- $5 / 8$ yard - Coral (17339-CRL-CTN-D) for Piecing and Binding
- $1 / 2$ yard - Beach Huts (17335-SND-CTN-D)
- $1 / 3$ yard - Vintage Bus (17332-SND-CTN-D)
- 1/3 yard - Patch (17338-MLT-CTN-D)
- $1 / 3$ yard - Beach Balls (17340-TRQ-CTN-D)
- $1 / 4$ yard - Surf Boards (17333-TRQ-CTN-D)
- 1/4 yard - Signs (17337-CRM-CTN-D)
- 1/8 yard - Waves (17334-MLT-CTN-D)
- $1 / 8$ yard - Bicycles (17341-WHT-CTN-D)
- $23 / 8$ yards - Beach Balls (17340-TRQ-CTN-D) for Backing

## Befare Yau Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.

Fussy Cut $2-131 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}(34.29 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm})$


Coral - 17339-CRL-CTN-D (5/8 Yard x wof / $57.15 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 6-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \mathrm{x}$ wof
Cut 2 - 2" x $401 / 2 "(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$


Beach Huts - 17335-SND-CTN-D ( $1 / 2$ Yard $x$ wof $/ 45.72 \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Fussy Cut $1-5^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 22^{\prime \prime}(12.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$
Fussy Cut $1-51 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$


Vintage Bus - 17332 -SND-CTN-D ( $1 / 3$ Yard x wof $/ 30.48 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut $1-8 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 22^{\prime \prime}(21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$


Patch - 17338-MLT-CTN-D ( $1 / 3$ Yard $x$ wof $/ 30.48 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Fussy Cut $1-5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 22^{\prime \prime}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$


Beach Balls - 17340-TRQ-CTN-D ( $1 / 3$ Yard $x$ wof $/ 30.48 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $1-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $1-5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 13 ½^{\prime \prime}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2 - 5" x 13 ½" ( $12.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm}$ )


Surf Boards - 17333-TRQ-CTN-D ( $1 / 4$ Yard x wof $/ 22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Fussy Cut $1-41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$


Signs - 17337-CRM-CTN-D ( $1 / 4$ Yard $x$ wof $/ 22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $1-51 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 22^{\prime \prime}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$


Waves - 17334-MLT-CTN-D ( $1 / 8$ Yard x wof / $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $1-21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 22^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$



Airglow Sky - 17166-GRN-CTN-D ( $1 / 4$ Yard x wof / $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) from the Magical Galaxy Collection
Cut 3 - 2" $\times 401 / 2 "(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$

Bicycles - 17341-WHT-CTN-D ( $1 / 8$ Yard $x$ wof $/ 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Fussy Cut $1-21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 22^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Sewing

1. Place two Beach Balls rectangles $5^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{1 / 2 "}(12.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm})$ and two fussy cut Beach Travel Panel squares $131 / 2{ }^{1 / 2} \times 131 / 2{ }^{1 / 2}(34.29 \mathrm{~cm}$ $\times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of the Beach Ball rectangle $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram A. Pin RST, sew and press to make Row 6 ( $131 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} / 34.29 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

2. Place the rows as shown in Diagram B. Pin the rows RST matching centers and end; sew and press. The finished Quilt Top should measure $401 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 581 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ( $102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 148.59 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

Rows 1, 7, 12: (3) Airglow Sky strips (2" x 40 ½" / 5.08cm x 102.87cm).
Row 2: Fussy cut Beach Huts strip ( $5^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 22^{\prime \prime} / 12.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Rows 3: Fussy cut Bicycles strip ( $21 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 " / 6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Rows 4 and 14: (2) Coral strips (2" x $401 / 2 " / 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Row 5: Fussy cut Patch strip ( $51 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 " / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Row 6: Made in Step 1 ( 13 ½" x 40 ½" / 34.29cm x 102.87cm).
Row 8: Vintage Bus strip ( $81 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 22^{\prime \prime} / 21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Row 9: Waves strip ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2 " / 6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Row 10: Fussy cut Surf Boards strip ( $41 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 " / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Row 11: Beach Balls strip ( $21 / 2$ " $\times 401 / 2 " / 6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Row 13: Signs strip ( $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 22^{\prime \prime} / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Row 15: Fussy cut Beach Huts strip (5 ½" x $40 ½ " / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).


## Finishing

3. Remove the selvages from the Beach Balls Backing fabric. Cut one piece $401 / 4 " \times 66^{\prime \prime}(102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 167.64 \mathrm{~cm})$, one piece $81 / 4 " \times 40$ $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(20.96 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.24 \mathrm{~cm})$, and one piece $81 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 26^{1 / 4 " \prime}(20.96 \mathrm{~cm} \times 66.68 \mathrm{~cm})$. Pin and sew the two smaller pieces RST on the short edges; press. Pin and sew the two sections RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram C. Press seams open or to one side. The Backing should measure 48 " x 66" $(121.92 \mathrm{~cm} \times 167.64 \mathrm{~cm})$.

4. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, wrong side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
5. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
6. Binding - Follow Diagram D to make the Coral Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the five $21 / 2$ " ( 6.35 cm ) x wof strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 " $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.


Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
