Gray/Black Queen Quilt: 84" Square



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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.


All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:


PLEASE NOTE:

Cut all 5-1/4" squares in half diagonally twice for the  number of triangles indicated in [].

Cut **Fabric A** 3-5/8", all 2-7/8", and all 2-3/8" squares  in half diagonally for the number of triangles indicated in [].

Fabric A - Cut (8) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 4-1/2" squares, (52) 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" pieces, and (4) 3-5/8" squares  [8]
Cut (2) 3-5/8" strips, subcut (22) 3-5/8" squares [44]

Cut (3) 2-1/8" strips, subcut (52) 2-1/8" squares

Cut (12) 2-3/8" strips, subcut (192) 2-3/8" squares  [384]

Fabric B - Cut (3) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (20) corner pieces with Corner Template (see Cutting Diagram) and (20) 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" pieces

Cut (1) 2-5/8" strip, subcut (8) 2-5/8" squares
Cut (14) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 78-1/2", (2) 2" x 75-1/2", (2) 2" x 69-1/2", and (2) 2" x 66-1/2" borders

Fabric C - Cut (3) 3-5/8" strips, subcut (26) 3-5/8" squares and (8) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (1) 2-5/8" strip, subcut (16) 2-5/8" squares


Fabric D - Cut (6) 2" strips, subcut (52) 2" x 4-1/2" pieces
Cut (14) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 84-1/2", (2) 2" x 81-1/2", (2) 2" x 63-1/2", and (2) 2" x 60-1/2" borders



Cutting Diagram for Corner Piece

Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.


Fabric E - Cut (5) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (5) 4-1/2" squares, (32) corner pieces with Corner Template (see Cutting Diagram), and (32) 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" pieces

Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (20) 2-7/8" squares  [40]


Cut (1) 2-5/8" strip, subcut (16) 2-5/8" squares
Cut (14) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 81-1/2", (2) 2" x 78-1/2", (2) 2" x 66-1/2", and (2) 2" x 63-1/2" borders

Fabric F - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 4-1/2" squares


Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (12) 3-3/8" squares
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (40) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (1) 2-5/8" strip, subcut (16) 2-5/8" squares

Fabric G - Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (10) 5-1/4" squares  [40]

Cut (1) 2-5/8" strip, subcut (16) 2-5/8" squares
Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric H - Cut (2) 5-1/4" strips, subcut (14) 5-1/4" squares  [56]

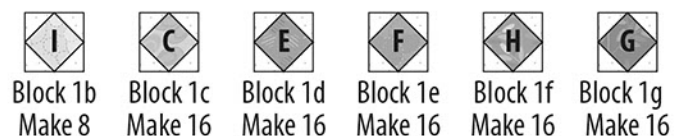
Cut (1) 2-5/8" strip, subcut (16) 2-5/8" squares

Fabric I - Cut (8) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (100) 2-7/8" squares  [200]

Cut (1) 2-5/8" strip, subcut (8) 2-5/8" squares

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew 4 **Fabric A** 2-3/8 triangles to all sides of a **Fabric B** 2-5/8" squares. Make a total of 8 Unit 1a (3-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 Unit 1b and 16 each Units 1c-1g with **Fabric A** 2-3/8 triangles and 2-5/8" squares indicated.



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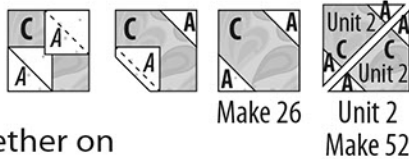
2. Arrange 1 Unit 1b and 2 each Units 1c-1g in a row as shown. Stitch units into a row (3-1/2" x 33-1/2" unfinished). Make a total of 8 Pieced borders.



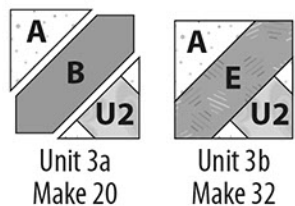
3. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 52 **Fabric A** 2-1/8" squares, 40 **Fabric F** 2-1/2" squares, 56 **Fabric C** 2-1/2" squares.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

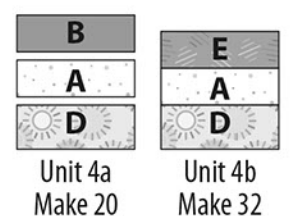
4. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric A** 2-1/8" squares on right sides together on opposite corners of a **Fabric C** 3-5/8" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangles out. Cut the square in half diagonally through the **Fabric A** corners as shown to create 2 Unit 2 (3-5/8" x 3-5/8" x 5-1/8"). Repeat to make a total of 52 Unit 2.



