




#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Garden Blocks - Pastel (A):

• Fussy cut (15) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares, each centered on a block.

#### From the Folio - Light Pink (B), cut:

• (3) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (60) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" triangles.

#### From the Dragonflies - Royal (C), cut:

• (12) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (120) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4" strips. • (10) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 7" strips.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Fuchsia (D), cut:

- (1) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares.
- (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- (5) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (120) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Small Flowers.

#### From the Folio - Lime Green (E), cut:

- (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (21) 2" squares.
- (2) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 20 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- See instructions to cut (19) Leaves.

### From the Folio - Light Violet (F), cut:

• (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2" squares.

#### From the Folio - Medium Blue (G), cut:

• (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (9) 2" squares.

### From the Medallion - Pastel (H):

• Fussy cut (15) 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares, each centered on a large medallion.

#### From the Folio - Powder Blue (I), cut:

- (4) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- (5) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 7" strips.

#### From the Folio - Spruce (J), cut:

- (4) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 72 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- (4) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 74 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- (18) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (71) 2" x 9" strips.
- (4) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 62" strips.
- (3) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 54 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.

#### From the Foliage - Sky (K), cut:

• (1) 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares.

From the Fuchsia Flowers - Pastel (L), cut:

• (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.

#### From the Folio - Peach (M), cut:

- (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- See instructions to cut (4) Small Flowers.
- See instructions to cut (4) Small Flower Centers

#### From the Foliage - Royal (N), cut:

- (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- See instructions to cut (2) Large Flower Centers.

#### From the Folio - Butter (O), cut:

- (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- See instructions to cut (4) Small Flowers.

#### From the Butterflies - Sky (P), cut:

• (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.

#### From the Dragonflies - Violet (Q), cut:

- (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- See instructions to cut (4) Small Flower Centers.

#### From the Folio - Orange (R), cut:

- (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- See instructions to cut (4) Small Flower Centers.
- See instructions to cut (2) Large Flowers.

#### From the Butterflies - Cream (S), cut:

• (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.

**From the Large Floral Allover - Royal (T), cut:** • (8) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Medallion - Royal (Backing), cut: $(2) 02^{\circ}$ x WOE string for the backing. Some the


• (2) 92" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 82" x 92" back.

#### **Block Assembly**


1. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" Fabric C strip to the short left side of (1) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B triangle. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to the left end of (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" Fabric C strip. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of the Fabric B triangle to make (1) Unit 1 segment (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (60) Unit 1 segments total.

2. Trim the Unit 1 segments as shown in Figure 2 to make (60) Unit 2 triangles.




3. Sew (1) Unit 2 triangle to each side of (1) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 3). The block should measure 9" x 9" square. Repeat to make (15) Block One squares total.


4. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric H square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (15) Unit 3 squares total.



5. Sew (1) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 7" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric D square to each end of (1) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 7" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 5). The block should measure 9" x 9". Repeat to make (15)

Block Two squares total.






6. Refer to Figure 6 to sew together (3) 2" Fabric E squares, (5) 2" x 9" Fabric J strips and (3) 2" Fabric F squares to make (1) Sashing Strip.

7. Repeat Step 6 and follow Figure 6 for fabric identification and location to make (6) additional Sashing Strips for a total of (7) Sashing Strips.


8. Sew together (6) 2" x 9" Fabric J strips, (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two squares as shown in Figure 6 to make Row One.

9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figure 6 for component identification, location and orientation to make Row Two through Row Six.

10. Sew together the (7) Sashing Strips and (6) pieced Rows, in numerical order and alternating them, to make the Center Block (Fig. 6).




11. Place (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 8).




12. Follow Figure 9 for the seam direction to add a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to each of the remaining corners of the  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 10).

13. Repeat Steps 11-12 to make (4) Unit 4 squares total.



14. Follow Figure 11 and sew together (32) assorted  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips lengthwise to make the Left Side Border.


15. Follow Figure 12 and sew together (32) assorted 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips lengthwise to make the Right Side Border.

16. Follow Figure 13 and sew together (27) assorted  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border.

17. Follow Figure 14 and sew together (27) assorted  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border.

18. Sew (1)  $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 62" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 54  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block (Fig. 15).

19. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block (Fig. 15).

20. Sew (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 74  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make (1) Unit 5 rectangle (Fig. 15).



#### Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 21. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

22. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.


23. Refer to the Quilt Layout to arrange and press the (4) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 20 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric E strips (Vines), assorted flowers, flower centers and Fabric E leaves onto the Fabric J outer border of the Unit 5 rectangle.

24. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the quilt top.


25. Layer and quilt as desired.

26. Sew the (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric T strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

27. Bind as desired.
