## Fabric Needed

## 3 Wishes Fabric ${ }^{\circledR}$ Celestial Journey Collection

- 1 Panel - Tree Panel (17130-MLT-CTN-D)
- 3/4 yd - Planets (17132-BLK-CTN-D)
- $1 / 2$ yd - Fiery Sky (17133-MLT-CTN-D) for Binding
- $3 / 8$ yd - Night Flight (17137-PUR-CTN-D)
- $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ - Borealis (17134-BLU-CTN-D)
- $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ - Landscape (17136-GRN-CTN-D)
- $21 / 2 \mathrm{yds}$ - Borealis (17134-BLU-CTN-D) for Backing


## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 51 " x 60 " ( $129.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 152.4 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4 "(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.

Fussy Cut 1 -20" x 29" ( $50.8 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.66 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Center Tree Panel
Fussy Cut 6 - " $^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$ Label $1-6$


Planets - 17132-BLK-CTN-D ( $3 / 4 \mathrm{yd} \mathrm{x}$ whf $/ \mathbf{6 8 . 5 8} \mathrm{cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut 2 - 11" x 20" (27.94cm x 50.8cm) Note: Fabric Direction Cut $2-11^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{1 / 2 "}(27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm})$ Note: Fabric Direction


Fiery Sky - $17133-$ MLT-CTN-D ( $1 / 2$ yd x wof / $45.72 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut $5-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $x$ oof $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ for Binding


Night Flight - 17137-PUR-CTN-D (3/8 yd x woof $/ 34.29 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut $12-1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 27.94 \mathrm{~cm})$ Cut $12-1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 9$ " $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$


Borealis - 17134-BLU-CTN-D ( $1 / 4$ yd x wof / $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut 8 - $11 / 2 " \times 11$ " ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 27.94 \mathrm{~cm}$ )


Landscape - 1716-GRN-CTN-D ( $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd} \mathrm{x}$ wof $/ 22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 2 - $11 / 2$ " $\times 29$ " $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.66 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2 - $1 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 55.88 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Sewing

1. Place a Landscape strip ( $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 29$ " / $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.66 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of the Center Tree Panel rectangle ( 20 " $\times 29$ " $/ 50.8 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.66 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram A. Pin RST, matching center and ends, sew and press. Place a Landscape strip ( $1 \frac{1}{2} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ $/ 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 55.88 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, matching center and ends, sew and press to make the Tree Panel Center (22" x 31" / $55.88 \mathrm{~cm} \times 78.74 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

2. Place a Night Flight strip ( $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 9$ " $/ 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of the Tree Panel \#1 square ( 9 " x 9" / $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram B. Pin RST, sew and press. Place a Night Flight strip ( $1 \times 1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ $/ 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 27.94 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Tree Panel Block \#1 (11" x 11" / $27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times 27.94 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).


Repeat to make Tree Panel Blocks 2-6 as shown below.

3. Place a Planets rectangle ( $11^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2 " / 27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), two Borealis strips ( $11 / 2$ " $\times 11^{\prime \prime} / 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 27.94 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and the Tree Panel Block \#6 ( 11 " x 11" / $27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ 27.94 cm ) as shown in Diagram D. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Left Side Border (11" x 31" / 27.94cm x 78.74 cm ).

5. Place a Planets rectangle ( $11^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime} / 27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times 50.8 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), two Borealis strips ( $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 11$ " / 3.81cm $\times 27.94 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), Tree Panel Blocks \#2 and \#5 (11" x 11" / $27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times 27.94 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram F. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Top Border (11" x 43" / $27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times 109.22 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

6. Place Tree Panel Blocks \#3 and \#5 (11" $\times 11^{\prime \prime} / 27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times 27.94 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), two Borealis strips ( $11 / 2$ " $\times 11^{\prime \prime} / 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 27.94 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and Planets rectangle ( $11^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ " $/ 27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times 50.8 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram G. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Bottom Border ( $11^{\prime \prime} \times 43^{\prime \prime}$ / $27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times 109.22 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

7. Follow Diagram H to complete the Quilt Top. Place the Left and Right Side Borders ( $11^{\prime \prime} \times 31^{\prime \prime} / 27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times 78.74 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of the Tree Panel Center ( $22^{\prime \prime} \times 31$ " / $55.88 \mathrm{~cm} \times 78.74 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown. Pin RST, matching centers and ends, sew and press. Place the Top and Bottom Borders ( $11^{\prime \prime} \times 43^{\prime \prime} / 27.94 \mathrm{~cm} \times 109.22 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown. Pin RST, matching centers and ends; sew and press. The completed Quilt Top should measure 43" x 52" (109.22cm x 132.08 cm ).

## Finishing

8. Remove the selvages from the Borealis Backing fabric. Cut one piece $401 / 4 " \times 60$ " $(102.4 \mathrm{~cm} \times 152.4 \mathrm{~cm})$, one piece $11 \frac{1}{4} \times 401 / 4$ " $(28.58 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.24 \mathrm{~cm})$, and one piece $11 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime} \times 201 / 4 "(28.58 \mathrm{~cm} \times 51.44 \mathrm{~cm})$. Pin and sew the two smaller pieces RST on the short edges; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew along the long edges as shown in Diagram I. Press the seam open or to one side. The Backing should measure 51 " x 60" ( $129.54 \mathrm{~cm} \times 152.4 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

9. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, wrong side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
10. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
11. Binding - Follow Diagram J to make the Fiery Sky Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the five $21 / 2$ " $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ wof strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 " $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