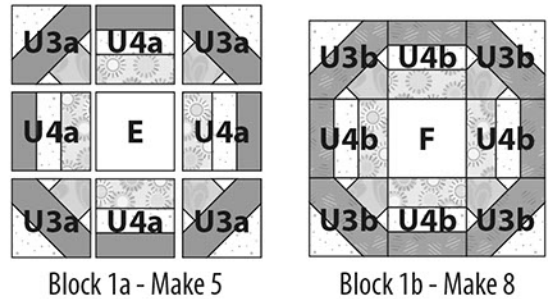
5. Sew 1 **Fabric A** 3-5/8" triangle and 1 Unit 2 to opposite sides of a **Fabric B** corner piece along their long edges. Make a total of 20 Unit 3a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 32 Unit 3b with a **Fabric E** corner piece



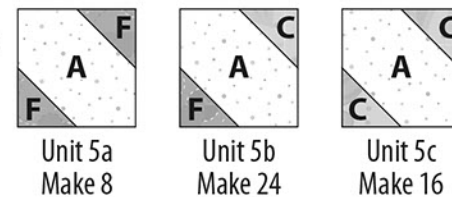
6. Stitch a **Fabric A** 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" piece lengthwise between **Fabric B** 1-3/4" x 4-1/2" and **Fabric D** 2" x 4-1/2" pieces. Make a total of 20 Unit 4a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 32 Unit 4b with fabrics indicated.



7. Arrange 1 **Fabric E** 4-1/2" square, 4 Unit 3a, and Unit 4a in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 **Block 1a** (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 **Block 1b** with **Fabric F** 4-1/2" squares and Units 3b and 4b.



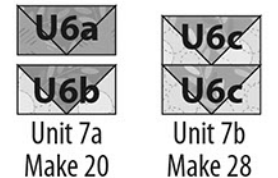
8. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric F** 2-1/2" squares right sides together on opposite corners of a **Fabric A** 4-1/2" square as shown. Using the same stitch and flip technique in Step 4, sew along marked lines, trim, and press triangles out. Make a total of 8 Unit 5a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 24 Unit 5b and 16 Unit 5c.



9. Sew 2 **Fabric E** 2-7/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric G** 5-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 20 Unit 6a (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 20 Unit 6b and 56 Unit 6c with fabrics indicated.



10. Stitch Units 6a and 6b together as shown. Make a total of 20 Unit 7a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 28 Unit 7b with Unit 6c.



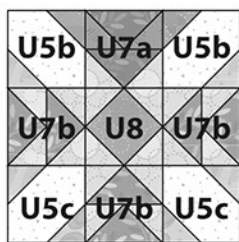
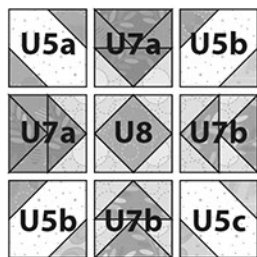

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11. Sew 4 **Fabric I** 2-7/8" triangles to edges of a **Fabric F** 3-3/8" square. Make a total of 12 Unit 8 (4-1/2" square unfinished).



12. Arrange Units 5a, 5b, 5c, 7a, 7b, and 8 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 **Block 2a** (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 **Block 2b** with units indicated.



13. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks, Unit 1a, pieced borders, and borders.

14. Arrange blocks in 5 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (60-1/2" square unfinished).

15. Sew **Fabric D** 2" x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric D** 2" x 63-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

16. Sew **Fabric E** 2" x 63-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric E** 2" x 66-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

17. Sew **Fabric B** 2" x 66-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric B** 2" x 69-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

18. Sew a Unit 1a between 2 pieced borders. Make a total of 4 borders (3-1/2" x 69-1/2" unfinished). Sew borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Unit 1a to ends of remaining borders then stitch to top and bottom of quilt.

19. Sew **Fabric B** 2" x 75-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric B** 2" x 78-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

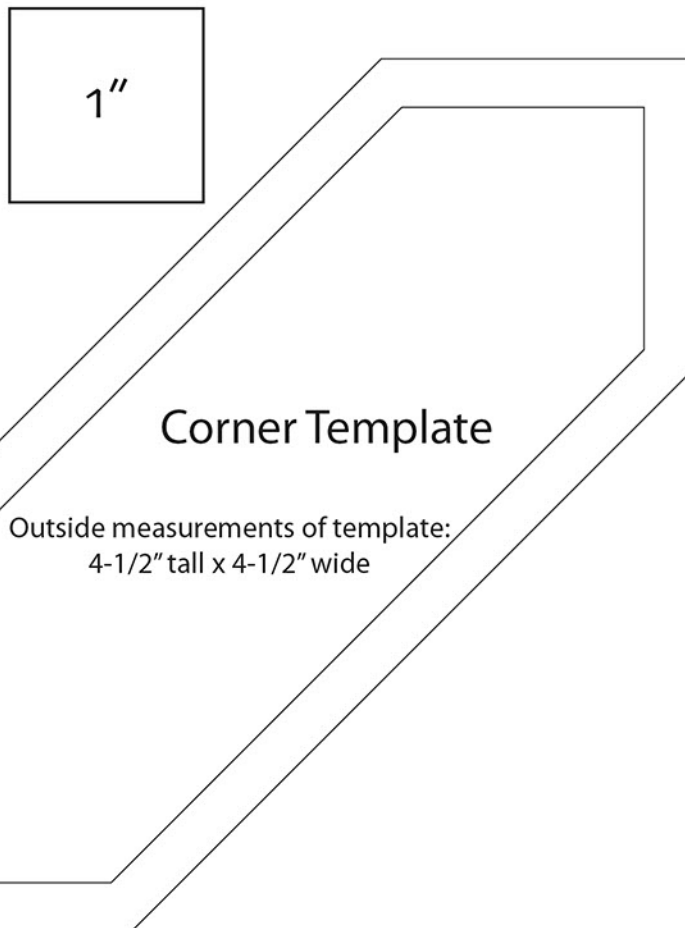
20. Sew **Fabric E** 2" x 78-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric E** 2" x 81-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

