





# Cutting

#### Cut all pieces in the order listed.

Fabric 1 From the panel cut (8) 6-1/2" sauares.

# Fabric 2

A: Cut (2) 7-1/4" squares: cut twice on the diagonal for a total of (8) triangles. B: Cut (2) 3" x WOF Strips: subcut (20) 3" squares.

#### Fabrics 3, 4, and 7, 8

C: Cut (2) 7-1/4" squares: cut twice on the diagonal for a total of (8) triangles each.

#### Fabric 5

D: Cut (2) 7-1/4" squares: cut twice on the diagonal for a total of (8) triangles.

- E: Cut (1) 13-1/4" square: cut twice on the diagonal for a total of (4) triangles.
- F: Cut (2) 6-1/2" squares

G: Cut (4) 3" squares

# Fabric 6

H: Cut (2) 7-1/4" squares: cut twice on the diagonal for a total of (8) triangles. I: Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip: subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares. From

I: Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip: subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares. From leftover fabric cut (3 more) 2-1/2" squares for a total of 19.

# Fabric 9

J: Cut (2) 7-1/4" squares: cut twice on the diagonal for a total of (8) triangles. Binding: Cut (9) 2-1/2" x WOF strips

# Fabric 10

K: Cut (6) 6-1/2" x WOF strips: subcut into (32) 6-1/2" squares. L: Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip: subcut into (13) 3" squares. From the

leftover fabric cut (3) 3" squares for a total of 16. M: Cut (2) 7-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut into (8) 7-1/4" squares.

Cut twice on the diagonal for (32) triangles. Cut (2) 5" x WOF strips. Subcut into:

- N: (4) 5" x 8" rectangles
  - O: (4) 5" x 12-1/2" rectangles

P: Cut (4) strips 1-1/2" x WOF for the narrow borders.

- Subcut into
- P1: (2) 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" strips
- P2: (2) 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips
- Q: Cut (1) 13-1/4" square. Cut twice on the diagonal for a total of (4) triangles.

# Fabric 11

R: Cut (8) 7-1/4" squares: cut twice on the diagonal for a total of (32) triangles.

S: Cut (2) 13-1/4" squares: cut twice on the diagonal for a total of (8) triangles.

# Fabric 12

T: Cut (2) 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles

# Fabric 13 Border Stripe

From the wide utensil section cut: (4)  $5" \times LOF$  strips. From the aprons cut (14)  $2-1/2" \times 18-1/2"$  sashing strips. From the utensils cut (13)  $2-1/2" \times 18-1/2"$  sashing strips.

# **Kitchen Stars Quilt**

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Use a light sizing/starch before cutting triangles to help control stretching along the bias edges. Fabric will be abreviated to 'F'

# Star Block A

Gather (4) pink F1 panel sections, (16) white F10-K squares, (16) white F10-M triangles, (16) F11-R triangles, (8) triangles each of F2-A, F3-C, F4-C, F5-D, and .

# Hourglass 1

1. Sew a F2-A triangle to a F10-M triangle. Press toward A.

2. Sew a F3-C triangle to a F11-R triangle. Press towards R.

3. Sew the A-M section to the R-C section. Press toward center. Make 8.

4. Sew a F10-K square to either side of an Hourglass 2 unit. Make sure to follow the orientation of the illustration. Press toward center. Make 8.

# Hourglass 2


5. Sew a F4-C triangle to a F10-M triangle. Press toward C.

6. Sew a F5-D triangle to a F11-R triangle. Press toward D

7. Sew the C-M section to the D-R section. Press open.Make 8.


8. Sew an Hourglass 2 unit to either side of a F1 panel sectior Note: the panel section will be different in each block. Lay out the Hourglass unit as illustrated. Press away from center. Make 4.

9. Sew the blocks together as illustrated below. Make 4

# Star Block B

Gather (4) blue or green F1 panel sections, (16) white F10-K squares, (16) white F10-M triangles, (16) F11-R triangles, and (8) triangles each of F6-H, F7-C, F8-C, F9-J

# Hourglass 3

1. Sew a F6-H triangle to a F10-M triangle. Press toward H.

2. Sew a F7-C triangle to a F11-R triangle. Press towards C.

3. Sew the H-M section to the R-C section. Press open. Make 8.

4. Sew a F10-K square to either side of an Hourglass 3 unit. Make sure to follow the orientation of the illustration. Press toward center. Make 8.

