove the selvages and sew the short ends of the 2 ½" x 42" (6.35cm x 106.68cm) strips RST end to end at a 45-degree angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼" (6.35mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2" (5.08cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded binding even with the edge of the quilt and sew, mitering the corners (Dia. K). Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the binding. Fold the binding over to the back and hand stitch.

## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. **Tip:** Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
