## Cutting




From Panel:

Center and trim center panel image to:  
25" X 34", quilt center.

From Light Grey Squiggle:

- (4)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X WOF strips, sub cut into:
  - (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X 34", sides border #1.
  - (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X 27", top and bottom border #1.
- (6)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X WOF strips, for binding.

From White Squiggle:

- (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X WOF strips, sub cut into:
  - (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X 36", sides border #2.
  - (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X 31", top and bottom border #2
- (3)  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " X WOF, sub cut into:
  - (14)  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " X  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally for (28) A triangles in pieced border #4. 
- (1)  $6\frac{1}{4}$ " X WOF, sub cut into:
  - (5)  $6\frac{1}{4}$ " X  $6\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut in diagonally twice for (20) B triangles in pieced border #4. 
- (1)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " X WOF, sub cut into:
  - (4)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " X  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares, cut diagonally for (8) C triangles in pieced border #4. 
- (1) 3" X WOF, sut cut into:
  - (4) 3" X  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ", F rectangles in corner blocks, pieced border #4.
  - (4) 3" X 3", G squares in corner blocks, pieced border #4.

WOF = width of fabric  
HST= half square triangle, QST =quarter  
square triangle  
All seams  $\frac{1}{4}$ "  
Press as you stitch

# Cutting continued

From Bees Print:

- (2)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " X WOF strips, sub cut into:
  - (2)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " X 40", sides border #3.
- (2)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " X WOF strips, sub cut into:
  - (2)  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " X  $35\frac{1}{2}$ ", top and bottom border #3.




From Green Dot:

- (6)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X WOF strips. Remove selvages, stitch together on short ends and sub cut into:
  - (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $55\frac{1}{2}$ ", right and left border #5 strips.
  - (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $47\frac{1}{2}$ ", top and bottom border #5 strips.

From Yellow Dot:

- (1) 3" X WOF strip, sub cut into:
  - (4) 3" X 3", E squares for pieced border #4.
- (1) 4" X WOF strip, sub cut into:
  - (4) 4" X 4", D squares for pieced border #4.

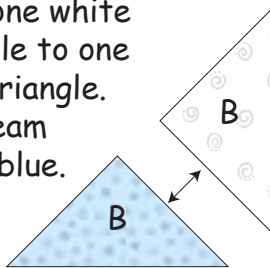
From Blue Dot:

- (1)  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " X WOF, sub cut into:
  - (4)  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " X  $5\frac{7}{8}$ ", cut in half once diagonally for (8) A triangles in pieced border #4. 
- (1)  $6\frac{1}{4}$ " X WOF, sub cut into:
  - (5)  $6\frac{1}{4}$ " X  $6\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut diagonally twice for (20) B triangles in pieced border #4. 
- (1)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " X WOF, sub cut into:
  - (4)  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " X  $3\frac{3}{8}$ " squares, cut diagonally for (8) C triangles in pieced border #4. 

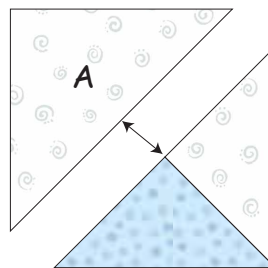
## Pieced Blocks Border #4

Using blue and white C triangles and white A triangles:

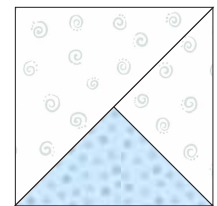
Stitch one white C triangle to one blue C triangle. Press seam toward blue.



Stitch white triangle A to C/C. Press toward A.



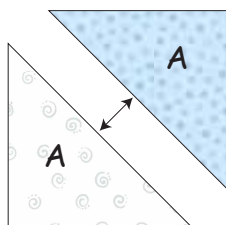

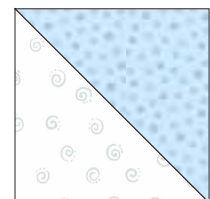

Using white and blue A triangles:

Stitch one white and one blue A triangle together and press toward blue triangle.



