Twin Quilt: 66" x 74 1/2"

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

Cut (1) 1-3/4" strip, subcut (16) 1-3/4" squares

**Fabric F** - Cut (1) 4-1/8" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/8" squares  $/\!\!/$  [8] and (4) 3-3/4" squares  $/\!\!/$  [16] If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips. Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to PLEASE NOTE: When indicated cut 5-1/4" and 3-3/4" squares in half |X|end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 43-1/2" borders diagonally twice for the number of triangles indicated in []. and (1) 2-1/4" x 10" strip Cut all 4-1/8", 2-7/8", and 2-3/8" squares in half diagonally  $\sqrt{\phantom{a}}$ Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (2) 3" x 8" strips, for the number of triangles indicated in []. (16) 3" squares, and (2) 1-1/2" x 8" strips Cut (2) 2-1/4" strips, sewn together end to Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy end with the 2-1/4" x 10" strip and cut into cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to (2) 2-1/4" x 43" borders selvage: (2) 9" x 70" multi-stripe and Fabric G - Cut (2) 3-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 9" x 65" multi-stripe borders (12) 3-3/4" squares [48] Fussy cut (4) 4-1/2" and (4) 3" squares with Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (4) 3" x 9" pieces and florals centered (16) 3" squares **Fabric B** - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (8) 3-3/4" Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (12) 2-7/8" x 5-1/4" pieces and (2) 5-1/4" squares [8] squares / [24] Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (4) 3" squares and Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding) (4) 2-1/2" squares Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces and (16) 1-3/4" squares Fabric C - Cut (4) 5" strips, sewn together end Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 8" to end and cut into (2) 5" x 66-1/2" borders, pieces (1) 3-1/2" x 10" strip, and (1) 3" square Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end Fabric H - Cut (1) 3-3/4" strip, subcut with the 3-1/2" x 10" strip and cut into (8) 3-3/4" squares [32] (2) 3-1/2" x 66" borders Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-3/4" x 3" Cut (1) 3-3/4" strip, subcut (10) 3-3/4" pieces and (16) 1-3/4" squares squares  $\times$  [40] and (1) 3" square Fabric I - Cut (1) 3-3/4" strip, subcut Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (4) 3" x 4-1/4" pieces, (2) 3-3/4" squares [8] and (8) 2-7/8" (14) 3" squares, and (4) 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" pieces squares / [16] Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 2-7/8" squares // Cut (1) 2-3/8" strip, subcut (8) 2-3/8" [16] and (8) 2-3/8" squares / [16] squares / [16] Cut (1) 1-3/4" strip, subcut (16) 1-3/4" squares Fabric D - Cut (1) 4-1/8" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/8" Cut (1) 1-1/4" strip, subcut (16) 1-1/4" squares squares [/] [8] and (4) 2-7/8" squares [/] [8] Cut (1) 3-3/4" strip, subcut (4) 3-3/4" squares, Fabric J - Cut (1) 3-3/4" strip, subcut (6) 3-3/4" squares 2 [24] and (4) 2-7/8" and (4) 3-3/4" squares [16] Cut (1) 1-1/4" strip, subcut (16) 1-1/4" squares squares / [8] Cut (1) 2-3/8" strip, subcut (8) 2-3/8" Fabric E - Cut (2) 3-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 3-3/4" squares / [16] squares and (10) 3-3/4" squares [40] Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (4)  $3" \times 4 - 1/4"$  pieces, end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 49" and (16) 3" squares, and (4) 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" pieces (2) 1-1/2" x 43-1/2" flat piping strips Cut (1) 2-3/8" strip, subcut (8) 2-3/8" Cut (1) 1-1/4" strip, subcut (32) 1-1/4" squares

#### 2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew 1 each **Fabrics C** and **I** 2-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 8 Unit 1a (2-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units

1b-1d shown with fabrics indicated.

2. Sew 2 each Fabric G 2-7/8" triangles to short edges of a Fabric B 5-1/4" triangle as shown

Make 4 Make 4 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished). Make a total of 4 Unit 2a. In the same manner, make 4 Unit 2b.

3. Arrange 4 Unit 1d in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows to complete 1 Unit 3 (4-1/2" square unfinished).






4. Arrange 2 each Units 1a, 1b, and 1c and 1 Unit 2a in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Unit 4  $(4-1/2" \times 8-1/2" \text{ unfinished}).$ 



5. Arrange 4 Fabric B 2-1/2" squares, 4 Unit 2b, and 1 Unit 3 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows.



6. Arrange 4 Fabric A 4-1/2" squares, 4 Unit 4, and 1 Unit 5 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Unit 6 (16-1/2" square unfinished).



