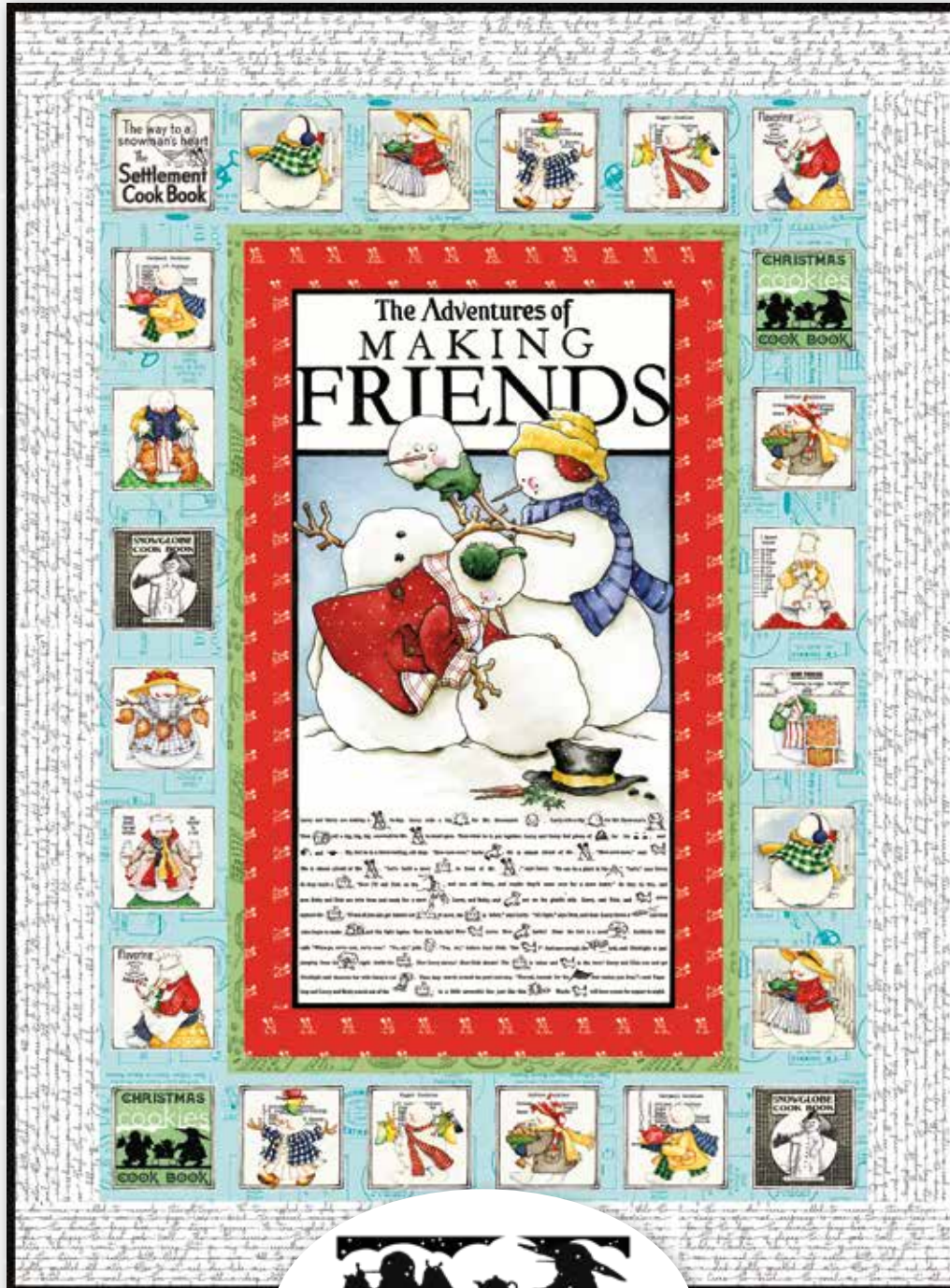

SNOW SWEET ADVENT QUILT

Finished Quilt Size 51³/₄" x 71³/₄"

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please read **ALL** instructions before beginning the project. Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. Fabric quantities are for 43"/44" wide, 100% cotton fabrics.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- 2 5/8 yards 20" wide woven fusible interfacing (optional)
- Polyester stuffing (optional)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS



Making Friends Panel

Fussy cut 1 rectangle 23 1/4" x 43 1/4", centered over the panel design



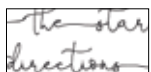
Christmas Cooks Medium Patch Panels

Fussy cut 24 squares 7 1/2" x 7 1/2", centered over the squares on the panel.



