



(For fabric choices refer to the diagram.)


HST = Half Square Triangle





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Begin HST unit assembly using (4) A triangles and (4) B triangles. Place triangles right sides together and edges aligned.
- 2. Sew the longest edges of the triangles together using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Press toward the B triangle.
- 3. Repeat to create (4) HST units using A and B triangles, and (4) HST units using A and C triangles. (HST units should total 8.)
- 4. Trim A/B and A/C HST units using the following guide:
 - a. 4" Block: 11/2" unfinished (1" finished)
 - b. 6" Block: 2" unfinished (1 1/2" finished)
 - c. 8" Block: 21/2" unfinished (2" finished)
 - d. 12" Block: 3 1/2" unfinished (3" finished)










- 5. Use HST unit assembly instructions provided above to create (2) HST units using (2) D triangles and (2) E triangles. Press seams toward the E triangle.
- 6. Trim D/E HST units using the following guide:
 - a. 4" Block: 21/2" unfinished (2" finished)
 - b. 6" Block: 3 1/2" unfinished (3" finished)
 - c. 8" Block: 4 1/2" unfinished (4" finished)
 - d. 12" Block: 6 1/2" unfinished (6" finished)






7. Complete block assembly using all HST units created in steps 1-6. Sew HST units together as shown in the diagram. Please note the orientation of all HST units. Arrows indicate pressing instructions.
