Small Throw Quilt: 45" x 63"







Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 67" and (2) 8-3/4" x 49" multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (4) 2-1/4" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/4" x 28" strips

Fabric D - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (3) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 44-1/2" and (1) 1-3/4" x 29" borders

Cut (1) 1-3/4" strip, subcut (1) 1-3/4" x 29" border

2. Piecing Order:

- 1. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, and borders.
- 2. Stitch **Fabric C** 2-1/4" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-1/4" x 28" **Fabric C** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to* 26" x 44-1/2" (unfinished).
- 3. Sew **Fabric D** 2" x 44-1/2" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add **Fabric D** 1-3/4" x 29" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.

4. Center **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 67" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 49" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the holly stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping

1/4" from corners of quilt

center. Do not trim. Press

borders out.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.



5. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.




- 6. The quilt measures approximately 45-1/2" x 63-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric E**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 7. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!
