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A Country Weekend


Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.


All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

PLEASE NOTE:




Cut all 9-1/4" squares in half diagonally twice for the number of triangles indicated in []. 



Cut all 4-7/8" squares in half diagonally for the number of triangles indicated in []. 


Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.



Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 2 panels to approximately 8-1/2" x 23-1/2" and 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square


Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (6) 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" floral strips

Fabric C - Cut (1) 9-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 9-1/4" square  [4] and (1) 4-1/2" square
Cut (3) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (20) 4-7/8" squares then cut 10 in half diagonally *only as shown* [20] and 10 in the opposite direction *only as shown* [20]  

Fabric D - Cut (1) 9-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 9-1/4" square  [4] and (4) 4-7/8" squares  [8]
Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares
Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip


Fabric E - Cut (3) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (26) 4-7/8" squares  [52] and (3) 1-1/4" x 32" strips. Subcut 1-1/4" x 32" strips into (6) 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" strips and (1) 1-1/4" x 6" strip.
Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips
Cut (2) 1-1/4" strips, sewn together end to end with the 1-1/4" x 6" strip and cut into (2) 1-1/4" x 42-1/2" borders
Cut (2) 1 1/4" strips, subcut (6) 1 1/4" x 12 1/2" strips.


Fabric F - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 4-7/8" squares then cut 2 in half diagonally *only as shown* [4] and 2 in the opposite direction *only as shown* [4]  

Fabric G - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 4-7/8" squares  [8]
Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip

Fabric H - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

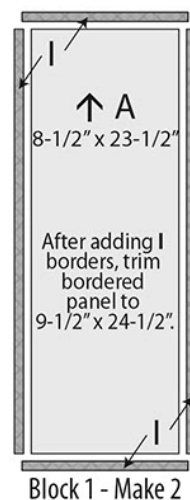
Fabric I - Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" squares and (1) 1-1/4" x 12" strip
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 25" and (4) 1-1/2" x 11" strips
Cut (5) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 14" and (7) 1-1/4" x 12" strips

Fabric J - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 4-7/8" squares  [4] and (12) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric K - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 4-7/8" squares  [8]
Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders
Cut (3) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 44-1/2" borders and (1) 1-1/2" x 20" strip
Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end with the 1-1/2" x 20" strip and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 50" borders

2. Piecing Order:

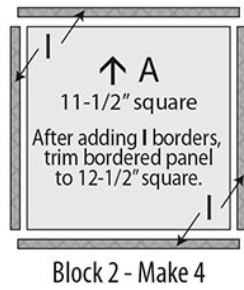
1. Stitch **Fabric I** 1-1/2" x 25" strips to sides of a 8-1/2" x 23-1/2" **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 11" **Fabric I** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 9-1/2" x 24-1/2" (unfinished)**. Make a total of 2 Block 1.



Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

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2. Stitch **Fabric I** 1-1/4" x 12" strips to sides of an 11-1/2" square **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 14" **Fabric I** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished).** Make a total of 4 **Block 2**.

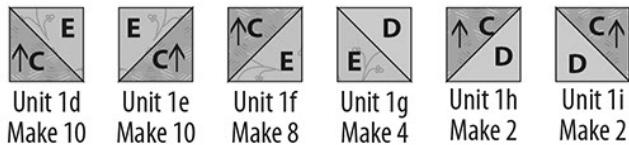
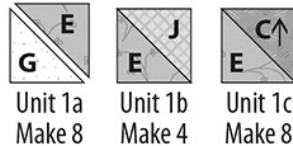


Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

3. Stitch **Fabric E** 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" strips to sides of a 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" **Fabric B** strip. **Trim to 6-1/2" wide.** Make a total of 6 **Block 3** (6-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished).



4. Sew 1 each **Fabrics E and G** 4-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 8 Unit 1a (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make the number of Units 1b-1i listed with fabrics indicated.



5. Arrange 1 **Fabric D** 4-1/2" square and Units 1b, 1c, 1d, 1e, 1f, and 1g in a row. Stitch into a row. Make a total of 2 Pieced Border 1 (4-1/2" x 52-1/2" unfinished).

