## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Wavy Stripe with Abstract Dots - Medium Blue (A), cut:

- (1) $87 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $87 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Hummingbirds - Navy (B), cut:
-(2) $87 / 8 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) $87 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Watercolor Abstract Paint Spots - Multi Blues (C), cut:
-(2) $87 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) $87 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Tossed Leafy Vines - White/Blue (D), cut:

- (1) $87 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $87 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Brush Strokes - Navy (E), cut:
-(1) $87 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $87 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Small Abstract Floral - White/Blues (F), cut: -(1) $87 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $87 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Watercolor Large Floral - Navy (G), cut:
-(2) $87 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) $87 / 8 "$ squares.
-(4) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 671 / 2 "$ strips.

- (4) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 751 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (H), cut:

- (4) $87 / 8 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $87 / 8 "$ squares.
- (2) $8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $8 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 161 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $8 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $81 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Watercolor Stripe - Multi Blues (I), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " x $641 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " x $671 / 2 "$ strips.
-(8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Textured Allover - Navy (J), cut:
-(4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 75 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.
- (4) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 771 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Leafy Vines - White/Blues (Backing), cut:
-(3) $85 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $85 " \mathrm{x} 85^{\prime \prime}$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Place (1) $87 / 8 "$ Fabric C square on top of (1) $87 / 8 "$ Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 1). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $8 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 4-12 for fabric identification, placement and number of unit squares to be made for Unit 2 through Unit 10.

3. Place (1) $87 / 8 "$ Fabric E square on top of (1) $87 / 8 "$ Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 13). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 13). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 14) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $81 / 2$ " square to make (2) Unit 11 squares (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (4) Unit 11 squares total.

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figure 16 for fabric identification and placement to make (2) Unit 12 squares.
5. Sew together (1) $81 / 2 " \times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) Unit 2 square,
(1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 11 square and (1) $81 / 2 " \times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip, in that order

Fig. 16 from left to right, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Eight.
6. Sew together (1) $81 / 2 "$ Fabric H square, (1) Unit 6 square, (1) Unit 7 square, (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 12 square, (1) Unit 6 square and (1) $81 / 2$ " Fabric H square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Seven.
7. Sew together (1) Unit 11 square, (1) Unit 8 square, (1) $81 / 2 "$ Fabric H square, (1) Unit 4 square, (1) Unit 2 square, (1) $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square, (1) Unit 7 square and (1) Unit 1 square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Three. Repeat to make Row Six.
8. Sew together (2) Unit 3 squares, (1) Unit 5 square, (1) Unit 10 square, (1) Unit 9 square, (1) Unit 1 square and (2) Unit 2 squares, in that order from left to right, to make Row Four. Repeat to make Row Five.
8. Sew the (8) Rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block, paying attention to the row orientations.

## Quilt 2

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 9. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 641 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $671 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 671 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 751 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 751 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 "} \times 771 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
