Twin/Extra Large Throw Quilt: 64" x 78"

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, small panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly. Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 small panels to approximately 11-1/2" square From large center panel fussy cut (1) 13-1/2" square

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 71" borders, (2) 5-1/2" x 59" borders, and (4) 5-1/4" x 20" (for piecing blocks) fish stripe

Fabric C - Cut (6) 3-1/2" strips, subcut and (4) 3-1/2" x 13" and (14) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces

Fabric D - Cut (1) 13-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 13-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally *in opposite directions* for 4 triangles



Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 39-1/2" borders

Fussy cut (18) 3-1/2" squares with motifs centered

Fabric E - Cut (1) 7-1/8" strip, subcut (2) 7-1/8" squares then cut in half diagonally in opposite directions for 4 triangles



Cut (3) 4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4" x 45-1/2" borders and (1) 2" x 20" strip

Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)


Cut (2) 2" strips, sewn together end to end with the 2" x 20" strip and cut into (2) 2" x 50-1/2" borders

Fabric F - Cut (6) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-3/4" x 14" and (8) 1-3/4" x 12" strips

Fabric G - Cut (3) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 58-1/2" borders Cut (8) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 67-1/2", (2) 2" x 47-1/2", and (2) 2" x 42-1/2" borders

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch Fabric F 1-3/4" x 12" strips to sides of a Fabric A small 11-1/2" panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-3/4" x 14" Fabric F strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 13-1/2" square




Block 1 - Make 4

(unfinished). Make a total of 4 Block 1.

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.


2. Fold a Fabric B ΛB 5-1/4" x 20" strip in half and mark the center of bottom edge. Fold long edge of a Fabric E 7-1/8" triangle in half and mark center of long edge. Sew triangle to bottom of strip matching center points.

3. On unit from Step 2, trim ends of Fabric B strip even with edges of Fabric E triangle





(13-7/8" x 13-7/8" x 19-5/8" unfinished). Baste 1/8" from trimmed edges to prevent stretching.


4. Stitch a Fabric D 13-7/8" triangle long edges together with unit from Step 3 to complete Block 2a (13-1/2" square unfinished).



5. Repeat Steps 2-4 to make 1 each **Blocks** 2b-2d noting direction of fabrics.







Block 2b - Make 1 Block 2c - Make 1



- 6. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of **Fabric A** 13-1/2" square, blocks, borders, squares, and pieces.
- 7. Arrange **Fabric A** 13-1/2" square and blocks in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (39-1/2" square unfinished).
- 8. Sew 4-1/2" x 39-1/2" **Fabric D** borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 9. Sew **Fabric G** 2" x 47-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric G** 2" x 42-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 10. Sew **Fabric E** 2" x 50-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric E** 4" x 45-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 11. Center **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 71" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 59" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the dark edge next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.


12. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



- 13. Sew **Fabric G** 2"x 67-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric G** 3"x 58-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 14. Stitch 5 **Fabric C** 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips alternately with 4 **Fabric D** 3-1/2" squares to make a side border. Make a second side border. Add to right and left sides of quilt.
- 15. Stitch 2 **Fabric C** 3-1/2" x 13" strips, 2 **Fabric C** 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips together with 5 **Fabric D** 3-1/2" squares to make the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border. Add to top and bottom of quilt.
- 16. The quilt measures approximately 64-1/2" x 78-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric H**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 17. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric E**) and enjoy!!