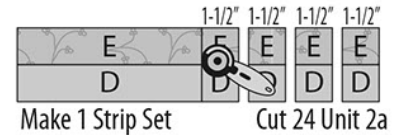


6. Arrange 1 **Fabric D** 4-1/2" square and Units 1c, 1d, 1e, 1f, 1h, and 1i in a row. Stitch into a row. Make a total of 2 Pieced Border 2 (4-1/2" x 52-1/2" unfinished).



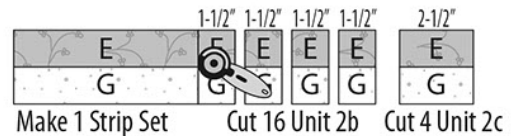

7. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics D and E** 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips



together lengthwise. From this cut (24) Unit 2a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" (unfinished).

8. Sew 1 each **Fabrics E and G** 1-1/2" x width of fabric strips together lengthwise. From this cut (16) Unit 2b 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" (unfinished) and (4) Unit 2c 2-1/2" square (unfinished).



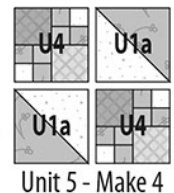
9. Stitch 1 each Units 2a and 2b together as shown. Make a total of 16 Unit 3 (2-1/2" square unfinished).



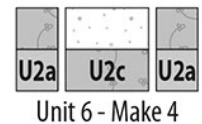
10. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics I and J** 2-1/2" squares and 2 Unit 3 in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 Unit 4 (4-1/2" square unfinished).



11. Arrange 2 each Units 1a and 4 in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew row together. Make a total of 4 Unit 5 (8-1/2" square unfinished).

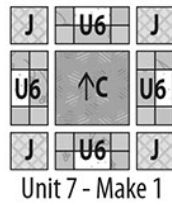


12. Sew a Unit 2c between 2 Unit 2a as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 6 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished).

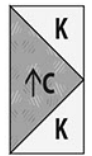
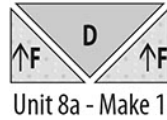


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13. Arrange 4 **Fabric J** 2-1/2" squares, 1 **Fabric C** 4-1/2" square, and 4 Unit 6 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to make Unit 7 (8-1/2" square unfinished).



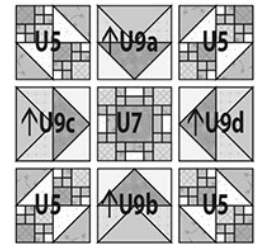
14. Stitch 2 **Fabric F** 4-7/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric D** 5-1/4" triangle as shown to create 1 Unit 8a (4-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 each Units 8b-8h.



15. Sew Units 8a and 8e together as shown to make Unit 9a (8-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 each Units 9b-9d.



16. Arrange Units 5, 7, and 9a-9d in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete Center Block (24-1/2" square unfinished).



17. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks, units, pieced borders and borders.

18. Arrange blocks in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (42-1/2" x 48-1/2" unfinished).

19. Sew **Fabric E** 1-1/4" x 42-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

20. Sew **Fabric K** 1-1/2" x 50" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric K** 1-3/4" x 44-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

21. Sew Pieced Border 2 to right and left sides of quilt. Add Pieced Border 1 to top and bottom of quilt.

22. Sew **Fabric K** 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric K** 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