21. Sew **Fabric D** 2" x 81-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric D** 2" x 84-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

22. The quilt measures approximately 84-1/2" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric J**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

23. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

Due to printer variations, the template(s) may need to be adjusted slightly. Please enlarge or reduce as needed to make the 1" box exactly 1" square & check that the outside measurements match those listed on the templates.



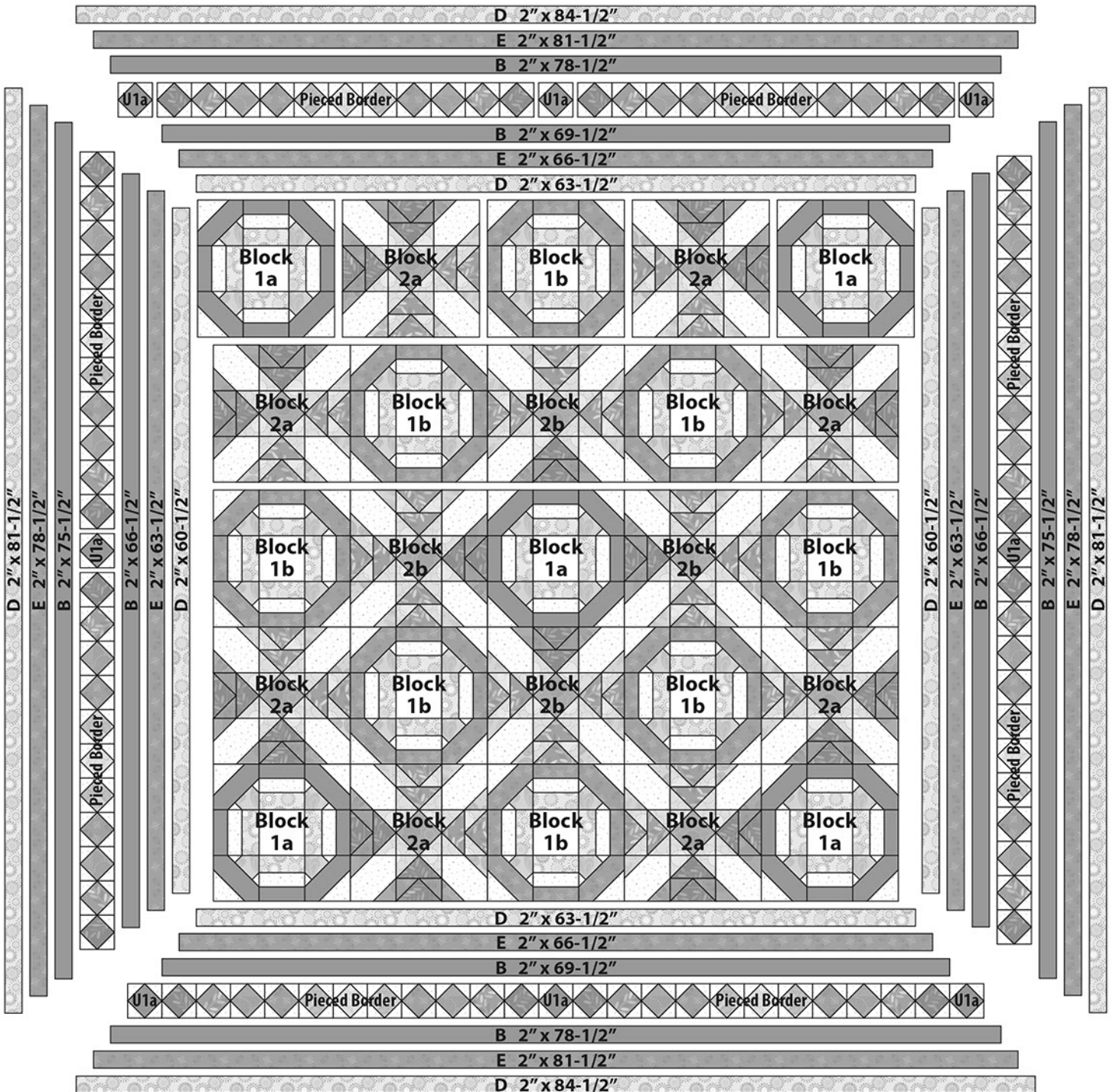
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QUILT LAYOUT

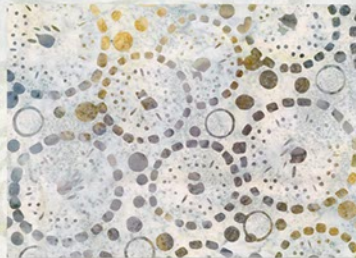
