Farmhouse Chic

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (5) 12-1/2" strips, subcut (15) 12-1/2" squares and (4) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric B - Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (6) 6-1/2" squares
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips

Fabric C - Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (5) 6-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips

Fabric D - Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares

Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips

Fabric E - Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (16) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for a total of 32 triangles Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (20) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for a total of 40 triangles Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric G - Cut (3) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for a total of 48 triangles Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips

Fabric H - Cut (3) 7-1/4" strips, subcut (15) 7-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice for a total of 60 triangles Cut (5) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (60) 3-1/2" squares Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 83" borders Cut (9) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 93-1/2" and (2) 3" x 86-1/2" borders

Cut (4) 2-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-3/4" x 75-1/2" borders

Fabric I - Cut (16) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 80",

(2) 2" x 69-1/2", and (5) 2" x 66-1/2" borders Cut (8) 2" strips, subcut (24) 2" x 12-1/2" strips

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch 2 **Fabric F** 3-7/8" triangles to short edges of a **Fabric H** 7-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 10 each Units 1a and 1b noting orientation of H stripe (3" x 5-1/2" unfinished).





Stripes indicate orientation of directional print.

2. In the same manner, make 8 each Units 2a and 2b and 12 each Units 3a and 3b.










3. Sew Fabrics F, B, E, C, G, and D

3-1/2" x width of fabric strips together lengthwise (18-1/2" x width of fabric unfinished). Make a second strip set. From these cut (18) 3-1/2" wide Unit 4 (3-1/2" x 18-1/2" unfinished).




Make 2 Strip Sets

Cut 18 Unit 4


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
4. Arrange a Fabric C 6-1/2" square, 4 Fabric H 3-1/2" squares, and 2 each U1a and U1b in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 Block 1 (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Stripes indicate orientation of directional print.

5. In the same manner, make 4 Block 2 and 6 Block 3 with fabrics and units indicated.

- 6. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of Fabric A 12-1/2" squares, blocks, Fabric I strips, units, and borders.
- 7. Arrange **Fabric A** 12-1/2" squares, blocks, and Fabric I 2" x 12-1/2" strips in 6 rows. Stitch into rows (12-1/2" x 66-1/2" unfinished). Sew rows together, alternating with Fabric I 2" x 66-1/2" strips, completing quilt center (66-1/2" x 80" unfinished).
- 8. Sew **Fabric I** 2" x 80" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add Fabric I 2" x 69-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 9. Sew **Fabric H** 3-1/2" x 83" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric H 2-3/4" x 75-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 10. Pick out stitches to remove Fabric F 3-1/2" square from the end of 2 Unit 4 to create 2 Unit 5.




- 11. Arrange 4 Unit 4 and 1 Unit 5 in vertical rows on right and left side of guilt. Stitch into side borders (3-1/2" x 87-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to right and left sides of guilt.
- 12. Arrange 4 Unit 4, 2 Fabric A 3-1/2" squares, and 1 Fabric F 3-1/2" square (from Step 10) in horizontal rows above and below quilt. Stitch into top and bottom borders (3-1/2" x 81-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to top and bottom of quilt.
- 13. Sew **Fabric H** 3" x 93-1/2" borders to right and left sides of guilt. Add Fabric H 3" x 86-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 14. The quilt measures approximately 86-1/2" x 98-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric J) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric F) and enjoy!!


