Fabric Needed

3 Wishes Fabric® The Great Outdoors Collection by Connie Haley

- 1 panel (76.2cm) (16030-RED-CTN-D)
- % yd (80.00cm) Camouflage (16036-BLU-CTN-D) for Piecing and Binding
- 3/4 yd (68.58cm) Words (16037-BRN-CTN-D)
- % yd (57.15cm) Tossed Animals (16035-TAN-CTN-D)
- 1/2 yd (45.72cm) Mountainside (16032-MUL-CTN-D)
- 3/8 yd (34.29cm) Newspaper Print (16033-GRY-CTN-D)
- 3 ¾ yds (342.90cm) Plaid Patch (16031-MUL-CTN-D) for Backing

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- 64" x 64" (162.56cm x 162.56cm) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

Before you begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6.35mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. Label blocks as they are made. wof = width of fabric

Cutting

1. Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.




Sewing

Refer to Diagram A to sew one Camouflage strip (1 ½" x 10 ½" / 3.81cm x 26.67) RST to the top and to Dia. A the bottom of one Mountainside strip (5 ½" x 10 ½" / 13.97cm x 26.67cm). Sew one Newspaper Print strip (2" x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " / 5.08cm x 26.67cm) to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make one Block One square that measures 10 ½" x 10 ½" (26.67cm x 26.67cm). Repeat to make a total of eight Block One squares that each measure 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (26.67cm x 26.67cm).





Refer to Diagram B to sew one Brown Solid strip (2" x 8 ½" / 5.08cm x 21.59cm) RST to each side of one Panel square (8 ½" x 8 ½" / 21.59cm x 21.59cm). Sew one Brown Solid strip (2" x 11 ½" / 5.08cm x 29.21cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Panel square to make one Block Two square. Trim the block to measure 10 ½" x 10 ½" (26.67cm x 26.67cm). Repeat to make a total of eight Block Two squares that each measure 10 ½" x 10 ½" (26.67cm x 26.67cm).

4. Refer to Diagram C to sew one Brown Solid strip (2" x 18 ½" / 5.08cm x 46.99cm) RST to each side of the Panel square (18 ½" x 18 ½" / 46.99cm x 46.99cm). Sew one Solid Brown strip (2" x 21 ½" / 5.08cm x 54.61cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Panel square to make one Unit 1 square. Trim the unit to measure 20 ½" x 20 ½" (52.07cm x 52.07cm).



5. Refer to Diagram D to sew one Tossed Animals strip (4 ½" x 20 ½" / 11.43cm x 52.07cm) RST to each side of one Unit 1 square. Sew one Tossed Animals strip (4 ½" x 28 ½" / 11.43cm x 72.39cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make one Unit 2 square that measures 28 ½" x 28 ½" (72.39cm x 72.39cm).



6. Refer to Diagram E to sew one Camouflage strip (1 ½" x 28 ½" / 3.81cm x 72.39) to each side of the Unit 2 square. Sew one Camouflage strip (1 ½" x 30 ½" / 3.81cm x 77.47cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make the Quilt Center that measures 30 ½" x 30 ½" (77.47cm x 77.47cm).



- 7. Refer to Diagram F to sew one Block One square to the top and to the bottom of one Block Two square to make the Left Border. *Note:* Check that blocks are placed in the correct direction.
- 8. Refer to Diagram G to sew one Block One square to the top and to the bottom of one Block Two square to make the Right Border. *Note:* Check that blocks are placed in the correct direction.



9. Refer to Diagram H to sew three Block Two squares and two Block One squares RST, alternating them, to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.10. Refer to Diagram I to sew one Splatter strip 2" x 56" (5.08cm x 142.24cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center. Sew together four Tossed Animals strips (4 ½" x 42" / 11.43cm x 106.68cm) end to end with diagonal seams; trim seam allowances to ¼" (6.35mm). From the sewn strip cut two 4 ½"x 67 ½" (11.43cm x 142.24cm) strips. Refer to Diagram I to sew one Tossed Animals strip (4 ½"x 67 ½" / 11.43cm x 142.24cm) to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the Quilt Center to make the quilt top. Completed Quilt Top should measure 64" x 75 ½" (162.56cm x 191.77cm).



10. Refer to Diagram I to sew the Left Border and Right Border to the Quilt Center as shown. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the Quilt Center as shown. The Quilt Center should measure 50 ½" x 50 ½" (128.27cm x 128.27cm).


11. Sew six Words strips (3 ½" x 42" / 8.89cm x 106.68cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowances to ¼" (6.35mm). From the sewn strip cut two 3 ½"x 50 ½" (8.89cm x 128.27cm) strips and two 3 ½"x 56 ½" (8.89cm x 143.51cm) strips . Refer to Diagram J to sew one Words strip (3 ½"x 50 ½" / 8.89cm x 128.27cm) to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one Words strip (3 ½"x 56 ½" / 8.89cm x 143.51cm) to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top. The completed Quilt Top should measure 56 ½" x 56 ½" (143.51cm x 143.51cm).



- 12. To make the Plaid Patch Backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 42" x 64" (106.68cm x 162.56cm). *Note:* Check the direction of fabric. Pin and sew the strips RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram K. Trim the back to measure 64" x 64" (162.56cm x 162.56cm).
- 13. Press finished quilt top and Backing. Tape the Backing **wrong** side up on a firm surface. Layer batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
- 14. Once the quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and batting even with the quilt top.

15. To make the Camouflage Binding, remove the selvages and sew the short ends of the 2 ½" x 42" (6.35cm x 106.68cm) strips RST end to end at a 45-degree angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼" (6.35mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2" (5.08cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the quilt and sew, mitering the corners (Dia. L). Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold the Binding over to the back and hand stitch.



Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. *Tip:* Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