# Hourglass 4


5. Sew a F8-C triangle to a F10-M triangle. Press toward C.

6. Sew a F9-J triangle to a F11-R triangle. Press toward J.

7. Sew the C-M section to the J-R section. Press open. Make 8.

8. Sew an Hourglass 4 unit to either side of a F1 panel section. Note: the panel section will be different in each block. Lay out the Hourglass units as illustrated. Press away from center. Make 4.

9. Sew the blocks together as illustrated below. Press open Make 4.

# Heart Block


Gather (2) F5-F and (4) F5-G squares, (2) F12-T rectangles

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on four F5-G squares. Place a F5-G square, RST, over a F12-T rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Cut the corner 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press away from center. Repeat on the opposite side. Make 2.

2. Make a diagonal line from corner to corner on two F5-F squares Place a F5-F square RST over one Step 1 unit. Sew on the marked line. Cut the corner 1/4" away from the sew line. Press away from center. Make 1.

3. Place a F5-F square on the remaining Step 1 unit, with the marked line facing the opposite direction as it did in Step 2. Sew on the marked line. Cut the corner 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press away from center. Make 1.

4. Sew the 2 halfs together. Press seams open


# Hourglass 5

Gather (4) F5 E triangles, (4) F10-Q triangles, and (8) F11-S triangles.

1. Sew a F10-Q triangle to a F11-S triangle. Press toward S.

2. Sew a F5-E triangle to a F11-S triangle. Press towards S  $\,$ 

3. Sew the Q-S section to the E-S section. Press open. Make 4.

# 9-Patch Units

Gather (20) F2-B squares, (16) F10-L squares, (4) F10-N and F10-O rectangles.

1. Sew the F2-B squares to the F10 L squares as illustrated Press toward B.

F2-B - F10-L - F2-B

F10-L - F2-B - F10-L

F2-B - F10-L - F2-B

2. Sew the rows together. Press open.

3. Sew a F10-N rectangle to the top of the nine patch units. Press away from 9-patch.

4. Sew a F10-O rectangle to the side of the step 3 unit. Press toward F10-O.

5. Repeat steps 1-4 to make 4 units.

# Hear Star Section Assembly

1. Lay the blocks out making sure to follow the block orientation illustrated below. Sew Together. Press open.










2. Sew the F10-P1 strips to opposite sides of the Heart Star Section. Press toward P1.

3. Sew the F10-P2 strips to the top and bottom of the Heart Star section. Press toward P2.



# Sew the rows

From F13 gather: (14) apron strips, (1) utensil strip, and (3) F6-I cornerstone.

1. Sew the F13 apron sashing strips to the Star A and Star B blocks as illustrated below. Press toward sashing.



2. Sew a F13 apron sashing to the left side of the remaining Star A and Star B blocks Press toward sashing.


3. Sew a F6-I cornerstone to the left side of the F13 utensil strip. Press away from cornerstone.

4. Sew the Star A and Star B blocks together with the sashing strip from step 3. Press toward sashing.



5. Sew a F6-I cornerstone in between two F13 apron strips. Press away from cornerstone. Make 2.

6. Sew the sashing strips to either side of the Heart Star Section. Press toward sashing.



# Quilt Top assembly

1. Sew the Step 4 Star Block section to the step 6 Heart Star section. Press toward sashing. Illustration on p. 9.

# Quilt Top Assembly (cont.)

2. Sew the remaining F13 utensil strips and cornerstones together to form 4 rows of 4 cornerstones and 3 sashing strips. Press away from cornerstones.


3. Sew the sashing strips to the Star Block rows and Heart Star section as illustrated below.



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4. Sew a border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top, makind sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the quilt top. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, wrond side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.

5. Starting at the sewn seam, draw a 45° line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on that line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat on remaining corners.



6. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.

7. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 3/8" seam allowance, mitering the corners. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
