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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### From Fabric A, cut:

three 9-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 9-1/2" x 23" rectangles\*

one 9-1/2" x 21-1/2" rectangle

two 9-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles\*

one 9-1/2" x 11" rectangle

\*Tip: cut one of each of these from one strip to maximize yardage.

seven 4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixty-six 4" squares for the HSTs

three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-three 3-1/2" squares

five 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixty-six 3" squares

twenty-two 2" x WOF strips. Sew sixteen strips together, end-to-end, then trim:  
eight 2" x 62" row sashing strips  
two 2" x 75-1/2" side inner borders  
From the remaining strips, subcut:  
twenty-two 2" x 9-1/2" block sashing strips

**From Fabric B, cut:**

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:  
two 2-1/2" x 69" top/bottom middle borders  
two 2-1/2" x 75-1/2" side middle borders

**From Fabric C, cut:**

seven 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:  
two 4-1/2" x 77" top/bottom outer borders  
two 4-1/2" x 79-1/2" side outer borders  
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
six 4" squares for the HSTs  
one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
twelve 3-1/2" squares

**From each of Fabrics D-K, R and S, cut:**

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
two 4" squares for the HSTs  
Trim the remainder of the strip to 3-1/2" wide, then subcut:  
four 3-1/2" squares

**From Fabric L, cut:**

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
four 4" squares for the HSTs  
one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
eight 3-1/2" squares

**From each of Fabrics M and N, cut:**

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
six 4" squares for the HSTs  
one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
twelve 3-1/2" squares

**From each of Fabrics O-Q cut:**

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
eight 4" squares for the HSTs  
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
sixteen 3-1/2" squares

**From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips



## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 4" Fabric A square with a 4" Fabric C square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make twelve A/C HSTs.



**Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 to make:



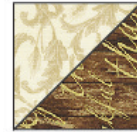
four A/D HSTs



four A/E HSTs



four A/F HSTs



four A/G HSTs



four A/H HSTs



four A/I HSTs



four A/J HSTs



four A/K HSTs



eight A/L HSTs



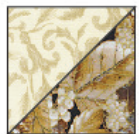
twelve A/M HSTs

## Assemble the Stem Units

**Step 3:** Place a 3" Fabric A square in one corner of a 3-1/2" Fabric D square, right sides together. Sew along the diagonal, as shown. Trim the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press toward Fabric A. Repeat on the opposite corner, with a second 3" Fabric A square.



**Step 4:** Repeat Step 4 to make:  
one Stem unit from each of Fabrics D-K, R and S  
two Stem units Fabric L  
three Stem units from each of Fabrics C, M and N  
four Stem units from each of Fabrics O-Q

## Assemble the Blocks



**Step 5:** Gather:  
one 3-1/2" Fabric A square  
three 3-1/2" Fabric D squares  
one Fabric D Stem unit  
four A/D HSTs

Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

**Step 6:** Sew the pieces together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions every other row.

**Step 7:** Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting Block will measure 9-1/2" square.

**Step 8:** Repeat Steps 5-7 to make a total of thirty-three Blocks:  
one Block from each of Fabrics D-K, R and S  
two Block from Fabric L  
three Block from each of Fabrics C, M and N  
four Block from each of Fabrics O-Q
