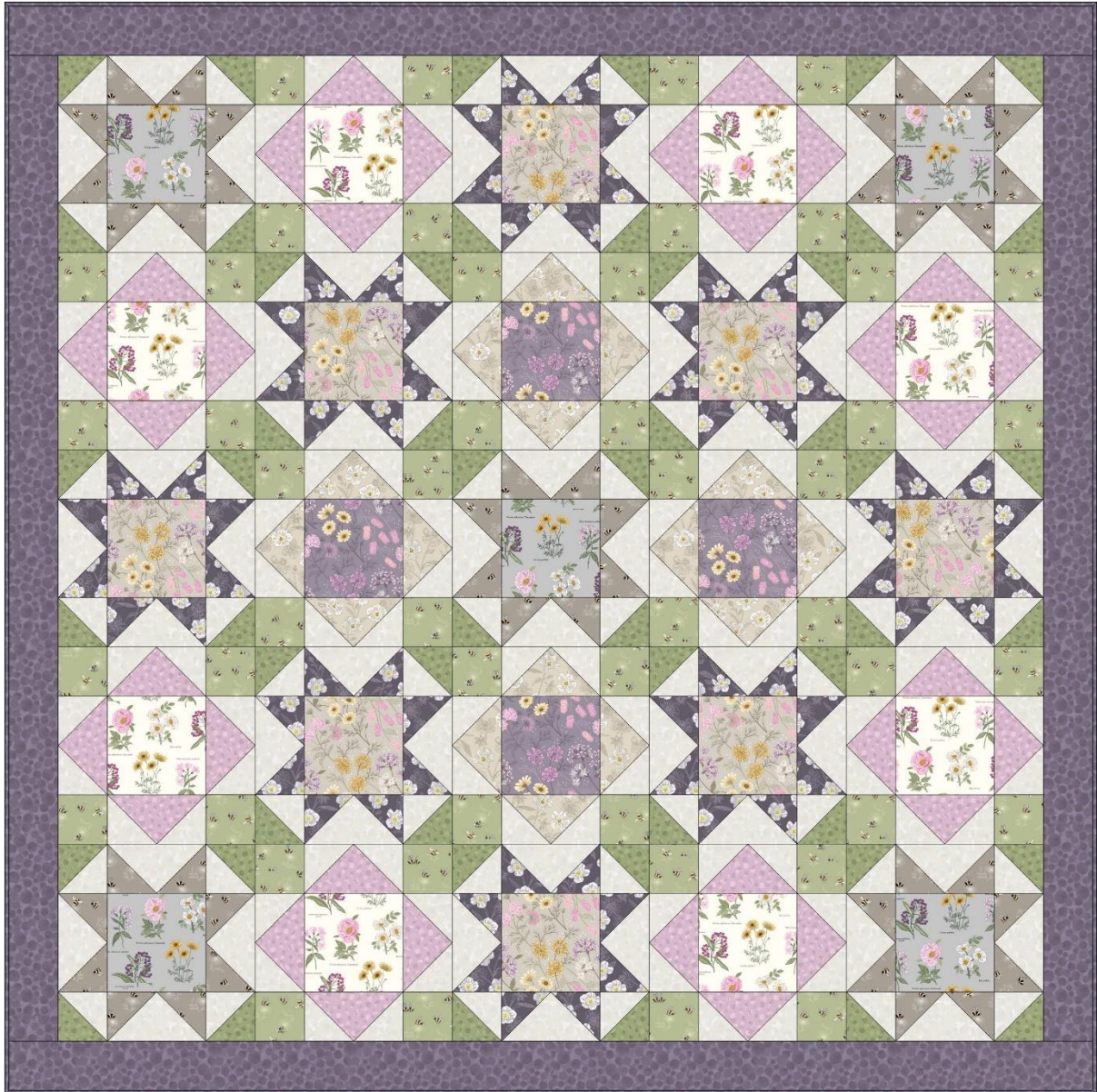

Main Diagram

Requirements

Fabrics from the Botanic Garden collection:

1. A454.3 - Garden seeds on green - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
2. A456.2 - Bumblebee on latte - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A453.2 - Botanic flowers on light grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$