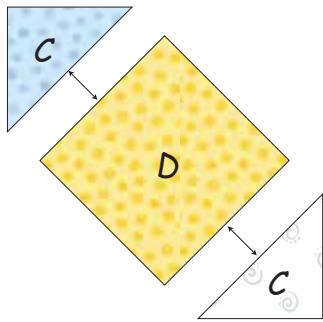

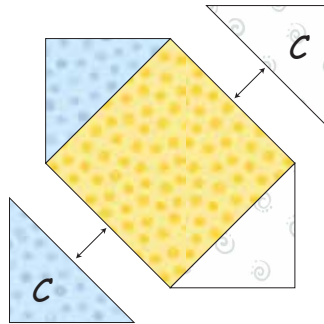

# Pieced Blocks Border #4 continued

Using C triangles, and D squares:

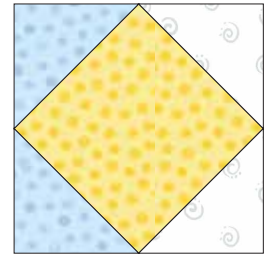


Stitch one blue triangle C and one white triangle C to opposite sides of square D.



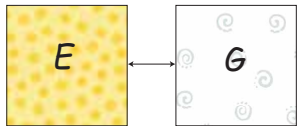
Stitch remaining triangle C pieces to center square as shown.

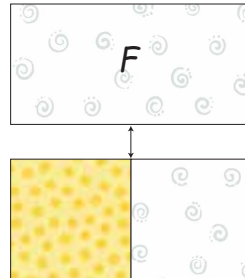

Using E and G squares and F rectangles:

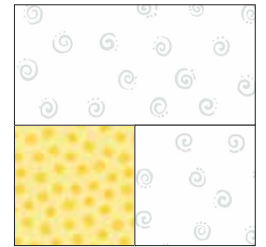


Stitch one yellow E square to one white G square. Press seam toward yellow.

Stitch white rectangle F to E/G. Press toward F.

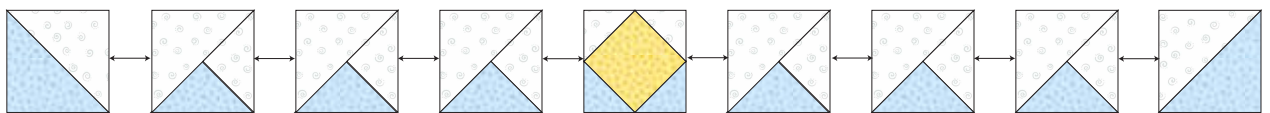

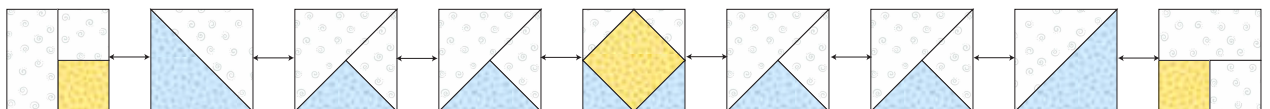
## Quilt Assembly

Step 1. With pieced blocks, assemble border #4 strips:

