## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

Fabric A Cut (2) $41 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (6) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) $41 / 2$ " squares.

Fabric C Cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (4) $41 / 2 " \times 121 / 2$ " strips.
Cut (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) $41 / 2$ " squares.

Fabric D $\quad \operatorname{Cut}(3) 71 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (13) $71 / 4$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (52) $71 / 4$ " triangles.
Cut (6) $41 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (48) $41 / 2$ " squares.
Cut (3) $37 / 8$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (26) $3^{7 / 8} 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (52) $37 / 8$ " triangles.

Fabric E Cut (1) $41 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) $41 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) $41 / 2$ " squares.

Backing

Cut (1) $41 / 2 \mathrm{x}$ X WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $41 / 2$ " $\times 121 / 2$ " strips.
Cut (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

Cut (1) $41 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $41 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (1) $41 / 2 \mathrm{x}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $41 / 2$ " squares.

Cut (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) $4^{1 / 2 "} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.
Cut (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $41 / 2$ " squares.

Cut (6) $21 / 2 x$ WOF strips for the binding.
Cut (1) $41 / 2 \mathrm{x}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) $41 / 2 " \times 121 / 2$ " strips.
Cut (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

Cut (2) 68" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 68 " $\times 68$ " backing.

## Making the Quilt

## 1. Block Assembly

Sew (1) $71 / 4 "$ Fabric D triangle to opposite sides of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $37 / 8$ " Fabric D triangle to the top of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 triangle (Diagram 1). Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 triangles total.

2. Sew (1) $37 / /^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D triangle to each end of (1) $41 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Diagram 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 strips total.

3. Sew (1) Unit 1 triangle to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 strip to make (1) Block One square (Diagram 3). The Block should measure $121 / 2$ " square. Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

4. Repeat Steps $1-3$ and refer to Diagrams $4-5$ for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (3) $121 / 2$ " Block Two squares and (4) $121 / 2$ " Block Three squares.

5. Sew (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric D square to each side of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric E square. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of (1) $41 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to make (1) Block Four square (Diagram 6). Repeat to make (3) Block Four squares total.

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Diagrams $7-10$ for fabric identification and location to make (2) Block Five squares, (2) Block Six squares, (2) Block Seven squares and (3) Block Eight squares.


## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)
7. Sew (1) Block One square, (1) Block Four square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Five square and (1) Block One square together in that order left to right to make Row One.
8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to the quilt layout for component identification, location and orientation to make Rows Two through Five.
9. Sew the (5) rows together in numerical order to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew the (6) Fabric I binding strips together, end to end with a 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
12. Bind as desired.