4. A456.1 - Bumblebee on light green - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ mtr
5. A454.2 - Garden seeds on lilac - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ mtr
6. A453.1 - Botanic flowers on cream - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
7. A455.3 - Rambling floral dark - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ mtr
8. A457.1 - Garden floral on linen - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
9. A455.1 - Rambling floral on dark cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. A457.3 - Garden floral on warm lilac - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
11. BB40 - Bumbleberries Cream - $1\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 1.30
12. BB223 - Bumbleberries Warm purple - $1\frac{1}{8}$ yd - 1.10

Wadding and backing 70" x 70"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.
you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

26 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (blocks 1 & 3)

From fabric 2 cut

20 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

From fabric 3 cut

5 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 4

48 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 5 cut

8 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)

From fabric 6 cut

8 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 7 cut

32 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 3)

From fabric 8 cut

8 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 3)

From fabric 9 cut

4 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 4)

From fabric 10 cut

4 x 6½" x 6½" (block 4)

From fabric 11 cut

13 x 7¼" x 7¼" cut in half diagonally twice for blocks 1 & 3

70 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once for all blocks 1 & 3

From fabric 12 cut

2 x 3½" x 66½" border top & bottom

2 x 3½" x 60½" border sides

Making up the blocks

Block 1 and 3 are made up in the same way.



Block 1



Block 3

Lay out the fabric pieces for each block. Start by sewing the small corner triangles together to make a square. Now stitch a small triangle to the larger triangle on the short side and then add the other small triangle to this.

Lay out all the pieces and sew in rows, then sew your rows together to complete the block. For block 1 you need 5 in total and for block 3 you will need 8 in total.

Blocks 2 and 3 are made up in the same way.

Stitch the small triangles to the larger triangles. Lay out in rows and then stitch the rows together to complete the blocks

For block 2 you need 8 in total and for block 4 you need 4 in total.

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram



Part of quilt

Stitch the rows together pressing you seams in the opposite way each time this will help when sewing each of the rows together.

Sew the side borders to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size.

Binding

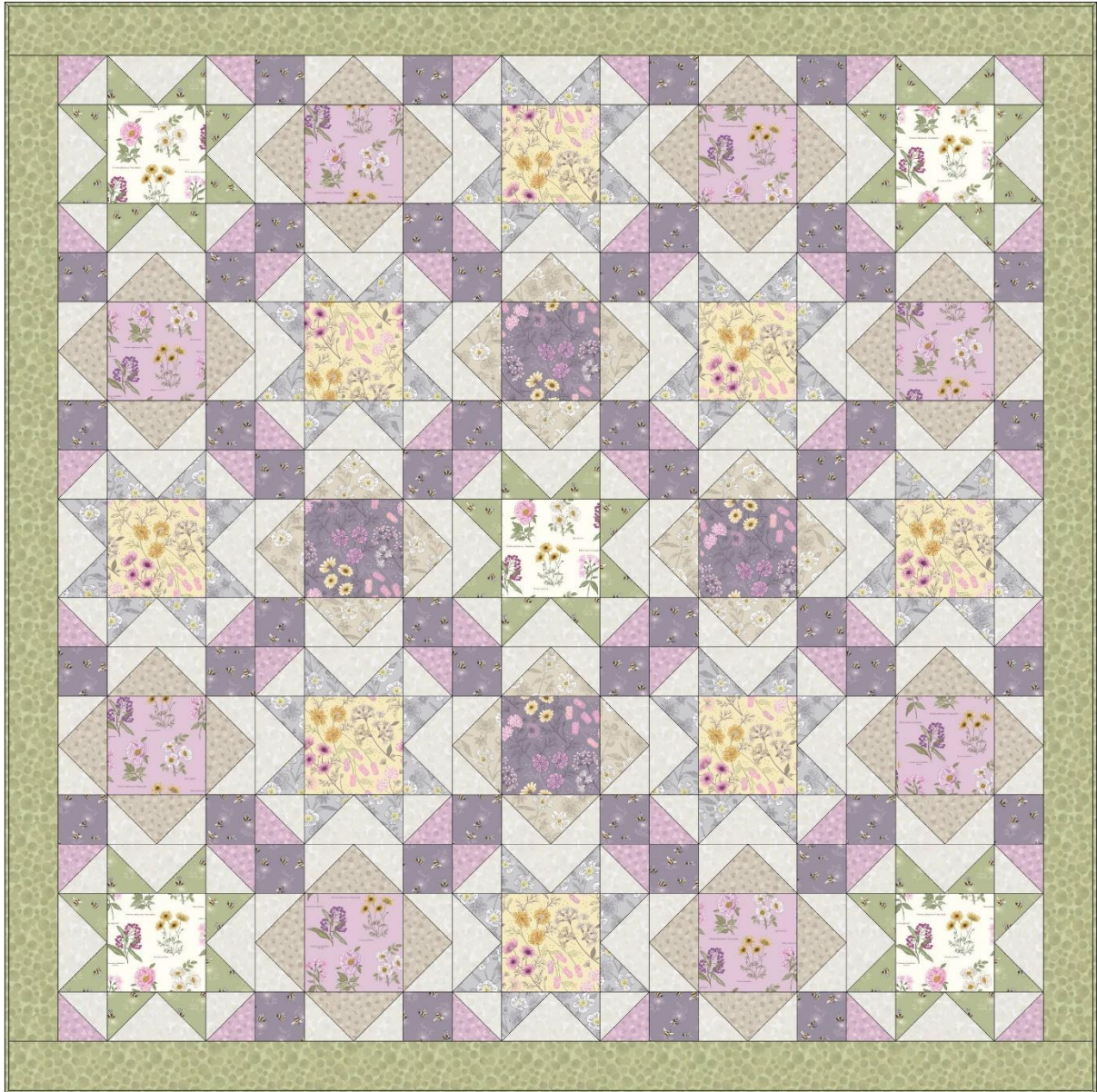
Use your favourite method from fabric 12 to bind the quilt.