Red Small Snowmen

Cut 4 strips 3" x WOF for Border 1.



White Candy Making Text

Cut 6 strips 3 3/4" x WOF for Border 4.



Black Sugary Snow Dots

Cut 7 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for Binding.



Blue Vintage Ads

Cut 5 strips 8" x WOF for Border 3.



Green Vintage Cook Book

Cut 4 strips 1 1/2" x WOF for Border 2.



Gingerbread Cookies Felt Panel

Each gingerbread shape has a front and back piece, referred to as a pair. When cutting each pair, cut 1/4" around the outside of the printed line to add a seam allowance.

Cut 24 pairs of felt shapes.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

When sewing border pieces, sew all of the cut strips end to end into one long strip before cutting the side, top and bottom border pieces.

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Press seam allowances towards borders. The Pockets will be sewn on Border 3 after all the borders have been attached.

Border 1

Side borders should be 43 1/4". Top and bottom border should be 28 1/4".

Border 2

Side borders should be 48 1/4". Top and bottom border should be 30 1/4".

Border 3

Side borders should be 50 1/4". Top and bottom border should be 45 1/4".

Border 4

Side borders should be 65 1/4". Top and bottom border should be 51 3/4".

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POCKETS

Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for print and Pocket placement.

Optional Pocket Reinforcement: Cut 24 squares $7\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ from the woven fusible interfacing. Fuse an interfacing square to the wrong side of each Christmas Cooks Medium Patch Panel $7\frac{1}{2}''$ square.

Finish all edges of each Christmas Cooks Medium Patch Panel $7\frac{1}{2}''$ square by folding under $\frac{1}{4}''$ twice and pressing. Topstitch across the top, $\frac{1}{8}''$ from the edge to complete 24 Pockets ($6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$). The remaining edges will be secured when the Pockets are sewn to the Quilt Top.

Border 3 Top and Bottom

Fold the Quilt Top in half, matching the side edges. Press to make a crease at the center of the top and bottom of Border 3.

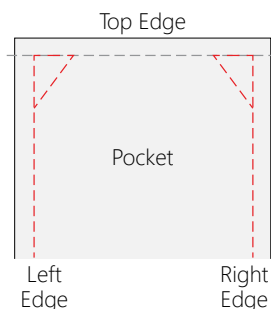
Measure and mark a line $\frac{5}{8}''$ from each side seam of the top border (refer to page 3).

Place a Pocket, right side up, to the right of the line on the left, centering it on the height of the border and pin in place. Repeat to place a Pocket to the left of the line on the right.

Place 4 Pockets between the 2 pinned Pockets, spacing them evenly with 2 Pockets on each side of the center crease. Pin in place.

Sew around the left, bottom and right sides of each pinned Pocket, $\frac{1}{8}''$ from the edge. Reinforce the seams at the top of the left and right edges by sewing a triangle as shown.

Repeat to add 6 Pockets to the bottom border.



Border 3 Sides

Fold the Quilt Top in half, matching the top and bottom edges. Press to make a crease at the center of the sides of Border 3.

Measure and mark a line $1\frac{3}{8}''$ from the top and bottom seams of the left border.

Place a Pocket, right side up, to the bottom of the line on the top, centering it on the width of the border and pin in place. Repeat to place a Pocket to the top of the line on the bottom.

Place 4 Pockets between the 2 pinned Pockets, spacing them evenly with 2 Pockets on each side of the center crease. Pin in place.

Sew around the left, bottom and right sides of each pinned Pocket, $\frac{1}{8}''$ from the edge. Reinforce the seams at the top of the left and right edges by sewing a triangle.

Repeat to add 6 Pockets to the right border.

GINGERBREAD COOKIES

Place a pair of shapes wrong sides together, matching the edges. Sew around the edges on the printed line with a thread the color of the felt.

Optional: Leave a small opening and lightly stuff the center of the Gingerbread Cookie, then sew the opening closed.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Quilt around the pockets. Bind with Black Sugary Snow Dots strips. Add the Gingerbread Cookies to the pockets.

Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
