

Buzz from the Garden Play Mat



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Finished Sizes:

- Center 29" X 24"
- Ruffle 1¹/₄"

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Fabric Requirements for Play Mat w/ Ruffle:

- 1-Panel SB20360-310
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yd. SB20363-100 white mini floral for ruffle.
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yd. SB20364-310 for backing
- Batting 30" X 25"

Project Notes

Cutting

- From panel:
 - Center & cut $29\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.
- From mini floral:
 - Cut (6) 3" X WOF
- From honeycomb patchwork:
 - Cut (1) $29\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle for backing.



With 3" WOF strips, trim away selvages, stitch short ends together. Press in half and gather @ 2:1.

- Step 2. Stitch ruffle around all sides of center panel. Join ends of ruffle.
- Step 3. To make quilt sandwich:

Lay batting on flat surface, place backing face up on top of batting. Place panel with ruffle face down on top of backing.

- Step 4. Stitch together with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, leaving a 6" opening.
- Step 5. Trim away extra batting, especially around corners.
- Step 6. Turn through 6" opening and slip stitch shut.
- Step 7. Quilt as desired

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Finished size approximately 31" X 26"

Finished Sizes:

- Center 29" X 24"
- Flange 1"

- Fabric Requirements for Play Mat w/ Flange:
- · 1-Panel SB20360-310
- $\frac{1}{4}$ yd. SB20363-100 mini floral for border/flange
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yd. SB20364-310 for backing
- Batting 33" X 28"

Project Notes Cutting

- From panel:
 - Center & cut (1) $29\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.
- From mini floral:
 - Cut (4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. and sub cut into:
 - (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X $24\frac{1}{2}$ " side border strips.
 - (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X $31\frac{1}{2}$ " top and bottom border strips.
- From honeycomb patchwork:
 - Cut 31½" X 26½"
- Step 1. Stitch side border strips to center panel.
- Step 2. Stitch top and bottom border strips to center panel.
- Step 3. Layer backing and batting baste together and trim away batting.
- Step 4. Place panel on top of backing/batting face to face. Stitch all the way around with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, leaving a 6" opening. Trim batting away close to corners.
- Step 5. Turn through 6" opening and slip stitch shut.
- Step 6. Stitch in ditch between border and panel to create flange.
- Step 7. Quilt as desired
