$7 / 8$ yard Texture - Teal (B)
$5 / 8$ yard Wolves Allover - Multi (C)
$1 / 4$ yard Buffalo Allover - Brown (D)
$15 / 8$ yards Map - Cream (E)
$5 / 8$ yard Paw Print Allover - Green (F)
$1 / 3$ yard Paw Print Allover - Rust (G)
$1 / 4$ yard Flying Eagles - Blue (H)
2 yards Rustic Novelty Stripe - Gray/Brown (I) 9496-93
$5 / 8$ yard Paw Print Allover - Teal (J) 9498-77*

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Block Panel - Gray/Brown (A):

- Fussy cut (8) 9 " squares, each centered on a block.

From the Texture - Teal (B), cut:

- (4) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $2 " x 9 "$ strips.
- (6) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 " x $12 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $11 / 4 " \times 9 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10 $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $10 \frac{1}{2} \gg$ strips.
From the Wolves Allover - Multi (C), cut:
-(2) $9 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (5) $9 "$ squares.
From the Buffalo Allover - Brown (D), cut:
- (1) $41 / 2 \prime \times$ X WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Map - Cream (E), cut:
-(2) 2 " $\times 501 / 2 "$ LOF strips.

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 531 / 2 "$ strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $71 / 2 " \times 30 "$ WOF strips, (2) $41 / 2 " \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips and (10) $2 " \times 30$ " WOF strips. From the 2 " x 30 " WOF strips, sub-cut (24) 2 " $\times 71 / 2 "$ strips and (24) $2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Paw Print Allover - Green (F), cut:

- (4) 2 " $\times 30$ " WOF strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 531 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 551 / 2 "$ strips.

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2" $\times 9$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 12" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure
$101 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (8) Block One squares total.

2. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 9 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 " Fabric C square. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (5) Block Two squares total.

From the Plaid with Paw Print - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) $71 " \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71 " x 71 " back.
From the Rustic Novelty Stripe - Gray/Brown (I), cut:
- (4) $41 / 2$ " $\times 67$ " LOF strips.

From the Paw Print Allover - Teal (J), cut:
-(7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

## From the Paw Print Allover - Rust (G), cut:

-(4) 2 " $\times 30$ " WOF strips.

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3. Sew (1) $2 " \times 30 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of (1) $41 / 2 " \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Strip Set 1.
4. Cut the (2) Strip Set 1 's into (24) 2 " $\times 71 / 2 "$ Unit 1 strips (Fig. 4).

5. Sew (1) 2" x $30 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of (1) $71 / 2 " \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 2 (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Strip Set 2.
6. Cut the (2) Strip Set 2 's into (24) 2" x $101 / 2$ " Unit 2 strips (Fig. 6).

7. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $41 / 2$ " Fabric D square lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (8) Unit 3 squares total.

8. Sew (1) $2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of the newly sewn strip to make $101 / 2$ " Block Three square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (8) Block Three squares total.
9. Repeat Steps 7-8 and refer to Figure 9 for fabric identification, location and orientation to make (4) $101 / 2 "$ Block Four squares.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew (1) Block Three square to each side of (1) Block Two square. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Five.
11. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Four square. Sew (1) Block Three square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
12. Sew together (3) Block Two squares and (2) Block Four squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Three.
13. Sew together the (5) Rows from Steps 10-12, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) $2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $531 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 531 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 551 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Center (1) $41 / 2 " \times 67$ " Fabric I strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.

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17. Repeat Step 16 to sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 67$ " Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 10).
18. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 10), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.
19. Layer and quilt as desired.
20. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
21. Bind as desired.