Requirements

Fabrics from the Botanic Garden collection:

1. A454.2 - Garden seeds on lilac - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
2. A456.1 - Bumblebee on light green - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A453.1 - Botanic flowers on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$

4. A456.3 - Bumblebee on warm lilac - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ mt
5. A454.1 - Garden seeds on dark cream - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ mtr
6. A453.3 - Botanic flowers on lilac - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
7. A455.2 - Rambling floral on lightest grey - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd - $\frac{1}{2}$ mtr
8. A457.2 - Garden floral on pale yellow - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
9. A455.1 - Rambling floral on dark cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. A457.3 - Garden floral on warm lilac - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
11. BB40 - Bumbleberries Cream - $1\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 1.30
12. BB211 - Bumbleberries Soft green - $1\frac{1}{8}$ yd - 1.10

Wadding and backing 70" x 70"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.
you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

26 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (blocks 1 & 3)

From fabric 2 cut

20 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 1)

From fabric 3 cut

5 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 4

48 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 5 cut

8 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 2)

From fabric 6 cut

8 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 7 cut

32 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (block 3)

From fabric 8 cut

8 x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 3)

From fabric 9 cut

4 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (block 4)

From fabric 10 cut

4 x 6½" x 6½" (block 4)

From fabric 11 cut

13 x 7¼" x 7¼" cut in half diagonally twice for blocks 1 & 3

70 x 3⅞" x 3⅞" cut in half diagonally once for all blocks 1 & 3

From fabric 12 cut

2 x 3½" x 66½" border top & bottom

2 x 3½" x 60½" border sides

Making up the blocks

Block 1 and 3 are made up in the same way.



Block 1



Block 3

Lay out the fabric pieces for each block. Start by sewing the small corner triangles together to make a square. Now stitch a small triangle to the larger triangle on the short side and then add the other small triangle to this.

Lay out all the pieces and sew in rows, then sew your rows together to complete the block. For block 1 you need 5 in total and for block 3 you will need 8 in total.

Blocks 2 and 3 are made up in the same way.

Stitch the small triangles to the larger triangles. Lay out in rows and then stitch the rows together to complete the blocks

For block 2 you need 8 in total and for block 4 you need 4 in total.

Part of quilt

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 12 to bind the quilt.

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