7. Sew 1 each Fabrics D and F

Unit 6 - Make 1

4-1/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 8 Unit 7 (3-3/4" square unfinished).



8. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 8 Fabric E 3-3/4" squares.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

9. Arrange a marked **Fabric E** 3-3/4" square right sides together on a **Fabric B** 3-3/4" x 5-1/4" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Make a total of 4 each Units 8a and 8b (3-3/4" x 5-1/4" unfinished)













10. Arrange 2 Unit 7 and 1 each Units 8a and 8b in a row as shown. Stitch into row. Make a total of 4 Unit 9 (3-3/4" x 16-1/2" unfinished).



11. Arrange 4 Fabric D 3-3/4" squares, 4 Unit 9, and 1 Unit 6 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Block 1 (23" square unfinished).



12. Sew 1 each Fabrics G and H 1-3/4" x 3" pieces together lengthwise as shown. Make a total of 8 Unit 10 (3" square unfinished).

13. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 16 Fabric D, 16 Fabric I, and 32 Fabric J 1-1/4" squares and 16 each **Fabrics E**, **G**, **H**, and **I** 1-3/4" squares.



14. Arrange 4 marked **Fabric D** 1-1/4" squares right sides together on a Fabric B 3" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 4 Unit 11a (3" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Unit 11b with fabrics indicated and 8 Unit 11c each with 2 each Fabrics I and J 1-1/4" squares and a Unit 10.

15. Using the same flip-and-sew technique, arrange a marked Fabric E 1-3/4" square right sides together on a Fabric G 3" square as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Make a total of 16 Unit 12a (3" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 16 each Units 12b-d with fabrics indicated.

16. Arrange 2 Fabric H and 1 each Fabrics D and G 3-3/4" triangles as shown. Stitch triangles together. Make a total of 16 Unit 13a (3" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 13b-d listed with fabrics indicated.

17. Stitch 1 each Fabrics C and J 2-3/8" triangles to short edges of a Fabric E 3-3/4" triangle as shown. Make a total of 8 Unit 14a (2" x 3" unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 each Units 14b-d with fabrics indicated.









18. Stitch 1 each Units 14a and 14b together as shown. Make a total of 8 Unit 15a (3" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 Unit 15b.

19. Arrange 1 Unit 11a, 4 Unit 12a, and 4 Unit 13a in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 2a (8" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 Block 2b and 8 Block 3 with units indicated.









- 20. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 5) for arrangement and placement of blocks, flat piping strips, and borders.
- 21. Arrange 1 Block 2b and 2 Block 3 in vertical rows on right and left sides of **Block 1**. Stitch into vertical rows (8" x 23" unfinished). Sew to right and left sides of **Block 1**.
- 22. Arrange 2 Block 2a, 1 Block 2b, and 2 Block 3 in horizontal rows above and below Block 1. Stitch into horizontal rows (8" x 38" unfinished). Sew to top and bottom of **Block 1** to complete quilt center (38" square unfinished).
- 23. Arrange 1 **Fabric F** 1-1/2" x 8", 2 **Fabric G** 1-1/2" x 8", and 2 each **Fabrics C** and **E** 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" strips in vertical rows on right and left sides of quilt center. Sew into vertical rows (1-1/2" x 38" unfinished) and stitch to right and left sides of quilt center.

- 24. Arrange 1 Fabric F 3" x 8", 2 Fabric G 3" x 9", and 2 each **Fabrics C** and **E** 3" x 4-1/4" strips in horizontal rows above and below the quilt center. Sew into horizontal rows (3" x 43" unfinished) and stitch to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 25. Sew **Fabric F** 2-1/4" x 43" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric F 3-1/2" x 43-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 26. Fold and press Fabric J 1-1/2" x 49" and 1-1/2" x 43-1/2" strips in half lengthwise, right side out, forming 3/4" wide flat piping strips.
- 27. Baste 3/4" x 49" **Fabric J** flat piping strips on top of sides of guilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of Fabric F border. Baste 3/4" x 43-1/2" **Fabric J** flat piping on top of top and bottom of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of Fabric F border.
- 28. Center Fabric A 9" x 70" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and Fabric A 9" x 65" borders on top and bottom of guilt center with the light stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out leaving flat piping over Fabric F borders.




Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints. 29. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



- 30. Sew **Fabric C** 3-1/2" x 66" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric C 5" x 66-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 31. The guilt measures approximately 66-1/2" x 75" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric K) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 32. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric G) and enjoy!!
