Twin Quilt: 65 1/2" x 90 1/2"

Indigo Garden

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

PLEASE NOTE:

Cut all 3-3/8" squares in half diagonally for the number of triangles indicated in [].

Fabric A - Referring to the guilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (5) 7" x 70" multi-stripe borders. Sew 3 strips together end to end and cut into (2) 7" x 95" borders

Fabric B - Cut (4) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (38) 3-3/8" squares [76] and (6) 3" squares

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (14) 3" squares

Fabric C - Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (14) 3-3/8" squares / [28] Cut (5) 3" strips, subcut (68) 3" squares

Fabric D - Cut (5) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (58) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

Fabric E - Cut (1) 8" strip, subcut (2) 8" squares and (4) 5-1/2" x 8" pieces Cut (1) 5-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 5-1/2" x 8" pieces

Cut (6) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (72) 3-3/8" squares [144]

Fabrics F, H, and J - From each fabric: Cut (4) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (48) 3-3/8" squares [96]

Fabric G - Cut (3) 3" strips, subcut (32) 3" squares

Fabrics I and K - From each fabric: Cut (4) 3" strips, subcut (48) 3" squares

Fabric L - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (17) 3" squares Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew 1 each Fabrics B and E 3-3/8" triangles together along their long edges.

Unit 1d Make 96

Make a total of 48 Unit 1a (3" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 96 Unit 1b, 28 Unit 1c, and 96 Unit 1d with fabrics indicated.

2. Arrange 2 Unit 1b and 1 each Units 1a and 1c in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 28 Unit 2 (5-1/2" square unfinished).




3. Sew 1 each Fabrics G and C 3" squares together. Make a total of 32 Unit 3 (3" x 5-1/2" unfinished).



Stripe indicates orientation of directional print.

4. Arrange 1 Fabric C 3" square and 4 each Units 2 and 3 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 6 Block 1a (13" square unfinished).



5. Arrange 1 Fabric C 3" square, 1 Unit 2, and 2 Unit 3 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 1b (8" square unfinished).


6. Arrange 2 Unit 1d and 1 each Fabrics I and K 3" squares in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 48 Unit 4 (5-1/2" square unfinished).



7. Arrange 1 Fabric L 3" square, 4 Fabric D $3'' \times 5 - 1/2''$ pieces, and 4 Unit 4 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 7 Block 2a (13" square unfinished).

8. Arrange 1 Fabric L 3" square, 3 **Fabric D** 3" x 5-1/2" pieces, and 2 Unit 4 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 10 Block 2b (8" x 13" unfinished).



9. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 20 Fabric B 3" squares.

Block 2b - Make 10

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

10. Arrange 4 marked **Fabric B** 3" squares right sides together on all corners of an 8" **Fabric E** square. Stitch across marked lines. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corners out. Make a total of 2 Unit 5 (8" square unfinished).




11. In the same manner, make 6 Unit 6 each with 2 marked Fabric B 3" squares and a 5-1/2" x 8" Fabric E piece (5-1/2" x 8" unfinished).



12. Sew a **Fabric C** 3" square between 2 Unit 1b. Make a total of 14 Unit 7 (3" x 8" unfinished).




13. Arrange 4 Unit 1a, 1 Unit 5, and 4 Unit 7 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 Block 3a (13" square unfinished).



14. Arrange 2 Fabric C 3" squares, 2 Unit 1a, 2 Unit 1b, 1 Unit 6, and 1 Unit 7 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. 14. (continued) Make a total of 6 Block 3b $(8'' \times 13'' \text{ unfinished}).$

15. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.




Block 3b - Make 6

16. Arrange blocks in 7 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (53" x 78" unfinished).


17. Center Fabric A 7" x 95" borders on right

and left sides of guilt center and Fabric A 7" x 70" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the dark stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

18. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.




approximately 66" x 91" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric M) approximately 8" larger than the top.

20. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric L) and enjoy!!