23. The quilt measures approximately 56-1/2" x 64-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

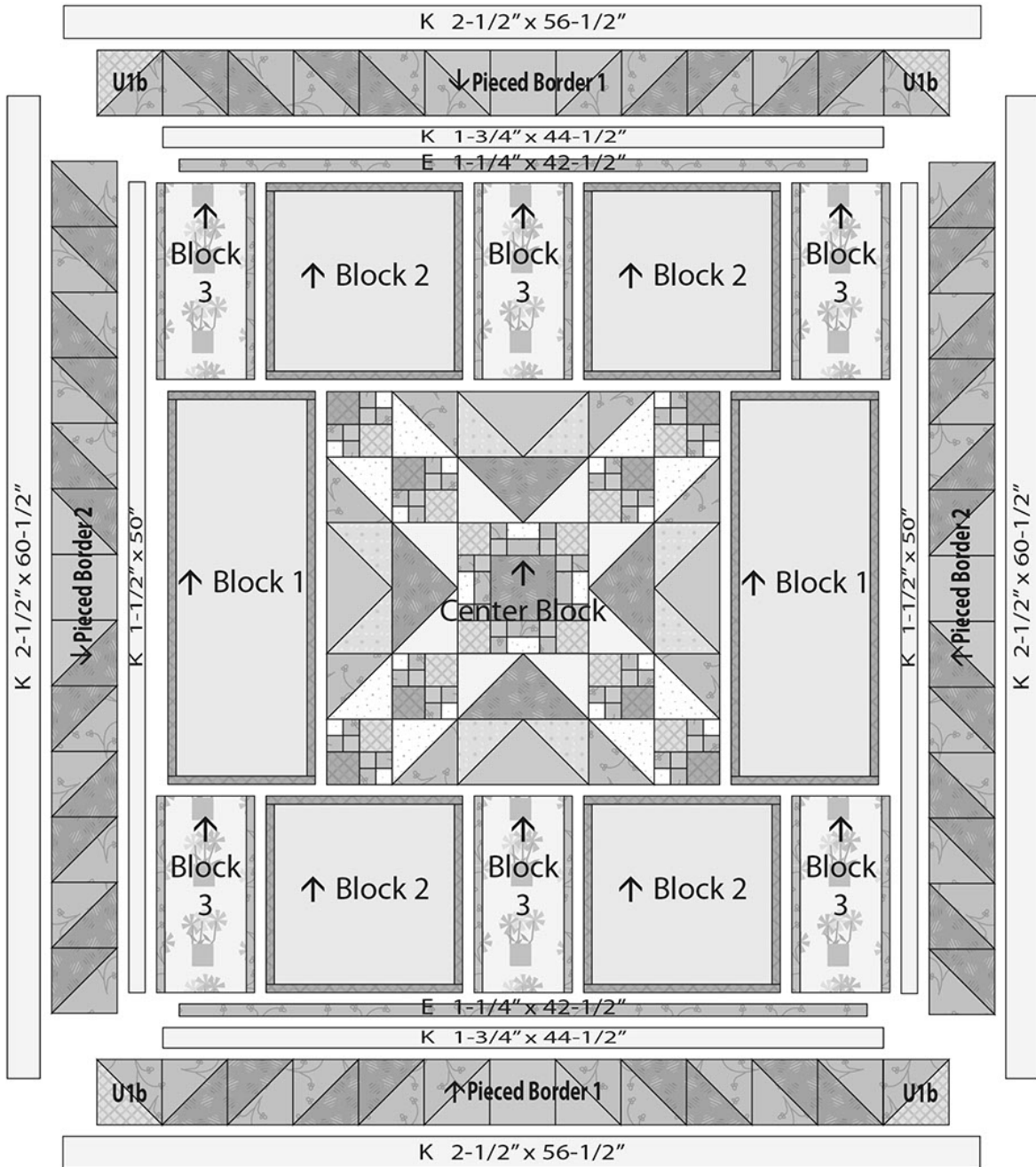
24. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!

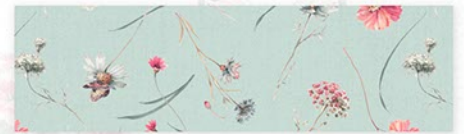

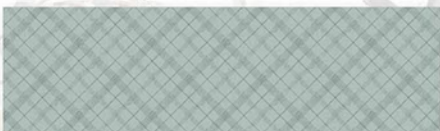

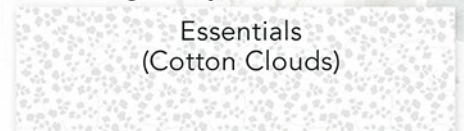
