
Harlequin Poppies

Queen Quilt: 81" x 85 1/2"





Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 75" multi-stripe borders (1 with butterflies on top, 1 with butterflies on bottom)

**Fabric C** - Cut (4) 3-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-3/4" x 80" borders

Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 81-1/2" borders
Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips

**Fabric D** - Cut (3) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (17) 6-1/2" squares

**Fabric E** - Cut (5) 3-1/2" strips, from 1 strip subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares


**Fabrics F, G, and I** - From each fabric: Cut (8) 3-1/2" strips

Fabric H - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces Cut (4) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 75" borders Cut (3) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 60-1/2" borders

Fabric J - Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (6) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/2" x 14" and (8) 1-1/2" x 12" strips

#### 2. Piecing Order:


1. Stitch **Fabric J** 1-1/2" x 12" strips to sides of a **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 14" **Fabric J** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished)*. Make a total of 4 **Block 1**.



Block 1 - Make 4

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Sew **Fabrics G** and **I** 3-1/2" strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 4 strip sets. From these, cut (40) 3-1/2" wide Unit 1a (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 strip sets using **Fabrics C** and **I** 3-1/2" strips and cut 40 Unit 1b.



3. In the same manner, make 2 strip sets of each fabric combination and cut 22 each Units




4. Stitch 1 each Units 1a and 1b together as shown. Make a total of 40 Unit 2a (6-1/2" square unfinished).




5. In the same manner, make 11 each Units 2b-2e with the units indicated.

6. Arrange 1 **Fabric D** 6-1/2" square, 4 **Fabric E** 3-1/2" squares, and 4 Fabric H 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 2** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 2 - Make 1

7. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 32 Fabric C 3-1/2" squares.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

8. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric C** 3-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a Fabric D

6-1/2" square as shown.







Unit 3a Make 8

Make 8

Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make 8 each Units 3a and 3b (6-1/2" square unfinished).


9. Arrange 2 each Units 2a and 3a in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 3a (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 **Block 3b** with units indicated.






Block 3b - Make 4

10. Arrange 1 each Units 2a and 2b and 2 Unit 2c in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 Block 4a (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 each Blocks 4b-4d with units indicated.




11. Arrange 1 each Units 2b and 2e and 2 Unit 2a in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to make 1 **Block 5a** (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 each Blocks 5b-5d with units indicated.



12. Sew a Unit 2a above a Unit 2b as shown. Make a total of 2 **Block 6a** (6-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 each **Blocks 6b-6d** and 1 each **Blocks 7a** and **7b** with units indicated.




Block 6a Make 2



- 13. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- 14. Arrange blocks in 5 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (60-1/2" x 72-1/2" unfinished).
- 15. Sew **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 2" x 75" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 16. Sew **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 75" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 17. Sew **Fabric C** 3-3/4" x 80" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric C** 3-1/2" x 81-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 18. The quilt measures approximately 81-1/2" x 86" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 19. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!
