

# WARM WISHES NINE PATCH

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 69" x 69"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Warm Wishes Rolie Polie (RP-10780-40)
1% Yards Sky Main (C10780 Sky)
1% Yards Redwood Snowmen (C10786 Redwood)\*
1% Yards Red Le Crème Swiss Dot (C600-80 Red)
\* Includes binding

### **CUTTING REQUIREMENTS**

Please read instructions first before cutting. WOF - width of fabric.

## Warm Wishes Rolie Polie

Cut 360 - 2½" squares, varying the prints. The more fabrics used the scrappier the quilt will look.

**Sky Main** Cut 7 strips 6" x WOF for Border 2

# Redwood Snowmen

Cut 6 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 1. Cut 8 strips 2½" x WOF for Binding.

#### Red Le Crème Swiss Dot


Cut 7 strips 6½" x WOF. Sub-cut from strips: 41 - 6½" squares

# QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo and layout diagram for the placement of prints. Press seam allowances as shown in the diagrams unless otherwise stated.

### Nine Patches (Make 40)

Randomly select 9 Warm Wishes Rolie Polie  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Lay the squares out in a nine patch. Sew the squares into rows. Sew the rows together to complete 1 Nine Patch ( $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ").



Repeat to make 40 Nine Patches.

### **Quilt Center**

Sew together 5 Red Le Crème Swiss Dot  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, alternating with 4 Nine Patches. Repeat to make 5 Row 1 ( $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $54\frac{1}{2}$ ").

Sew together 5 Nine Patches, alternating with 4 Red Le Crème Swiss Dot  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Repeat to make 4 Row 2 ( $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $54\frac{1}{2}$ ").

Sew together the Rows, alternating Rows 1 and 2, to complete the Quilt Center ( $54\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $54\frac{1}{2}$ ").

#### Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Piece borders strips together end to end where necessary.

Sew side borders to the first. Press seam allowances towards the borders.

#### Border 1

Side borders should be 54½". Top and bottom borders should be 58½".

#### Border 2

Side borders should be  $58\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $69\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with the Redwood Snowmen strips. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
