



# MNNE GREEN GABLES"



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#### FINISHED QUILT SIZE 64" x 64"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

### **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

1 Anne of Green Gables 10" Stacker (10-10600-42)

1¼ Yards Eggplant Main (C10600 Eggplant)

% Yard Grape Floral (C10603 Grape)\*

1¾ Yards Parchment Text (C10604 Parchment)

% Yard Basil Blossom (C10605 Basil)

\* Binding

#### **CUTTING REQUIREMENTS**

Please read instructions first before cutting. WOF - width of fabric.

Refer to the quilt photo and layout diagram for the placement of prints. Label pieces as they are cut.

#### Anne of Green Gables 10" Stacker

Select 13 squares for the half square triangles:

Sub-cut from each square:

2 - 5" squares (A)

Select 7 squares for the four patches:

Sub-cut from each square:

12 - 21/2" squares (B)

Select another 7 squares for the four patches:

Sub-cut from each square:

8 - 21/2" squares (B)

Select 1 more square for the four patches:

Sub-cut from square:

4 - 21/2" squares (B)

#### **Eggplant Main**

Cut 6 strips 6½" x WOF for Border 2.

#### **Grape Floral**

Cut 7 strips 21/4" x WOF for Binding.

#### **Parchment Text**

Cut 4 strips 5" x WOF.

Sub-cut from strips:

26 - 5" squares (C)

Cut 3 strips 4½" x WOF.

Sub-cut from strips:

20 - 4½" squares (E)

Cut 9 strips 2½" x WOF.

Sub-cut from strips:

144 - 2½" squares (D)

#### **Basil Blossom**

Cut 6 strips 21/2" x WOF for Border 1.


#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

Press seam allowances as indicated in the diagrams unless otherwise stated.

#### **Half Square Triangles**

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the C squares.

Place 1 A and 1 C square right sides together (RST). Sew  $\frac{1}{2}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line for 2 half square triangles (HSTs). Press the seam allowance open. Trim the HSTs to  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".




Repeat to make 52 HSTs.

#### **Four Patches**

Select 2 B squares of the same print and 2 D squares.

Lay out the B and D squares in a four patch. Sew the squares together in rows. Sew the rows together to complete 1 Four Patch  $(4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ ").



Repeat to make 72 Four Patches.

#### **Quilt Center**

Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram (page 3) for block placement.

Lay out the HSTs, Four Patches and E squares in 12 rows of 12 blocks. Sew the blocks into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt center  $(48\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $48\frac{1}{2}$ ").

#### **Borders**

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Piece borders strips together end to end where necessary. Sew side borders first. Press the seam allowances towards the borders.

#### **Border 1**

Side borders should be 48%". Top and bottom borders should be 52%".

#### **Border 2**

Side borders should be 52%". Top and bottom borders should be 64%".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with the Grape Floral strips. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