Right and Left border #4  
Make 2



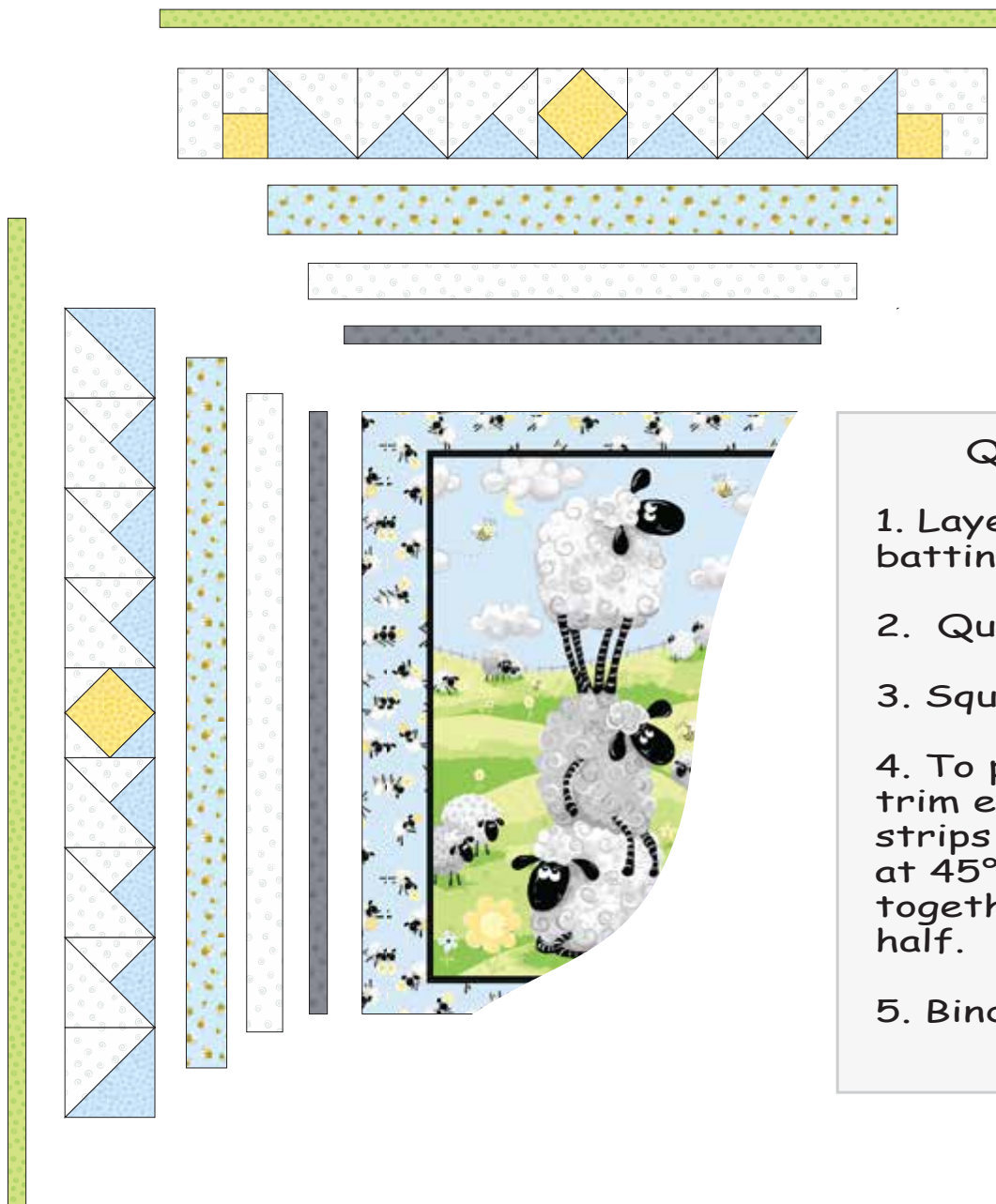
Top and Bottom border #4  
Make 2



## Step 2.

Add borders to quilt center in the following order:

- A. Grey  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X 34", sides border #1.  
Grey  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X 27", top and bottom border #1.
- B. White  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X 36", sides border #2.  
White  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X 31", top and bottom border #2
- C. Bee print  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " X 40", sides border #3.  
Bee print  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " X  $35\frac{1}{2}$ ", top and bottom border #3.
- D. Pieced right and left side border #4  
Pieced top and bottom border #4
- E. Green  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $55\frac{1}{2}$ ", right and left border #5 strips.  
Green  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $47\frac{1}{2}$ ", top and bottom border #5 strips.



### Quilt Finishing

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Square quilt.
4. To prepare binding, trim ends of binding strips facing up and cut at  $45^\circ$  angle. Stitch together, and press in half.
5. Bind as usual.
