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Snow Valley

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 45" and (2) 5-1/2" x 26-1/2" scenic stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 28" strips

Fabric D - Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (8) 5" squares
Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (2) 4" x 26-1/2" borders and (2) 2-1/2" x 8" strips

Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 3-1/2" x 4" pieces

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips. Sew a 2-1/2" x 8" strip to 1 end of each width of fabric strip and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 45" borders.

Fabric E - Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 5" squares.

Cut remaining strip into (1) 1-1/2" x 22" and (2) 1" x 22" strips. From these strips cut (4) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" strips, (4) 1-1/2" squares, and (32) 1" squares

Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (2) 4" x 26-1/2" borders.

From remaining strip cut (3) 1-1/4" x 14" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 4" pieces

Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 45" borders. Cut remaining strip into (2) 1" x 30" strips, subcut (16) 1" x 3-1/2" pieces.

Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip, subcut (28) 1-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (1) 1" strip, subcut (4) 1" x 3-1/2" pieces

Fabric G - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut

(4) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" and (4) 1-1/2" x 5" pieces

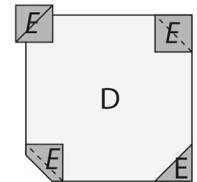
Fabric H - Cut (6) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 69" and (2) 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders

2. Piecing Order:

1. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all the **Fabric E** 1" and 1-1/2" squares.

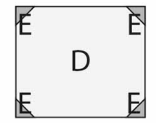
Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Arrange 4 marked **Fabric E** 1-1/2" squares right sides together on a **Fabric D** 5" square. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out.



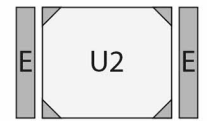
Unit 1 - Make 8

3. Sew 2 **Fabric E** 1" x 3-1/2" pieces to short sides of a Unit 2. Make a total of 8 Unit 3 (3-1/2" x 5" unfinished).



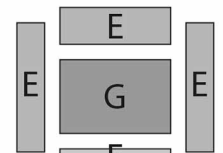
Unit 2 - Make 8

4. Sew a **Fabric G** 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece between a **Fabric E** 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" and **Fabric F** 1" x 3-1/2" piece. Add 2 **Fabric E** 1-1/4" x 4" pieces to the sides. Make a total of 4 Unit 4 (4" x 5" unfinished).



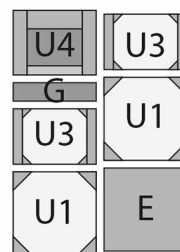
Unit 3 - Make 8

5. Arrange 2 each Units 1 and 3, 1 Unit 4, 1 **Fabric G** 1-1/2" x 5" piece, and 1 **Fabric E** 5" square in 2 vertical rows. Stitch into vertical rows. Sew rows together. Make 2 each Blocks 1 and 2 (9-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).

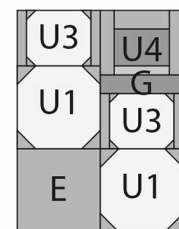


Unit 4 - Make 4

6. Arrange 2 each Units 1 and 3, 1 Unit 4, 1 **Fabric G** 1-1/2" x 5" piece, and 1 **Fabric E** 5" square in 2 vertical rows. Stitch into vertical rows. Sew rows together. Make 2 each Blocks 1 and 2 (9-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).

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6. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.

7. Stitch **Fabric C** 2-1/2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-1/2" x 28" **Fabric C** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 26-1/2" x 45" (unfinished).*

8. Sew a **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 45" border to top edge of a **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 45" border. Add a **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 45" border to the bottom of the **Fabric B** border. Make a second border. Sew to right and left sides of bordered panel.

9. Sew a **Fabric E** 4" x 26-1/2" border to top edge of a **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 26-1/2" border. Add a **Fabric D** 4" x 45" border to the bottom of the **Fabric B** border. Make a second border with the **Fabric E** border on the bottom and the **Fabric D** border on the top. Stitch one each **Block 1** and **Block 2** to ends of each border then sew to top and bottom of bordered panel.

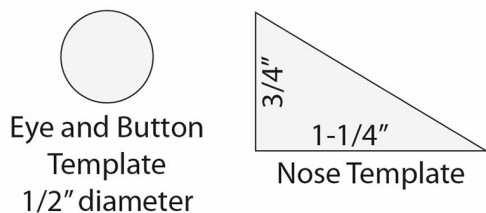
10. Stitch **Fabric H** 3-1/2" x 69" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric H** 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

11. Hand or machine appliqué a **Fabric E** nose to each snowman in **Blocks 1** and **2**. Refer to color quilt image for placement. Hand or machine appliqué eyes and snowmen's buttons if desired. If using buttons, sew on after the quilt is quilted.

12. The quilt measures approximately 50-1/2" x 75" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

13. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric F**).

