#### PIECED BLOCK

1. HST Units: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 3-1/2" square. Place marked A square, right side together (RST), on (1) H 3-1/2" square as shown. Sew 1/4" away from drawn line on both sides. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) HST units. Square to 3". Make (4). Note: (3) HST units will be used in (1) block. Set aside remaining HST for subsequent blocks.

2. Arrange and sew together (3) A/H units and (3) precut A 3-3/8" HSTs into row units as shown.

Row 1: (1) A HST



Row 2: (1) A HST and (1) A/H unit.





Row 3: (1) A HST and (2) A/H unit.



3. Sew together row units as shown. Add (1) precut J 8-3/8" HST to the long side of the row unit to complete (1) Pieced Block. Square measures 8". Make (4).



Make (4) **J/H** 8" Square




**4.** Make (4) of each **Pieced Block** by repeating **Steps 1-3**. Use the following fabric combinations.






#### **QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY**

- **5.** Pieced Rows: Referring to quilt image for block placement and block orientation, arrange and sew together (8) Pieced Blocks to make (1) Pieced Row. Make (8) rows.
- 6. Sew together Pieced Rows to complete quilt center.







#### **QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY**

Use the Quilt Diagram on Page 7 as a reference guide.

- 7. Inner Border: Sew (2) A 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" strips to the long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) A 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- **8.** Outer Border: Sew (2) M 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" strips to the long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) M 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



#### **Quilt Assembly**



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **J** 2-1/4" strips.
