\*\* Pieced backing is another easy option and includes remaining sections of the border stripe LIDW 4342-MU. In addition to the border stripe, you will need LIDW 4343-MU (2 yards) and LIDW 4347-S (1 yard).



## Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

### From Fabric A:

1. Cut twelve panel blocks at 8 1/2" x 10 1/2" centering design within each rectangle.

### From Fabric B:

1. Using the stripe sections containing the smaller-scale animals, cut four 5 1/4" (approx.) strips from the length of the fabric (LOF). Small floral band should be included at the BOTTOM of each stripe as seen in the quilt diagram. Cut 1/4" beneath the floral band so that it will act as a frame on the quilt. Trim strips to 5 1/4" x 66" to allow for mitering. (Fourth Border)

### From Fabric C:

1. Cut nine 1 1/2" strips. (Sashing).

### From Fabric D:

1. Cut five 2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut four equal length strips. (First Border)

2. Cut seven 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)

### From Fabric E:

1. Cut six 1 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut four 1 1/2" x 52" strips. (Second Border)

2. Cut two 2 1/2" strips; subcut twenty 2 1/2" squares. (Sashing Squares)

### From Fabric F:

1. Cut fourteen 1" strips. (Sashing)
2. Cut six 1 1/2" strips. Sew together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut four 1 1/2" x 54" strips. (Third Border)
3. Cut seven 3" strips. Sew together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut four 3" x 66" strips. (Fifth Border)

### From Fabric G:

1. Cut four 1" strips. (Sashing).

## Piecing Instructions:

1. Strip Set A: Sew one 1" F strip to both sides of one 1 1/2" C strip. Press toward the C strip. Repeat to make five strip sets. Cut sets into eight 8 1/2" segments and nine 10 1/2" segments (Figure 1).

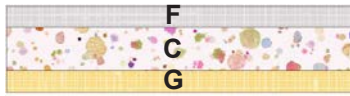


Figure 2 **Cut eight 8 1/2" and six 10 1/2" B sashing segments.**

2. Strip Set B: Sew one 1" F strip to one side of one 1 1/2" C strip. Sew one 1" G strip to other side of C strip. Press toward the C strip. Repeat to make four strip sets. Cut

sets into eight 8 1/2" segments and six 10 1/2" segments (Figure 2).

3. Referring to quilt diagram, arrange panel blocks into three rows. Sew one 10 1/2" A segment between blocks in each row. Sew a 10 1/2" B segment to both ends of rows. Press toward the panel blocks.
4. Sew four 8 1/2" B segments alternately with five 2 1/2" E squares. Press toward the squares. Repeat to make horizontal sashing rows #1 and #4.
5. Sew four 8 1/2" A segments alternately with five 2 1/2" E squares. Press toward the squares. Repeat to make horizontal sashing rows #2 and #3.
6. Referring to quilt diagram, sew panel block rows with sashing rows. Press seams open or to one side.
7. Sew together in order: one 2" D strip, one 1 1/2" E strip, one 1 1/2" F strip, one 5 1/4" B strip and one 3" F strip centering strips to each other. Press seams toward the 3" F strip. Repeat to make four sets. Center one border strip to one side of quilt and pin in place. Sew border to quilt beginning and ending a generous 1/4" from edge of quilt. Repeat for other side of quilt. Repeat process to sew a border set to top and bottom of quilt.
8. Close border corners with mitered seams matching all seams. Trim seams to 1/2" and press open.

## Finishing:

### Regular Backing:

1. Prepare backing using two widths with one or two seams. Press seams open. Trim backing to 69" x 65".
2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Quilt image shows a 1" finished outer border (Fabric F). These borders were cut across the width of the fabric which can stretch during the quilting process. To allow for that, they were cut at 3". To create a 1" finished border, cut 1 1/4" from the outer seam line on all sides of quilt, squaring corners.

### Pieced Backing:

1. Cut the following:
    - LIDW 4343 MU = five 6 1/2" strips on the length of the fabric (LOF)
    - LIDW 4347 S = sixteen 2 1/2" strips on the length of the fabric (LOF). Sew two strips together with a diagonal seam. Press seam open. Repeat to make eight pieced strips.
  2. Referring to backing diagram, sew strips from Step 1 together with remaining four border stripe strips. Press toward the 2 1/2" strips.
  3. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired.
  4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
- ### Both Backings:
5. Join seven 2 1/4" D binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method.
  6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.

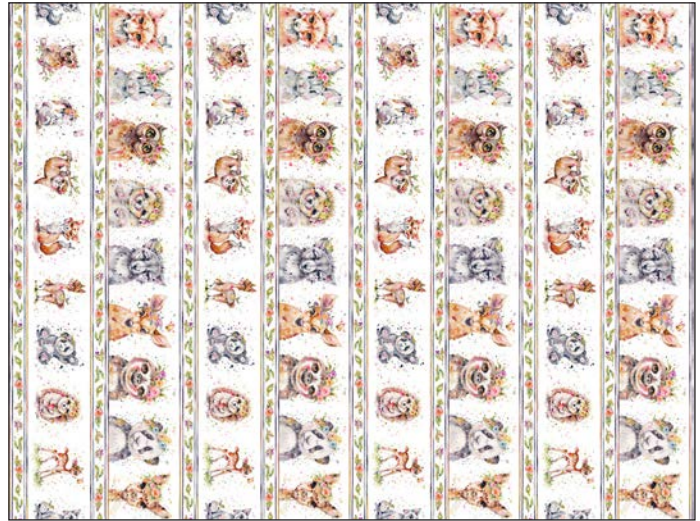
Quilt Diagram

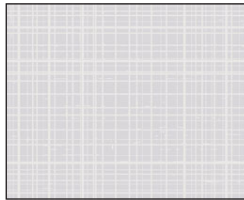

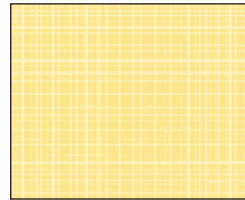