14. Stitch on 1/2" buttons for snowmen's eyes and buttons if they were not appliquéd on.

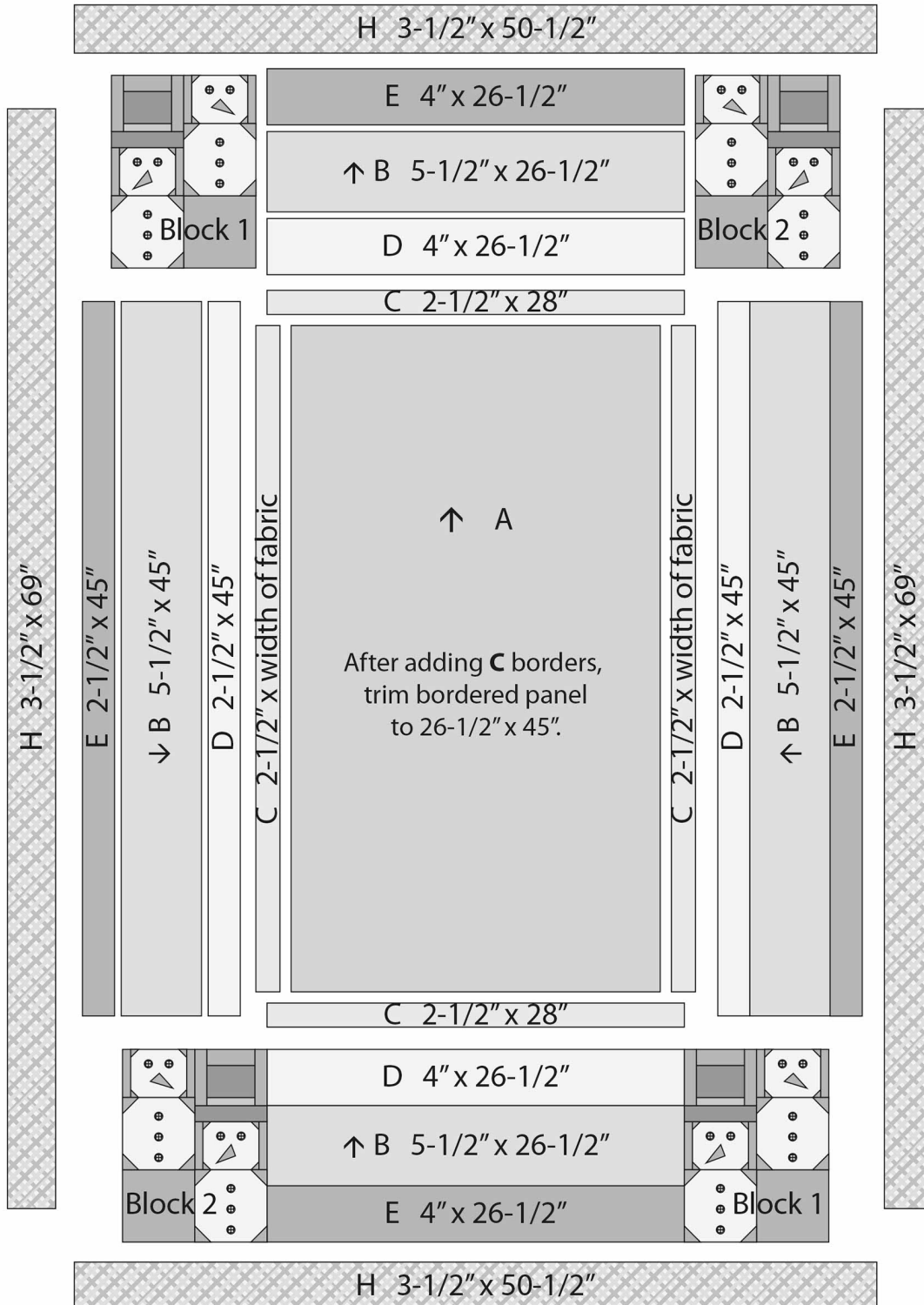

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QUILT LAYOUT

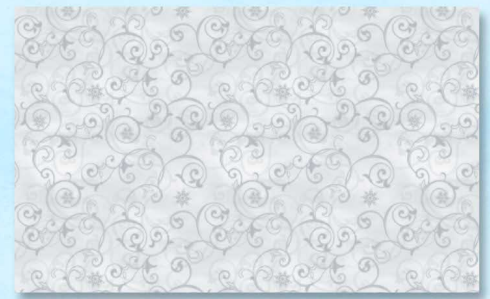
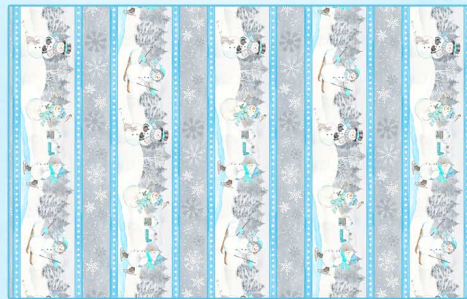
Border measurements are the cut size.
